NEW YORK, June 3.-Germany has carried her Submarine War to this side of the ocean and in the last 24 hours a number of vessels have been sunk. Some reports say the number of victims already is as many as fifteen. The presence of the U-boats has been reported in

coast, came today when the crew of one victim, the Schooner Edward H. Cole, landed here. Their vessel was sunk Sunday off the New Jersey shore.

It is known that at least two U-boats are engaged in the campaign which is assumed to be' aimed chiefly at the American transportation service. A report that besides the attacks on shipping off the New Jersey coast a submarine was operating off Nantucket Coast. Presumably the Germans are employing the new cruiser type of U-boats with a long steaming radius for these operations.
