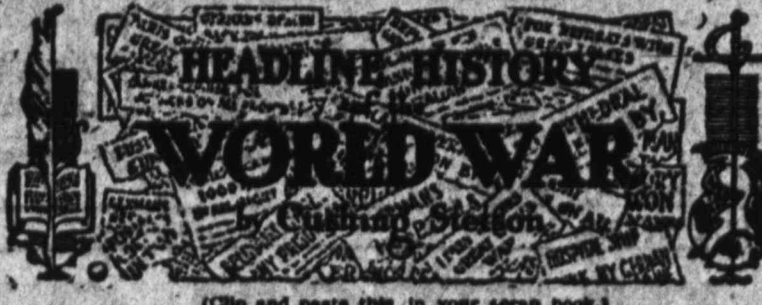

For Forty Years She Reigned As Queen of Singers of The Entire World. WAS RECIPIENT OF MANY HONORS DURING CAREER.

First American Tour Was In 1881 And Her Last Appearance In 1903.

LONDON, Sept. 27.—Adelina Patti, the prima donna, died this morning at Craig-Y-Nos Castle, Penryn, South Wales. Mrs. Adelina Patti reigned for 40 years as queen of singers.

Move to New York. Dwindling finances sent the Patti family to New York when Adelina, whose birth name was Adina Fugga, Marie Patti was a baby. When she was seven years old, her parents suddenly became destitute.

ROOSEVELT MEMORIAL DRIVE WILL BEGIN ON MONDAY, OCTOBER 6

Monday, October 6, will see the beginning of the drive for funds in Wichita county for funds for the Roosevelt Memorial Association, according to a statement by R. W. Wells, State organizer, who is in Wichita Falls arranging details for the campaign. Wichita county's quota has been fixed at \$3,000, the raising of which will be directed by John E. Abernathy as chairman of Wichita county. O. P. Maricle will direct the raising of a quota of \$11,250 in this congressional district.

One feature of the campaign will be a memorial service which it is proposed to hold in the schools on Colonel Roosevelt's birthday, October 28. "One of the most pleasing features in connection with this plan is the Roosevelt Memorial Association to provide funds for the erection of a monument in Washington and for a fitting memorial to Theodore Roosevelt in the nation, former secretary to Mayor Gaynor of New York City and former fire commissioner of the City of New York; George Harvey, editor of the North American Review and Harvey's Weekly; Congressman James A. Gallivan, of Massachusetts, who is representing a Boston district; Theodore Francis Green and Richard B. Comstock, both of Providence, R. I.; Thomas Taggart, chairman of the democratic national campaign in 1904 who accepted the honorary chairmanship for Indiana; the Hon. George Turner, of Spokane, Wash.; formerly a United States senator; Senator George E. Chamberlain, of Oregon, who is a member of the national committee; Luke E.
