PENNANT V SIGNS FOR GOTHAM FANS

Yankees, Giants and Superbs Each Believed to Have Good Chance to Win Quot.

New York, June 5.—Although the major league baseball season is not yet completed the fans on Greater New York are already figuring on witnessing at least one half of the World Series of 1916 and possibly the entire conflict. With the New York and Brooklyn teams fighting for the National League lead and the New York Americans winning striking distance of first place in the American, it is hard to convince the average fan of the big city that one of the three will not be found safely perched at the top when the season closes early in October.

The remarkable dash of the New York Giants from last place to within a few columns of the lead in the senior league, during which they won seventeen straight games, has restored the Giants to their former place of distinction of the fans and confidence in their ability to play winning ball from this time on, is evident on all sides.

Connie Mack, the leader of the Philadelphia Athletics, in a recent interview picked the Yankees to win the American League pennant. This is in conjunction with the brand of ball the reconstructed combination has displayed this spring, has caused the followers of the Yankees in Greater New York to figure on the possibility of the Yankees appearing in the role of World Series contenders next fall. Much will depend upon the result of the New York Americans first trip over the Western circuit. The Giants and Superbs have already passed this test in a highly satisfactory manner. If the Yankees can demonstrate that they are equally efficient in the road their chances of holding a place well to the fore in the long pennant race ahead will be considerably augmented.

TEXAS CASE UPHELD BY SUPREME COURT

Holds That Violation of Safety Appliance Law is Proof of Negligence.

By Associated Press. Washington, June 5.—Reaffirming a judgment of \$10,000 obtained in the Texas courts by William Wagner, brakeman on the San Antonio & Ansonia Pass railway for injuries received while operating a coupler,

the supreme court held the only negligence necessary to sustain recovery under the federal employers liability law is proof of a violation of the federal safety appliance law.

NERVOUS TROUBLE PROVES FATAL TO RAILROAD MAN

After an illness of three months with severe nervous trouble which developed into paralysis, James L. Crockett, aged 39, died this morning at 11:30 at his home 1213 Eighteenth street.

Mr. Crockett was formerly a brakeman on the Fort Worth & Denver and had lived here about five years. About three years ago he suffered the loss of his right arm in an accident and since that time he had at intervals been afflicted with nervous trouble.

Surviving are his wife and two children, a son and daughter. Three brothers and three sisters, all residing in Oklahoma also survive.

14TH VENIRE IN COURT FOR WILL ORPET TRIAL

By Associated Press. Waukegan, Ill., June 5.—The fourteenth panel of veniremen to be called for examination in the trial of Will H. Orpet, University of Wisconsin student charged with the murder of his former sweetheart, Marian Lambert, appeared today in court.

More than 1,100 men have now been summoned for examination and there are still two places in the jury box to be filled; eight men have been sworn for service and two others have passed temporarily.

CLINICS TO BE FEATURE OF MEDICAL ASSOCIATION

Detroit, Mich., June 5.—Hundreds of physicians and surgeons of national and international prominence, who are to attend the national convention of the American Medical Association in Detroit June 12-15, are expected to attend and possibly participate in a series of clinics to be conducted by the Detroit College of Medicine, June 7 to 12.

ADDITIONAL INTEREST IN THESE CLINICS seems centered about the plans for "Tuberculosis Day" which will be Friday, June 9. The principal feature of the day will be a pageant which will deal in unique ways with various phases of the disease and of treatments and preventative measures.

The pageant, which will pass through the principal streets of Detroit, will be followed by a public meeting. Tuberculosis experts are to make addresses at this meeting. They will urge the public to co-operate in a campaign for cleaner home and surroundings and for effective results on "public clean-up days."

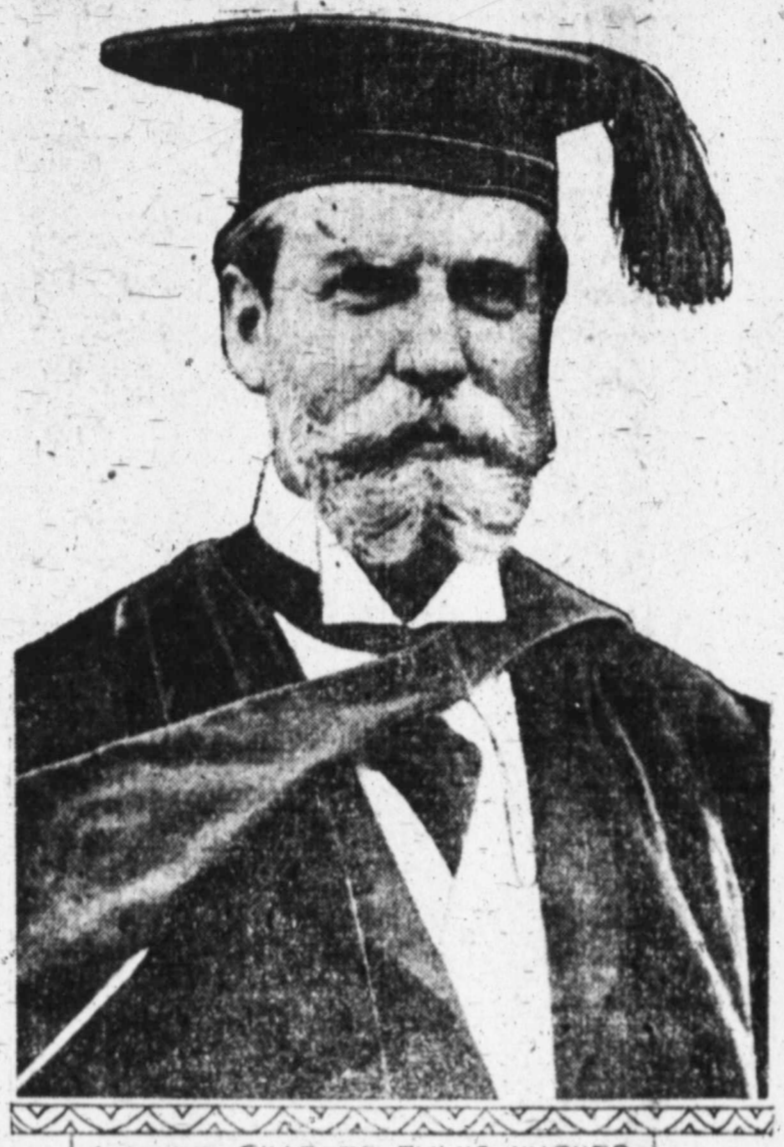

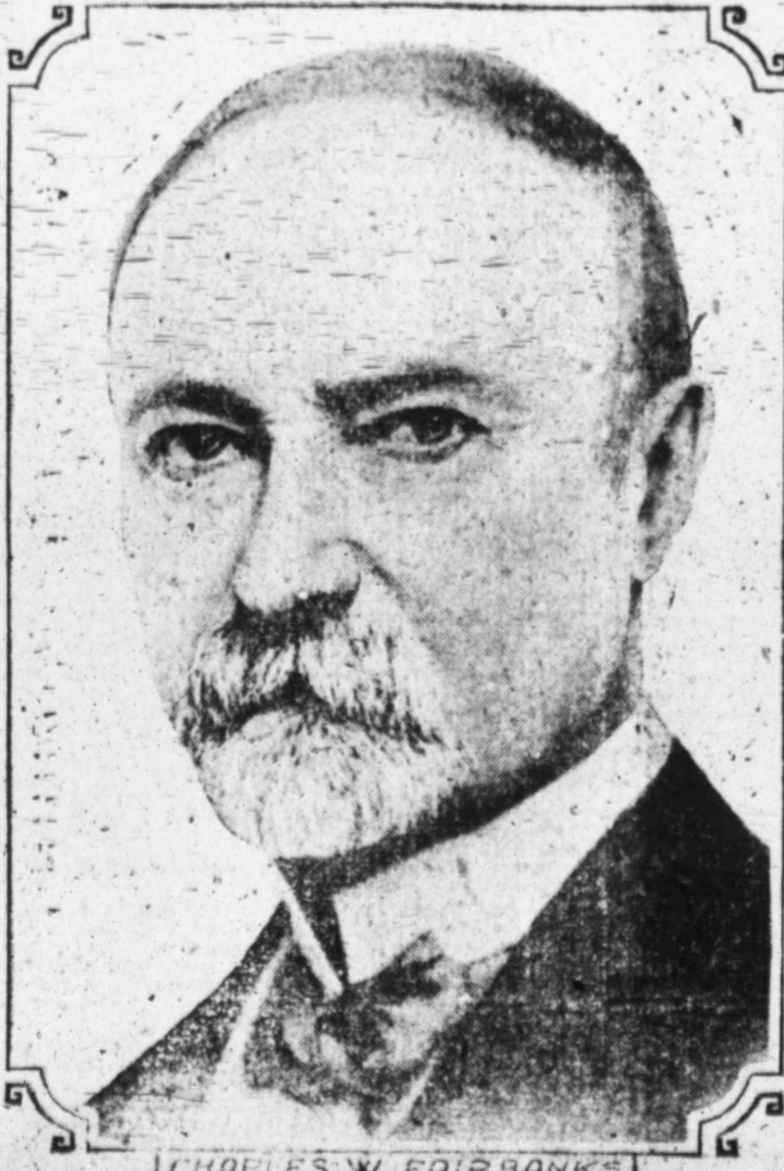
