## THE RESTAURANT STRIKE

Last evening just before the dinner hour, representatives of the Cooks and Waiters union called on restaurant members of the Open Shop Association and demanded of them that they withdraw from membership in the Open Shop Association. The union help in those places that refused to accede to this demand, immediately walked out.

On Sunday the Open Shop Association published in part a business directory of its members. Monday morning the walking delegate of the union called on all restaurants and notified them that they must not buy from those business concerns listed in the Open Shop Directory.

This strike directed against employers who have met every unreasonable demand of the union and who were living up to the strict letter of a union contract that does not expire until January 1921, is the real test of whether we are to be free Americans or bow to the despotic will of an ignorant, un-American powercrazed minority.

Good citizenship and the fair reputation of this community demand that this strike be crushed.
We call on every citizen to do his full duty and to stand by the Restaurant men of this city who are making this fight for decency and Americanism, and if need be, take the place of the strikers until workers can be-secured.
