### Another Reason Is Assigned for German Repulse

BERLIN, Jan. 18.—Failure of the German troops to keep in touch with headquarters during the last phase of the advance upon Paris in 1918 was the cause of the German repulse and the "miracle of the Marne," this assertion is made by General von Kuhl, who has written a commentary upon the government's decision to make public the war archives.

First Lieutenant Hentsch was sent to the first and second German armies with orders from the general staff which were intended to inform the commanders of the advancing troops of plans reached at headquarters. The lieutenant's failure to reach the battle zone led General von Buelow to order a retreat, and the second army followed.

### HASKELL CORPORATION PAYS \$750,000 FOR TWO TRACKS IN MEXIA FIELD

Henry Hobbs of this city, who has been with ex-Congressman Scott Ferris inspecting the Haskell holdings in the Mexia district, has purchased for that company the Coyle and Clem Carter holdings for \$750,000, according to an item in a Dallas paper. 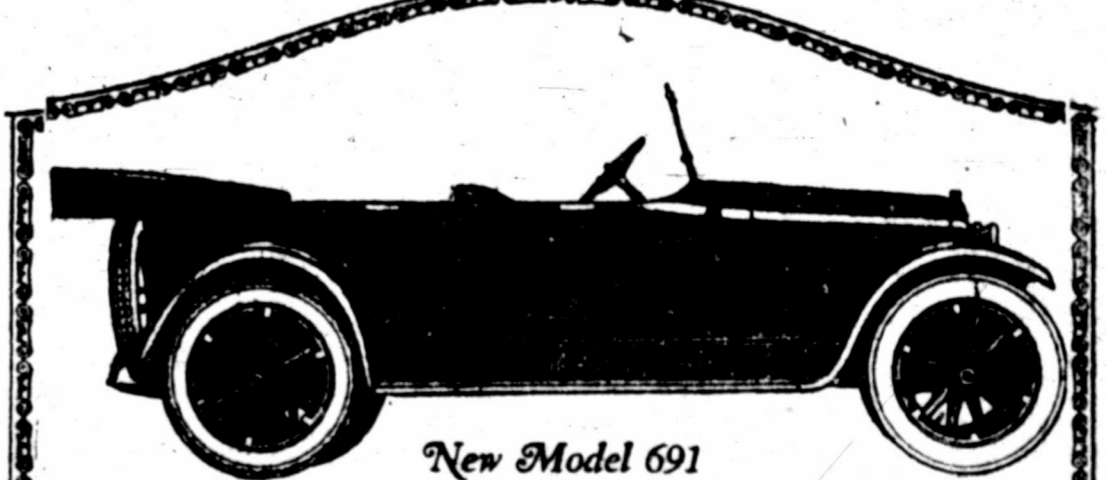
