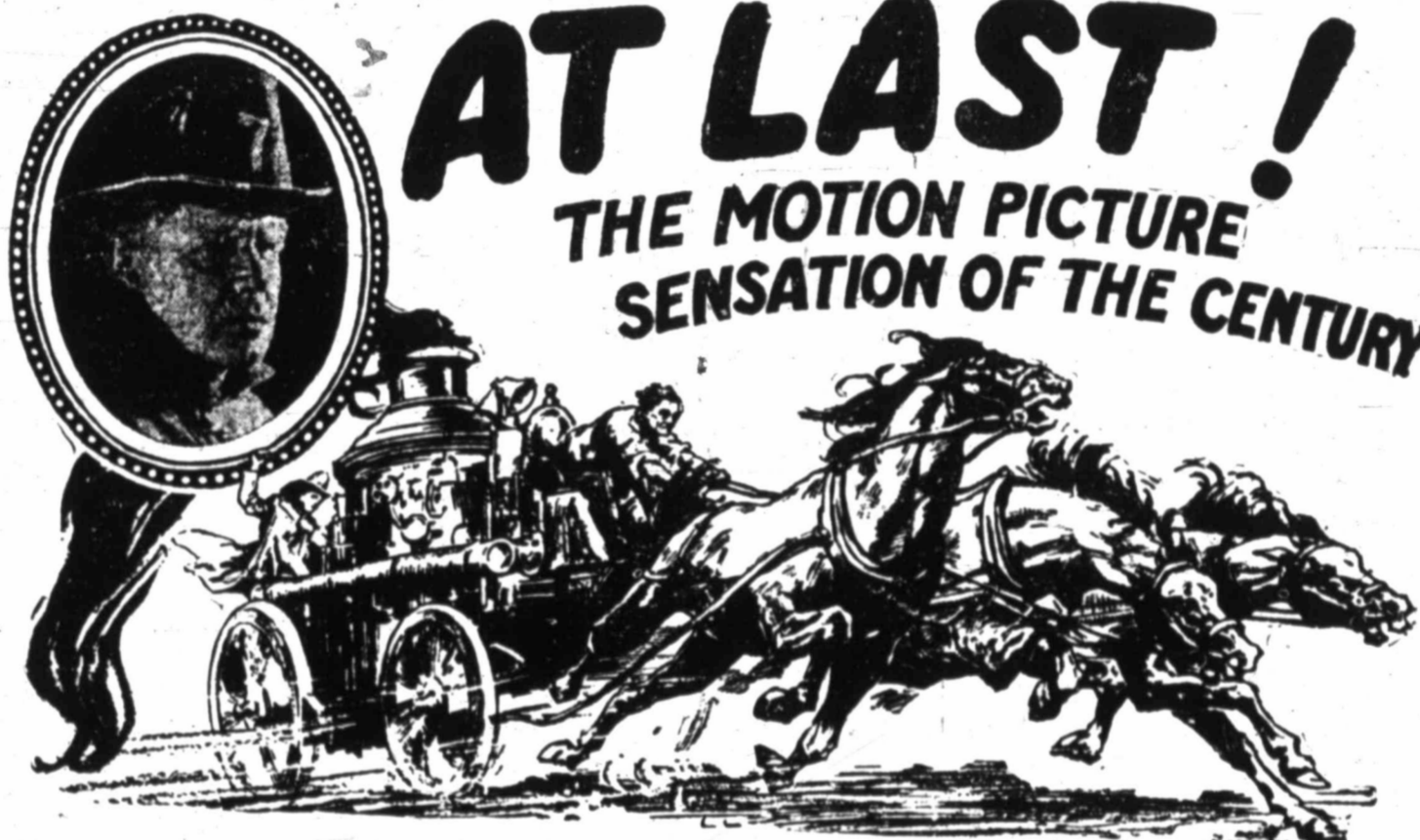

NEW YORK, Feb. 15.—The average gross crude oil production of the United States decreased 27,600 barrels for the week ending February 10, totaling 1,719,000 barrels, compared with 1,747,200 for the preceding week, according to the weekly summary of the American Petroleum Institute. The daily average production east of the Rocky mountains was 1,154,000, compared with 1,137,800 barrels.

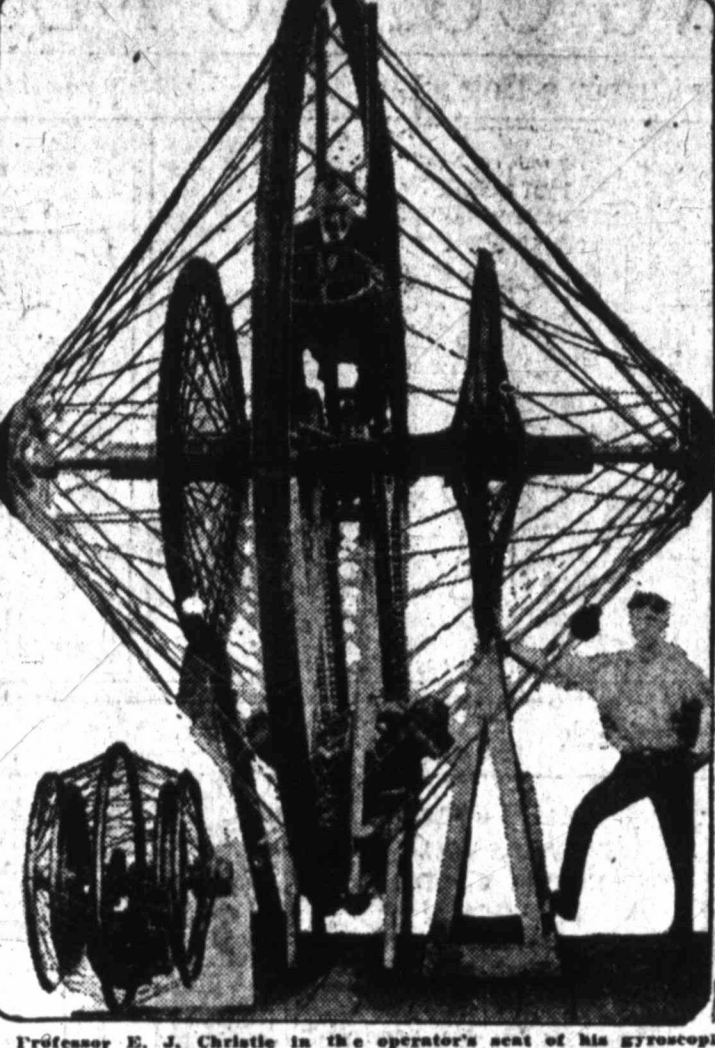

The wind continues from the north and contains a stinging touch that made it feel as though the mercury had fallen to about the 20 degree point. On the far end of the Wichita Falls & Northwestern the agents reported mercury readings from 15 to 20 degrees.

It was evident that the cold wave would remain in possession of the weather conditions for at least another 24 hours, and it is believed that approximately the same temperature will be recorded Thursday night as during the preceding one.

A LAXATIVE FOOD

Here's How to Keep Lady Nicotine From Being Put Alongside John Barleycorn

A move to forestall those who would, by a 19th amendment to the federal constitution, do to tobacco what they tried to do to the demon rum, has been started in New York. It has taken the form of a "pledge for smokers," and observance of this creed, it is considered, would make old lady nicotine less obnoxious to those who want to lay her out alongside of the supposedly late John Barleycorn.

The "pledge" was written by one Carl Avery Warner, and was given hearty endorsement at the recent tobacco exposition in New York City, according to the New York Times, which publishes it as follows:

"Notwithstanding that those who derive happiness, comfort and good-fellowship through the use of tobacco comprise 90 per cent of the male adult population of the United States, I fully realize that the majority, counting women and children, are non-smokers and that among this majority there are some to whom the fumes of tobacco are not agreeable. I take pleasure, therefore, in observing the following rules of courtesy and consideration:

"1.—I shall not smoke or carry a lighted cigar or cigarette in any place or at any time where or when, either by placard or common understanding, smoking is prohibited.

"2.—I shall not smoke in any place or at any time where or when the fumes of tobacco are obviously annoying to others, even though such abstinence is not compulsory.

SEVENTY PER CENT WOUNDS INFLECTED BY ARTILLERY FIRE

WASHINGTON, Feb. 15.—Medical records of the A. E. F. indicate that artillery fire was responsible for 70 per cent of the gunshot wounds. In the Civil war 90 per cent of the gunshot wounds were from small arms and grenades.

The statistics are based on study of 245,790 Civil war gunshot wounds records, and 147,651 similar A. E. F. returns.

Wounds resulting from artillery fire in the Civil war are classified as 2 per cent from "shell and cannon ball," the A. E. F. record showing 46 per cent under the same heading. Under "grape, canister and shrapnel," however, the A. E. F. shows 24 per cent, and Civil war records less than 1 per cent.

The figures are of interest in connection with the design for new helmets for the army. The present records merely show that 32 per cent of all gunshot wounds averaged 12 per cent to the head, face and neck; 5 per cent to the thorax; 2 per cent to the backbone and spine and 5 per cent to the abdomen and pelvis. The Civil war records follow approximately the same averages.

BRITISH AND FRENCH CABINET MINISTERS CONSIDER PROGRAM

By Associated Press. LONDON, Feb. 15.—British and French cabinet ministers met here today in a conference, which if it fails to evolve a program for British co-operation with the French and Belgians in solving the Ruhr transportation problems, is considered likely to result in the early withdrawal of the British troops from the Cologne area.

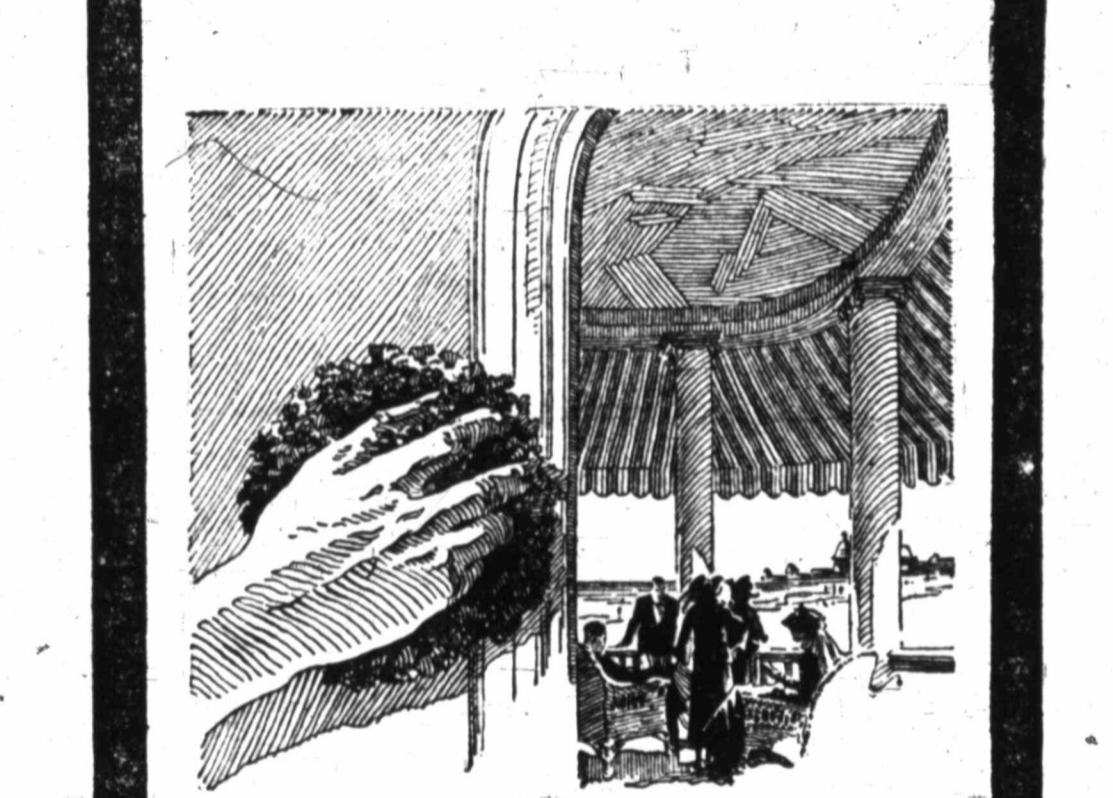
