RANGER FINDS OIL TRUCK BEING USED TO PEDDLE WHISKY

RANGER, Nov. 29.—An automobile tank car identical with those used by large companies to deliver their products is being used in the oil fields as a means of carrying on a bootlegging operation. This information has been given out by federal officials who are now making an effort to arrest the illicit liquor dealing. As they explained the system, the car has two compartments. In the rear is carried a stock of oil that is sold to camps. In the forward space is carried a quantity of moonshine whisky that also is sold from camp to camp. To carry the deuce further, "Gasoline and Oils" is the wording cross the side of the tanks, but no firm name appears. The officers say that under the driver's seat is hidden a hydrant through which the liquor is drawn and on top is a small screw cap through which the stock is taken in. With his truck the bootlegger goes from camp to camp and from town to town, officers declare, and at present has several hundred customers for his whisky. They also state that all his customers do everything they can to protect him and will not give out any information that will lead to his apprehension. So cleverly is the truck disguised that the only hope the officers have of capturing it is by meeting it face to face. They have a means of identification when this occurs, they say.
