Rule No. 1. Only bonafide members of 4 H and FFA are
eligible to compete for premiums.
The years of aetive participation in the show for 4 H and
FFA members are as follows: 4 H ages 921 inclusive; FFA memHerthip during high schiool years and 3 years following grad
bation or leaving school.
