Since he arrived at the nursing home three weeks ago, Chassion has done more than "tickle the ivories." He's been looking at the nursing home's operation and already has some suggestions for the home's board of trustees. Upgrading the facility to meet the requirements of the federal Medicare program would probably bring in the most funds, Chassion said, but a more immediate benefit would be its own linen rather than to send it out.
