has provided only two clerks and a stenographer in the office to admin-
ster the ew ister the law. He does not have a single representative to investigate

this reason the Comptroller is great-
former ly handicapped in the matier of en-

uor for medicinal purnoses uor for medicinal purposes.
The Comptroller's The Comptroller's records furnish ing the vital need of help in the mat ter of issuing and checking permits. During 1925 there were issued to

imately 4700 books of prescriptions imately 4700 books of prescriptions
of 100 each, aggregating 470,000 preor
scriptions which were isssued for one

of prescriptions issued, or 550,000 of prescriptions issued, or 550,000
prescriptions of one pint each, an increase of 80,000 pints of medicinal liquors for 1926 over 1925.
