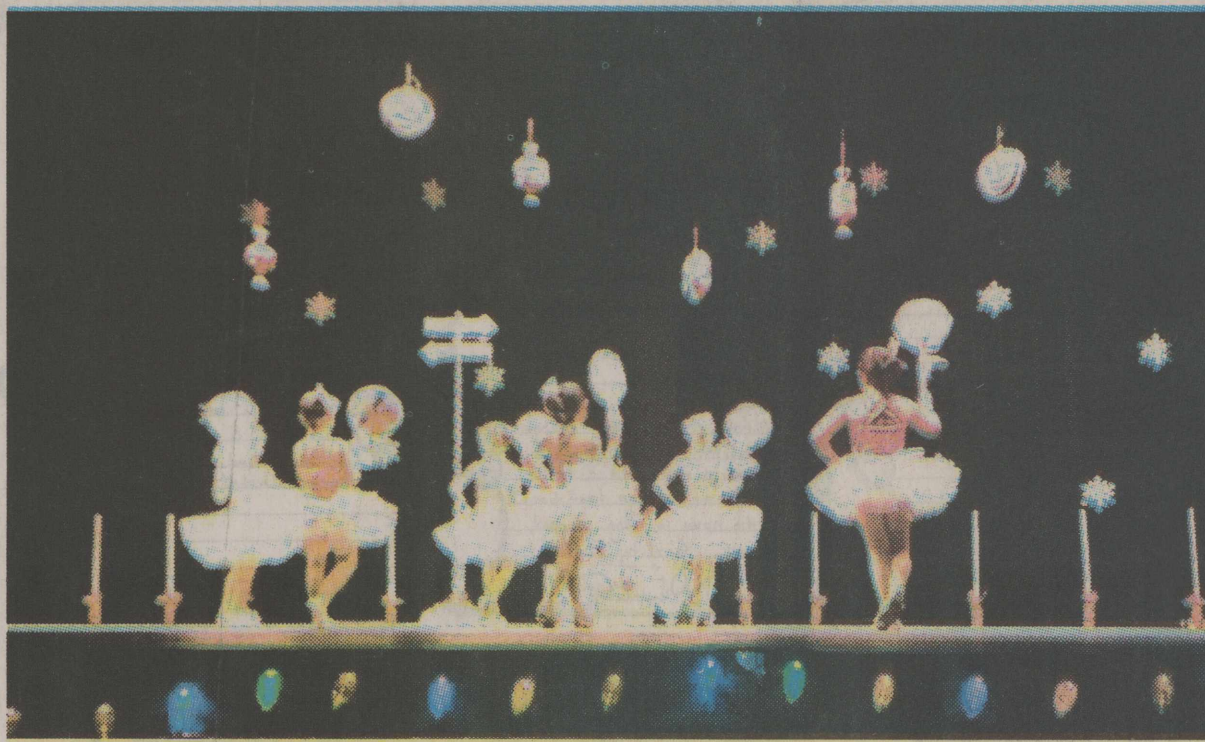

Lady Broncos 'Run and Fun' to 11-3 Record

The Lady Broncos move to 11-3 on the season by winning 3rd place at The Bank & Trust - Sonora Basketball Tournament. The highly competitive field saw Midland Christian (15-1) winning the championship but not before a hard fought battle with Sonora in the semi-finals. The Lady

Broncos started the tourney with a 72-37 victory over 3A Llano. Kylie Love (26 points), Gracie Dozier (20 points) and Tyler Hampton (12 points) paced the Lady Broncos. Naomi Dozier sparked the super subs with nice jumper and a 3 pointer for 5 points. Katie Hartman ran the fast breaking offense

with 6 assists. In the second game, Sonora beat Junction 69-41 behind Gracie and Kylie's 22 points each. Katie again led in 'dishes' with 4 and also hit a nice three pointer. JoJo Gutierrez played a huge role by scoring 8 points in 52 seconds to end the second quarter. In the semi-final game, Sonora battled Midland Christian 51-59. Sonora could not wear down Midland's deep bench and sharp shooters. Kylie's 23 points and Gracie's 13 led the Lady Broncos' effort. In the third place game Saturday against Harper (58-30), Zella Powers played her best game of the year grabbing 10 rebounds and sneaking 5 steals. Kylie and Gracie both scored 13 while Tyler Hampton had 9 points and 9 rebounds to go with her 4 blocks. Janelle Vasquez scored 7 with 5 thefts and Cip Tobias saw had positive contribution in extended minutes off the bench. The Sonora teams play Christoval in Sonora on Tuesday (12/17) and then travel to the AT&T Center in San Antonio on Saturday (12/21) to play Harper and to attend the San Antonio Spurs vs. Oklahoma City Thunder game.

Cold Weather Affects Livestock Nutritional Needs

Though our winters are generally mild, we do experience cold spells. Proper livestock nutrition during cold weather is an important management consideration. Severe weather during the winter months can lead to weight loss and reduced performance. Animals exposed to cold weather require more energy to maintain rate of gain, body condition, and to maintain body temperatures.

Other factors also come into play. The breed of animal, back fat thickness and the stage of production have a sizable influence on the energy requirements of an animal, during cold weather. During lactation, animals require 40 to 60% more energy compared to the gestation period. If lactation occurs during cold weather, the female's ability to maintain condition and continue to provide milk will be seriously compromised if energy levels are not sufficient in the ration.

Thicker skinned animals have more insulation, reducing the amount of additional energy that the animal requires. Thin animals require more energy for maintenance than fat ones. The more subcutaneous fat an animal has, the greater the ability to withstand colder temperatures. Females that lose weight prior to giving birth can end up with weaker offspring and poorer rebreeding rates.

An increased wind speed reduces the hair coat insulation and increases maintenance requirements when the animal is cold stressed. The hair coat insulation value is also reduced when the animal is wet or muddy. Extended cold winters can be hard on livestock. So pay attention not only to forage availability, but to the animal's body condition. This is the obvious indicator that supplemental feed is required. It is important to note that during cold spells, time of feeding may be significant. The energy from feed that is available to keep an animal's body warm is known as the heat increment of feeding. Incremental heat production is at its maximum 4 to 6 hours after the feed is consumed. Therefore, feeding late in the afternoon provides higher amounts of heat from fermentation overnight when temperatures are lowest, making the most efficient use of your feed supplies and meeting livestock's energy requirements.
