### Balloon launch gets results

Pupils at Ozona Primary School received a postcard that traveled from Ozona to O.C. Fisher Lake near San Angelo the hard way. The card was attached to a helium-filled balloon launched at the school on March 19. The launch was part of the new Writing Pals program sponsored by Weekly Reader, the classroom newspaper. It was found by Ed Truck-

enbrodt of San Angelo and returned to the Ozona Primary School, according to Principal Probst. Distance from Ozona to O.C. Fisher Lake is about 80 miles. The card is the first returned, out of one hundred cards tied to balloons sent up by the second grades at Ozona Primary. On the return card Ed Truckenbrodt wrote, "Hi Balloon Senders!

While hiking far from the off beaten path at O.C. Fisher Lake, I found a balloon that had run out of gas. Next time try premium gas instead of regular for more distance than 80 miles.

### Correction for bean cake recipe

**RECIPE CORRECTION**  
A recipe printed in last week's paper was in error, in fact, was the wrong recipe, according to Mary Lea Jones. The correct recipe for Mrs. Jones' Pinto Bean Cake follows:

**PINTO BEAN CAKE**  
2 cups home cooked mashed beans  
2 cups pineapple preserves  
1 cup sugar  
1/2 cup shortening  
2 beaten eggs  
1 cup flour  
1 teaspoon soda  
1/2 teaspoon salt  
1 teaspoon cinnamon  
1/4 teaspoon each cloves and allspice  
1 teaspoon vanilla  
1 cup raisins  
1 cup chopped nuts

Cream shortening and sugar, add eggs, mashed beans and preserves. Sift dry ingredients together and add gradually to the above. Fold in nuts, raisins and vanilla. Bake in well greased pan (long pyrex pan) at 350 degrees for 45 minutes or until a knife inserted comes out clean.

### Confirmation in county multi-pay

J. Cleo Thompson, No. 4 J.W. Childress "B", fifth Strawn producer and 3/4-mile northwest of the nearest Strawn production in a southwest extension area of the Crockett County portion of the Ozona, Northeast multi-pay field, 7 1/2 miles east of Ozona, was finalized for a calculated, absolute open flow of 1,700,000 cubic feet of gas daily. Gravity of the

condensate is 61.2 feet and the gas liquid ratio of 47,356-1.

Production was through open hole at 8,770-8,798 feet. Location is 1,320 feet from the south and west lines of 35-GH-GC&SF.

The Ellenburger and Canyon zones have extended across the line into Schleicher County.

Ozona varsity boys tracksters earned a respectable third place in the Sonora Relays Saturday, finishing behind their host Sonora and Junction. They will travel to Alpine Friday and spend next week getting ready for the district meet which will be held here April 7.

The team chalked up their best times of the year in the high jump, the 440 relay, the 440 dash, the mile run and the mile relay. Johnny Rodriguez set a new school record in his first place win in the mile run with a time of 4:42.2.

The 440 relay team of Ramos, Borrego, Sewell and Tambunga, placed fifth with a time of 46.8 Dan Martinez placed third in the 880 with a time of 2:10.4. Fred Garza placed third and Dan Sewell fifth in the 110 dash with 15.9 and 16.1 respectively. Randy Ramos earned first place in the 440 with 52.6, and Rudy Martinez placed fifth with 55.2.
