A farmer today has to feed himself and fifteen other people. Back in 1930 he had to supply food for 11 other people. By 1975, exp It would be niee it there were more land. But last year there
was only $1 \%$ more land under cultivation than prewar was only $1 \%$ more land under cultivation than prewar.

were spent in articulter last were spent in agriculture last year.
