

Crockett County's State dollars for the 1998-99 pro-Emerald Underground Water District became a member of the association last year. That was the first of a fouryear contract the association made with Pat Sweeney, owner of Weather Modification Inc. of Fargo, ND.

Two planes, a Cheyenne and a Cessna 340, are flying an area which includes Crockett, Glasscock, Sterling, Reagan, Irion, Schleicher, Sutsaid Dennis Clark, EUWD manager. The area covered includes 7.2 million acres at a cost of .042 cents per acre. Funding comes from the districts involved plus \$50,000 from the University of Texas, \$40,000 from the City of San Angelo and \$169,000 from an emergency appropriation by the State



"Remember the Sabbath to Keep it Holy." This is an important statement - we need a day of unhurried time when we can slow down, speak to the deepest parts of our being and open







#### **Homebuilders Need To Consider New Regulations**

Anyone building their dream systems that will protect the environhome in the country needs to consider ment and the homeowner. new state regulations to keep their wastewater system from turning into a nightmare.

According to Dr. Bruce Lesikar, agricultural engineer with the Texas Agricultural Extension Service, the new on-site wastewater regulations, which went into effect in February, protect not only the environment but homeowners as well.

One-fourth of Texans, or about 4 million people, presently use on-site wastewater treatment systems. More and more are being installed each year as people build homes in areas that do not have centralized collection sys-

Under the new state regulations, installers must be certified to put in either the traditional type of septic systems or the newer types of systems which provide additional treatment of the wastewater. These may include a septic system and a drain field that some of the newer technologies such as pressurized distribution, sub-surface irrigation or spray irriga-

"The new set of regulations actually give guidance on how newer, alternative technologies can be installed and operated so that they work correctly," Lesikar said.

Installers also must stay up-to-

Site evaluators — who examine the site to determine which type of system will work best — also will have to be certified under the new regulations, he said. They are required to take eight hours of training annu-

Systems that are already installed under previous regulations are not really affected by these rules unless there is a problem and they have to undergo major renovation, he said. "Then you need to bring up those existing systems to current regulations," Lesikar added.

Permits have been required for systems for several years. If an agency in a county issues permits, fees may or may not increase. The fees charged by the Texas Natural Resource Conservation Commission in areas not covered by a local permitting authority will increase to \$200 for a singlefamily residence.



Since Ozona's weekly problems may be somewhat different than those in San Angelo, we are looking forward to your input and question. All you need to do is give us a call (it's local now) and be sure to let us know that you are calling from Ozona. Myself, Mike Glaspie, or my partner, Ronnie Winkler, take turns writing the articles.

Now on to business. This week we are seeing quite a few trees, especially sycamores, being lunch for worms. If the tree is not an edible variety, you can use a systemic insecticide such as orthene. This will kill the insects it comes in contact with, and incorporate itself into the leaves, and any insect that eats any part of that leaf within 10-14 days will ingest the insecticide. This gives you twice the chances to kill the insects. Also if you had problems last year with brown patches in your St. Augustine or Fescue lawns, you need to start with preventative applications of Bayleton. This can be purchased in granular or liquid forms. Preventative applications are at 1/2 the curative rates, so you can save money by not waiting until the disease starts. If you have any question, please give us a call or come by.
