

turkey or chicken broth to mois-



1/2 c. Crisco 1/2 c. sugar 2 eggs 2 1/2 c. flour 2 tsp. baking powder 1/2 tsp. soda 1/2 tsp. salt 1 tsp. each cinnamon and nutmeg (1 tsp. ginger if you like it) 1 c. Grandma's Molasses 1 c. boiling water Cream Crisco and sugar. Add cggs and beat thoroughly. Add molasses.

Mix dry ingredients together (I don't sift, so I add a little less flour than called for) and stir in. Add boiling water last. Pour into a Pam-sprayed 9x12 pan and bake at 350 degrees until done.

Apricot Sherbet

Bring to a boil one quart water, one quart sugar. Let cool. This can be done a day ahead and refrigerated.







Tenth Annual Hunter Education Camp Completed

Since June 1988, volunteer instructors, contributors, sponsors and concerned citizens of Crockett County and the surrounding area have assisted students from Ozona and nearby counties in successful completion of the Texas Parks and WIldlife Department's Hunter Education Course. The 10th annual West Texas Hunter Education Camp was held on the Gene Perry Ranch in Crockett County on June 6, 7 and 8, 1997. Seven girls and 18 boys ages 12-15 were successfully certified for hunter safety as per a mandatory hunter education law that went into effect on June 1, 1988.





Ozona Chamber of Commerce's featured member this week is Ozona Wool and Mohair. The corporation as it is today was started in 1984 by local ranchers, according to assistant manager Joe Will Ross. We are pleased that the price of wool is higher compared to last year," said Ross. "We wish mohair would get on track. There are not very many goats left in this country." There has been some recent movement in the mohair market, Ross said.

Ozona Wool and Mohair conducts sales at its warehouse, sells by private treaty and also cooperates with Producers Marketing Cooperative in San Angelo.





When it starts to get hot outside, it sure feels good inside under the A/C.

Unfortunately, we can't ignore our land scapes. Here are a few of the summer time high points.

1) If your lawn is growing fine but it needs a green-up, apply an iron product such as lonate. If you need to grow & green, then use the lawn tonic, 14-0-0 with 10% iron. This will excite some new growth and put in the green.

2) Check your roses for diseases such as powdery mildew and black spot. Also checking for aphids and thrip damage. Use Fertilome Rose Spray, This will treat both disease and insects with one product. Be sure to feed roses regularly. They are heavy eaters this time of year.

3) If you have put down any St. Augustine sod recently, check for new growth. When this happens, you can start to use a foliar fertilizer such as Hasta-Gro or Miracle Grow's Hose End Feeder. You should feed the grass every 2 weeks for the rest of the growing season.

4) With all the rains, you should be seeing more fire ant mounds than usual. If so use the 2-step approach of Amidro and Orthene. Ronnie wrote on this application last week

Librarian Certification

Librarian Louise Ledoux has just received notification from Edward Seidenberg, director of the Library Development Division of the Texas State Library, of renewal of certification as county librarian in Texas through 1999. For renewal, librarians must receive a minimum of 20 hours of continuing education, or earn three hours of college credit every two years. Mrs. Ledoux has held a Grade II Certification since taking the job of Crockett County librarian in 1984.

Certification requirements are set by the Texas Legislature and include a Grade I Certificate which is permanent for anyone holding a fifth-year degree in librarianship accredited by the American Library Association, or a master's degree in library or information science. Most large metropolitan libraries require a Grade I Certificate for all library positions. A twoyear Grade II Certificate is required for employment in any city/county library having a service area with a population of 25,000 or fewer persons and requires graduation from an accredited senior college or university. A two-year Grade III Certificate is similar to Grade II, but is for a service area with a population of 10,000 or fewer persons and only requires graduation from high school or GED.







CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT SPECIAL ELECTION AUGUST 9, 1997

PROPOSITION NO.1 ON THE BALLOT

House Joint Resolution 4 proposes a constitutional amendment which would increase the school property tax residence homestead exemption from \$5,000 to \$15,000. The amendment would also authorize the Legislature to limit all or part of the exemption to political subdivisions that are the principal providers of elementary and secondary education within their boundaries.

In addition, the amendment would authorize the Legislature to allow the transfer of all or part of the age 65-and-over tax freeze to another homestead. Specifically, the Legislature would be authorized to provide that the current limitation against increasing school property taxes on the residence homesteads of persons age 65 or older, or their surviving spouse who is eligible to receive the exemption, may be transferred if the person establishes a different residence homestead.

The amendment would also allow the \$10,000 additional amount for the standard exemption to be used to lower the tax rate of persons cur-

rently receiving the 65-and-over tax freeze. Specifically, for a homestead affected by this limitation in 1996 or in an earlier tax year, the Legislature must provide for a reduction in the school property tax limitation in the 1997 tax year and subsequent tax years in an amount equal to \$10,000 multiplied by the 1997 school property tax rate.

The proposed amendment will appear on the ballot as follows:

"The constitutional amendment providing school property tax relief by increasing the residence homestead exemption by \$10,000 and providing for the transfer of the tax limitation to another qualified homestead for persons over 65 and a reduction in taxes subject to the limitation.'





plication may be granted administratively if no protest to the application is received. An affected person is entitled to protest this application. Affected persons include owners of record and the operator or lessees of record of adjacent tracts and tracts nearer to the proposed well than the minimum lease line spacing distance. A protestant should be prepared to establish standing as an affected person, and to appear at the hearing either in person or by qualified representative and protest the application with cross-examination or presentation of a direct case.
