SWTEC will assign its exist-Lyntegar Electric Cooperative, ing wholesale power contract to Golden Spread. As soon as all required contractual and regulatory approvals can be obtained, Golden Spread will become responsible for supplying electricity to these new members.

Golden Spread and its 16 member systems serve approximately 184,000 meters in 80 counties. Their combined load exceeds 1,000 megawatts, and they operate 68,400 miles of energized line. Total annual revenues are more than \$300 million.


Golden Spread generates a portion of its members' electricity needs and purchases the balance from other wholesalers. Golden Spread also sells energy to other utilities when its power supply resources are not needed to serve member system loads.

Golden Spread owns 50 percent of Mustang Station, a stateof-the-art generating facility lolarge gas turbine-generators to produce 300 megawatts of power. Exhaust heat from the gas turbines is converted to steam to power a fuel cost. The combined output of Mustang Station is 480 mega-

Ozona Garden Club Tips

By Esther Williams

My mother loved poinsettias. Because she had a December birthday, nieces, nephews and friends would fill our home with her favorite. Later in life, poinsettias took the place of her putting up a tree. She knew they would be coming and looked forward to their arrival.

I learned from Vivian's program that in 1825 Joel Roberts Poinsett, the first U.S. Ambassador to Mexico, was responsible for bringing back poinsettia cuttings to his greenhouse in South Carolina. Poinsettias are native to Mexico. In nature poinsettias are perennial flowering shrubs that can grow up to 10 feet tall. Now they grow commercially in all of our 50 states. California is the top producing state.

Poinsettias should be placed in a sunny location. Water when the soil is dry. They also can be placed in a sink and watered from the bottom up. Do not fertilize when the plant is in bloom. It is best to avoid warm and cold

The Christmas cactus is another potted plant that is popular during the holiday season. It also originated way down south of us - South America. These succulents were taken to Europe and crossed by breeders. Because the stems resemble crab claws they also are known as a crab cactus. They



Although they are succulents. They prefer moist, well-drained soil. Water your plant when the soil begins to become dry to touch. It needs bright, indirect light. Once your plant begins to bud and bloom, don't move it. It may stop blooming. After it finishes blooming, stop watering it as much and allow it to rest for severaly months. Then begin a regular watering and feeding schedule.

Christmas cactus prefer to be pot bound. So you may only need to add soil in the early spring. Southern Living, Dec. 2002, p. 97 has an excellent article on rooting cuttings and dividing your plant to share with friends.



Register for food manager certification course

During the past legislative session, a statute was amended that allowed the Texas Department of Health (TDH) to require each food establishment to have one certified food manager.

Recently, the Texas Board of Health adopted rules to implement this statute. Many of you have already received a letter from the Texas Department of Health regarding this. Under these new rules, each food establishment permitted by the Texas Department of Health must have one certified food manager. New food manager certificates will be valid for five years.
