

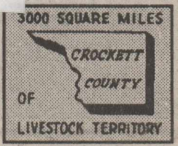

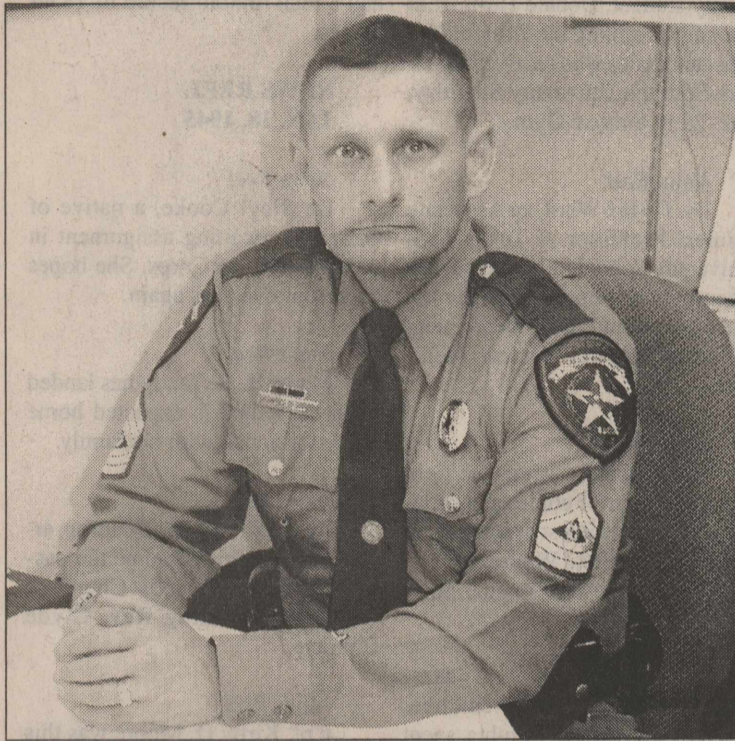

## Local 1st Marine Sgt. reflects on Saddam's capture

Ozona and the nation awoke Sunday to the news of the capture of Saddam Hussein, fallen Iraqi dictator. The news had special import to a number of people here whose family members are serving in those far away places, Iraq, Kuwait, Afghanistan.

"He was in the condition I expected, hiding like a rat like Maj. Gen. Raymond Odierno said," commented 1st Marine Sgt. Carl Mayfield. Troops from the 41st Infantry under Odierno's command at Fort Hood captured Hussein.

Mayfield, a reservist who was called to duty in February, is also the Department of Public Safety sergeant here, overseeing a five-county area.

"It was quite a relief to see we finally got Saddam in hand," said Mayfield of his reaction to the television news Sunday. "We've not had much luck capturing terrorists."

He believes Hussein fled to another country after he was ousted from power, "possibly to Syria and they asked him to leave." The fugitive, believed to have many hiding places, was found in a small chamber beneath a mud hut near Adwar 10 miles from his hometown of Tikrit and across the Tigris River from his elaborate palaces.

Moving from place to place to hide was made easier by the clothing worn in Iraq said Mayfield. "The culture there, the way they dress, makes it hard to see someone passing by in a vehicle and pick him out."

Mayfield went to Kuwait in February and entered Iraq on March 21. He was Company 1st Sgt. for a transport supply group - bulk liquids. His company hauled supplies to the front from the main base on the Kuwait/Iraq border. There were several forward staging areas. His company

saw combat at Nasiriyah, Al Kut, outside Baghdad and at Tikrit, Mayfield said.

As he went about his duties with the supply group, Mayfield saw many citizens on the sides of the road. In a town at their Edison Base southwest of Baghdad, "I went into one of their malls, which was more like a flea market in a back alley. People were very glad to see us."

The major of Iraqis were very friendly according to Mayfield. "They don't see Americans often, and when they do, they want to touch you and talk in broken English." This closeness is difficult for Americans who do not easily accept people being so close to them.

Mayfield believes things are now on the downhill side in Iraq. Things will move more quickly with rotation of Marines as of January or February. This will happen through 2004 as more

Marine reserve units are called up. "We'll be there quite some time. Possibly the capture of Saddam will help the people become more confident with taking over their own country. With him captured, they will be more willing to step up and take charge."

"I haven't heard what country they will have his trial in," Mayfield said Monday. "I'm sure Turkey would be more than happy to try him. I think he will go to trial and be incarcerated somewhere for the rest of his life. I know one thing, he will never rule a country again."

Mayfield believes Saddam has had weapons of mass destruction hidden somewhere. "That is secondary to me," he said. "He needed to be ousted. We would have had to deal with Saddam sooner or later. It's better that we did it on our own terms rather than his."

## Southwest Texas electric co-op joins Golden Spread

Southwest Texas Electric Cooperative (SWTEC), based in Eldorado, has joined Golden Spread Electric Cooperative, a generation and transmission cooperative now owned by 16 electric distribution cooperatives.

New members of the alliance in addition to SWTEC are Coleman County Electric Co-op, headquartered in Coleman; Concho Valley Electric Co-op, headquartered in San Angelo; Lyntegar Electric Cooperative, headquartered in Tahoka; and Taylor Electric Co-op, headquartered in Merkel.

Based in Amarillo, Golden Spread is a consumer-owned public utility organized in 1984 to provide low cost, reliable electric service for 11 rural distribution cooperatives. The original member cooperatives are located in the Texas Panhandle, the Oklahoma Panhandle and the Texas South Plains. The new member co-ops serve counties in West Texas and the Edwards Plateau region.

"I am confident that joining Golden Spread Electric Co-op will help stabilize our power costs in the uncertain times ahead," said William "Buff" Whitten, SWTEC general manager. "The mission of member-owned cooperatives is to provide the best service at the most reasonable cost available."

Robert W. Bryant, president and general manager of Golden Spread Electric Co-op, said, "We are pleased that Southwest Texas Electric Co-op has joined our innovative and growing network of member-owned electric providers."

"Golden Spread is dedicated to providing solutions for generating and delivering electric power for area distribution coop-

eratives. We provide crucial flexibility and a smart hedge against future energy variables in a volatile industry," Bryant said.

SWTEC, organized in 1944, has approximately 8,350 meters serving customers in Schleicher, Menard, Sutton, Tom Green, Irion, Reagan, Upton, Crockett, Pecos, Val Verde, Concho and Edwards counties. SWTEC has 4,924 miles of energized line.

SWTEC will assign its existing wholesale power contract to Golden Spread. As soon as all required contractual and regulatory approvals can be obtained, Golden Spread will become responsible for supplying electricity to these new members.

Golden Spread and its 16 member systems serve approximately 184,000 meters in 80 counties. Their combined load exceeds 1,000 megawatts, and they operate 68,400 miles of energized line. Total annual revenues are more than \$300 million.

Golden Spread generates a portion of its members' electricity needs and purchases the balance from other wholesalers. Golden Spread also sells energy to other utilities when its power supply resources are not needed to serve member system loads.

Golden Spread owns 50 percent of Mustang Station, a state-of-the-art generating facility located near Denver City. Mustang Station burns natural gas in two large gas turbine-generators to produce 300 megawatts of power. Exhaust heat from the gas turbines is converted to steam to power a third generator with no additional fuel cost. The combined output of Mustang Station is 480 megawatts.

## Nicks files for Commissioner

Freddie Nicks has filed as a candidate for Commissioner, Precinct 3, subject to the March Democratic Primary.

Nicks is running for his fourth term as a Crockett County commissioner and will have completed 12 years in the office at the end of his present term.

He has 24 years of experience in road building with the Texas Department of Transportation and has completed 176 hours of commissioner schooling.

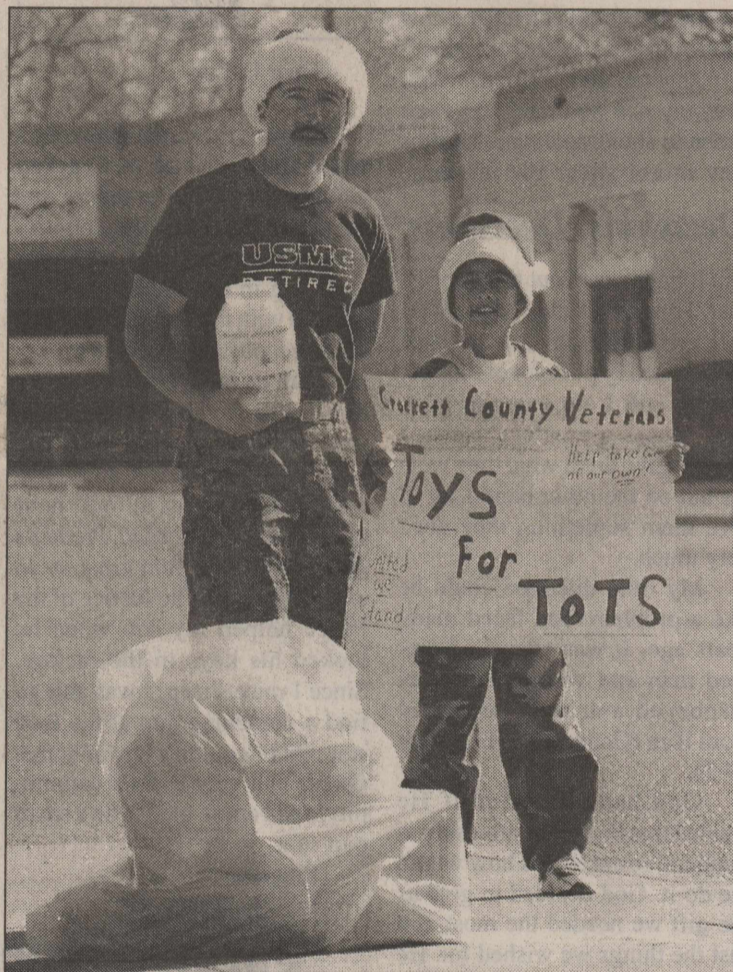
Pat and Freddie Nicks' son Weldon and his wife, Barbara, live in Ozona. There are two grandsons and two step-grandsons.

### Ozona Garden Club Tips

By Esther Williams

My mother loved poinsettias. Because she had a December birthday, nieces, nephews and friends would fill our home with her favorite. Later in life, poinsettias took the place of her putting up a tree. She knew they would be coming and looked forward to their arrival.

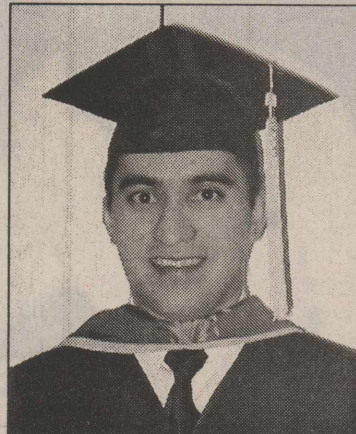
I learned from Vivian's program that in 1825 Joel Roberts Poinsett, the first U. S. Ambassador to Mexico, was responsible for bringing back poinsettia cuttings to his greenhouse in South Carolina. Poinsettias are native to Mexico. In nature poinsettias are perennial flowering shrubs that can grow up to 10 feet tall. Now they grow commercially in all of our 50 states. California is the top producing state.

Poinsettias should be placed in a sunny location. Water when the soil is dry. They also can be placed in a sink and watered from the bottom up. Do not fertilize when the plant is in bloom. It is best to avoid warm and cold drafts.

The Christmas cactus is another potted plant that is popular during the holiday season. It also originated way down south of us - South America. These succulents were taken to Europe and crossed by breeders. Because the stems resemble crab claws they also are known as a crab cactus. They

make beautiful hanging baskets. Although they are succulents. They prefer moist, well-drained soil. Water your plant when the soil begins to become dry to touch. It needs bright, indirect light. Once your plant begins to bud and bloom, don't move it. It may stop blooming. After it finishes blooming, stop watering it as much and allow it to rest for several months. Then begin a regular watering and feeding schedule.

Christmas cactus prefer to be pot bound. So you may only need to add soil in the early spring. *Southern Living*, Dec. 2002, p. 97 has an excellent article on rooting cuttings and dividing your plant to share with friends.

This is what the holiday season is all about.

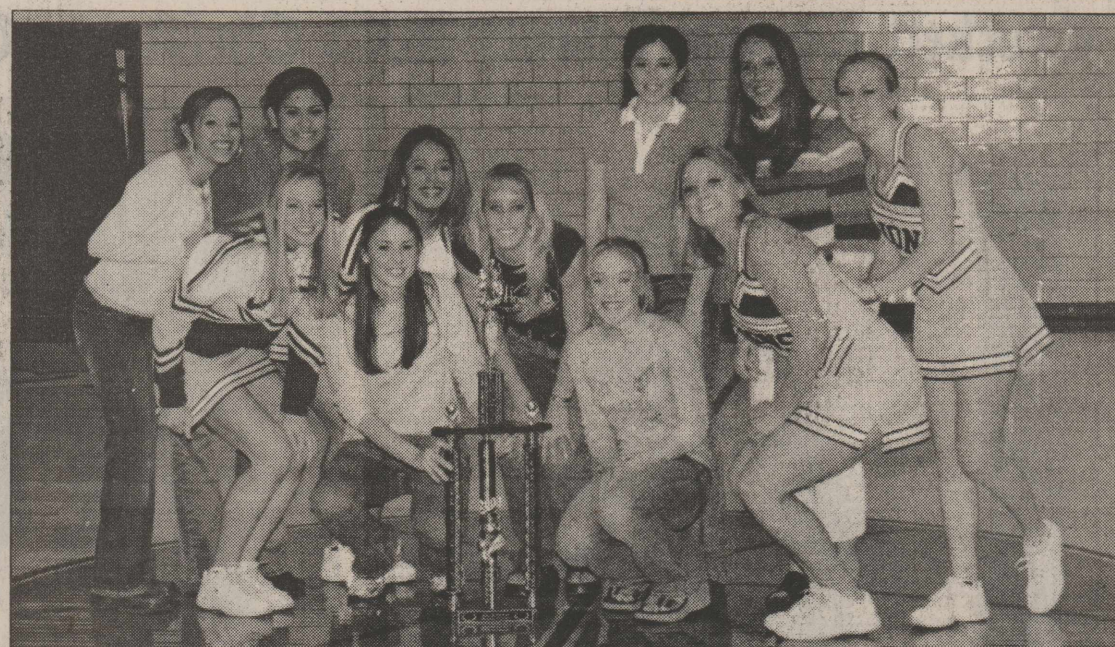

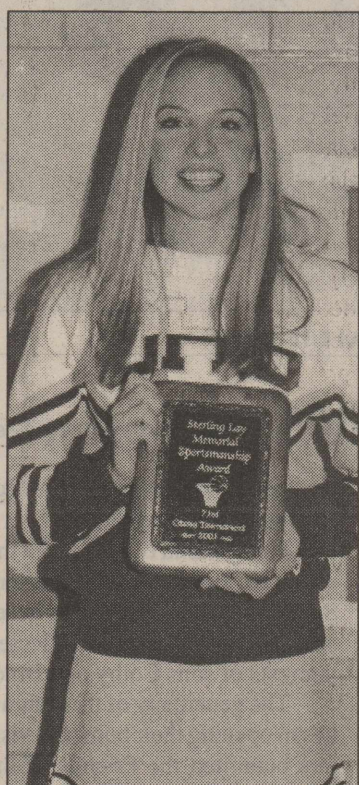

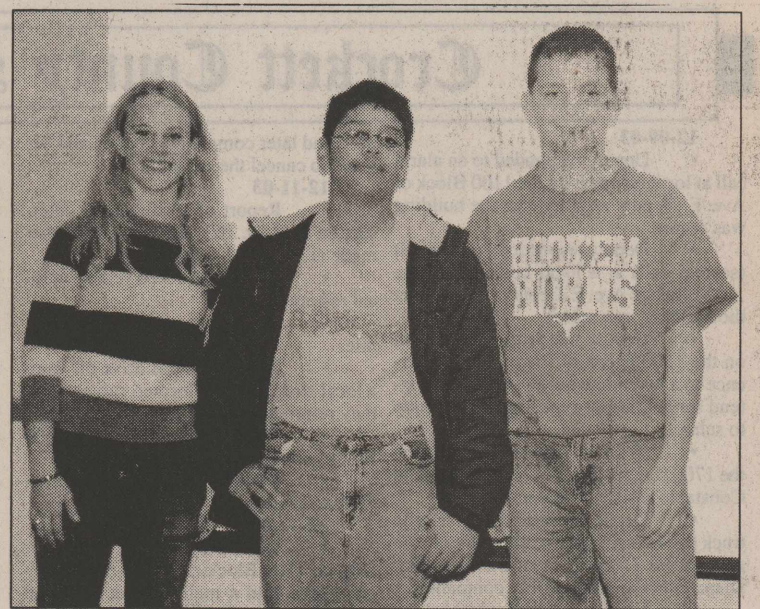

There are a lot of things I have learned in the past few weeks that have helped me in my everyday life. These are some of the very strong concepts that I have learned. What D.A.R.E. stands for. ## Wings Across Texas flies to Ozona for a presentation at middle school

Wings Across Texas is an experimental learning tool for middle and junior high school students. It is partnered with the PEER Project (funded by the national Institute of Environmental Health Sciences) and Texas A&M University. Dr. Jon Hunter has made 148 presentations to 44 rural schools around Texas. On Dec. 9, Dr. Hunter and his son flew to Ozona in a Cirrus SR22 aircraft, the only aircraft of its kind that can land using a parachute deployed by a rocket booster. They presented a fun and educationally interactive program to the Gifted and Talented Classes.

Dr. Hunter started the program with a presentation called *Texas-1867*. In this adventure, two boys travel back in time to investigate the yellow fever epidemic. Some of the history surrounding Sam Houston's family, the lifestyle during this period of Texas history, and the devastating effects of yellow fever are discovered during the time travels of these teenage boys Using keypads and a wireless response system, six groups of three students from Mrs. Childress' 6th, 7th and 8th grade G/T classes answered a series of English, social studies, science and mathematics questions pertaining to yellow fever and

Texas in 1867. The format for this activity is a team competition. The take-home messages in these activities relate to the mechanisms for spreading communicable diseases and the processes involved in solving medical questions.

The second presentation was titled *Water - You Thinking!* Again, the groups of students used the interactive question - answer format to predict the effects of acid rain, excess fertilizer, heating, silt and stagnation on water quality. After teams made their predictions, a student volunteer would perturb the water supply. Graphical measurements of the effects of the perturbation were projected and team responses and scores were displayed. Both immediate and longterm environmental effects were considered and discussed.

At the end of the presentation, team scores were tallied. Two teams were tied, so Dr. Hunter asked two tie-breaking questions. The team of Lalo Longoria, Ben Flores and Julia Henderson was the ultimate winner. Each team member chose a Texas Instrument calculator as their prize. Mrs. Childress and the students thank Jon Hunter and all the sponsors that made Wings Across Texas possible in Ozona.

## Register for food manager certification course

Statistics indicate that foodborne illness continues to be a health issue in the United States. Each year, one in four Americans will become sick, one in 1,000 will become hospitalized, and 5,000 will die due to a foodborne illness.

During the past legislative session, a statute was amended that allowed the Texas Department of Health (TDH) to require each food establishment to have one certified food manager.

Recently, the Texas Board of Health adopted rules to implement this statute. Many of you have already received a letter from the Texas Department of Health regarding this. Under these new rules, each food establishment permitted by the Texas Department of Health must have one certified food manager. New food manager certificates will be valid for five years.

Texas Cooperative Extension, Crockett County, is offering a food manager certification training course. This program will be offered for \$90.00 on Jan. 13-14 at Crockett County Extension Office. The program will begin at 8:00 a.m. on both days. You must register at the Extension Office before Dec. 31. Cost includes training, materials, and the State food manager certification examination.

This program is designed to not only prepare foodservice managers to pass the certification examination; it will provide valuable education regarding the safe handling of food. Almost 50 cents of every dollar Americans spend on food is spent on meals prepared away from home. Therefore, careful attention to food safety will help keep customers safe and satisfied.

Foodborne illnesses are estimated to cost thousands of dollars in lost wages, insurance and medical bills. With these statistics, knowledge of how to prevent foodborne illness is essential. The benefits of improved food safety include:

- Increased customer satisfaction
- Improved relationships with health officials
- Prevention of bad publicity and lawsuits due to foodborne illnesses.
- By attending the course, foodservice managers will learn about:
  - Identifying potentially hazardous foods and common errors in food handling
  - Preventing contamination and cross-contamination of food
  - Teaching and encouraging personal hygiene for employees
  - Complying with government regulations
  - Maintaining clean utensils, equipment and surroundings
  - Controlling pests.

Foodborne illnesses can be prevented by following simple food safety practices. For more information about the Food Manager Certification Training course of Texas Cooperative Extension, called "Food Safety: It's Our Business," Call Wendy Scott, County Extension Agent-Family and Consumer Sciences at 392-2721.
