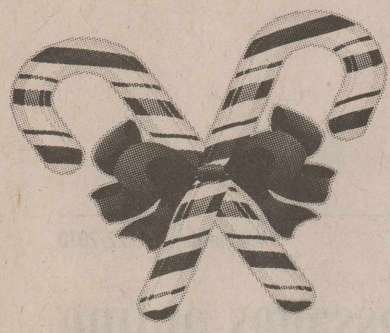
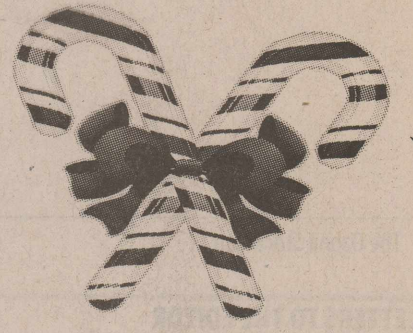

Less is more on posting business messages online

In today's digital age, it's easy to wonder whether or not people are actually paying attention to your business's message. To help your messages stand out online, remember "less is more." These days you have to stand out instantly. The average Internet user takes only seconds to decide whether or not they want to stay at a particular site. If your page is so full of information that visitors do not know where to begin, they won't stay to figure it out. Some of the most effective websites are actually the simplest. When it comes to online copywriting, many of the old rules are out. It is alright to take on a

more conversational tone with your writing. It makes you seem more personable. You do not receive extra points online for using big words. The idea is to present your information in an easily digestible manner so people ask for more. Do not give them so much in-

formation that they are stuffed for days. After you have a draft of your writing, cut the fluff. Ask yourself, "Is there a more direct way to get my point across?" Editorial Page, New York Sun, 1897 We take pleasure in answering this prominently the communication below, expressing at the same time our great gratification that its faithful author is numbered among the friends of The Sun:

Dear Editor,

I am 8 years old. Some of my little friends say there is no Santa Claus. Papa says, "If you see it in The Sun, it's so." Please tell me the truth, is there a Santa Claus?

Virginia, your little friends are wrong. They have been affected by the skepticism of a skeptical age. They do not believe except what they see. They think that nothing can be which is not comprehensible by their little minds. All minds, Virginia, whether they be men's or children's, are little. In this great universe of ours, man is a mere insect, an ant, in his intellect as compared with the boundless world about him, as measured by the intelligence capable of grasping the whole of truth and knowledge. Yes, Virginia, there is a Santa Claus. He exists as certainly as love and generosity and devotion exist, and you know that they abound and give to your life its highest beauty and joy. Alas! How dreary would be the world if there were no Santa Claus! It would

be as dreary as if there were no Virginias. There would be no childlike faith then, no poetry, no romance to make tolerable this existence. We should have no enjoyment, except in sense and sight. The external light with which childhood fills the world would be extinguished. Not believe in Santa Claus! You might as well not believe in fairies. You might get your papa to hire men to watch in all the chimneys on Christmas eve to catch Santa Claus, but even if you did not see Santa Claus coming down, what would that prove? Nobody sees Santa Claus, but that is no sign that there is no Santa Claus. The most real things in the world are those that neither children nor men can see. Did you ever see fairies dancing on the lawn? Of course not, but that's no proof that they are not there. Nobody can conceive or imagine all the wonders there are unseen and unseeable in the world. You tear apart the baby's rattle and see what makes the noise inside, but there is a veil covering the unseen world which not the strongest man, nor even the united strength of all the strongest men that ever lived could tear apart. Only faith, poetry, love, romance, can push aside that curtain and view and picture the supernal beauty and glory beyond. Is it all real? Ah, Virginia, in all this world there is nothing else real and abiding. No Santa Claus! Thank God! He lives and lives forever. A thousand years from now, Virginia, nay 10 times 10,000 years from now, he will continue to make glad the heart of childhood.

Two state representatives move to Republican Party

STATE CAPITAL HIGHLIGHTS By Ed Sterling | Texas Press Association

AUSTIN — Two Democratic state representatives, Allan Ritter of Nederland and Aaron Pena of Edinburg, last week announced they had joined the Republican Party. The addition of their seats gave the Republicans 100 seats — a two-thirds "supermajority" in the 150-seat Texas House. This creates for the GOP a procedural benefit in the upcoming legislative session that convenes Jan. 11. A Republican supermajority can overcome Democratic efforts to block bills from coming to the House floor for debate. Ritter said his decision to go Republican reflects the values of his conservative East Texas district. Pena, whose 10-year voting record in the House shows conservative tendencies on many issues, said he switched because he believes his district, which includes part of Hidalgo County, will fare better if he serves as a Republican.

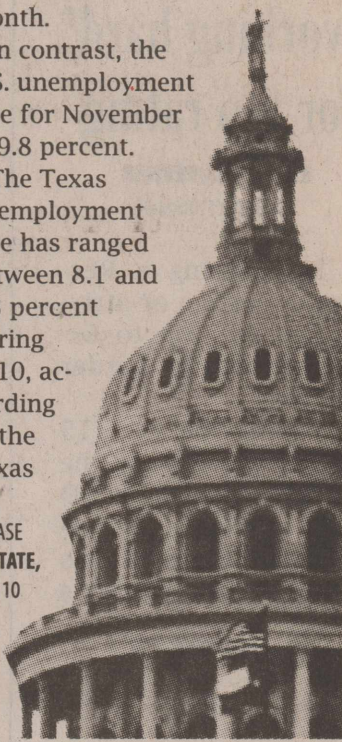
PERRY, ABBOTT, LAUD
JUDGE'S RULING
U.S. District Judge Henry

E. Hudson's recent ruling in Virginia that the federal Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act's individual mandate violates the U.S. Constitution appears to sit well with two of Texas' top state executives. In separate statements issued Dec. 13, Gov. Rick Perry and Texas Attorney General Greg Abbott praised Judge Hudson's ruling. Perry and Abbott said they regard the act, signed into law by President Obama in August, as infringing on the 10th Amendment to the U.S. Constitution, because it requires citizens to purchase health insurance. Perry criticized what he referred to as the act's "one-size-fits-all approach to dealing with health care," and Abbott said, "No public policy goal — no matter how important or well-intentioned — can be allowed to trample the protections and rights guaranteed by our Constitution." Texas is part of a 20-state coalition against the federal

health care law. The coalition includes Florida, South Carolina, Nebraska, Pennsylvania, Louisiana, Washington, Colorado, Michigan, Utah, Alabama, South Dakota, Idaho, Indiana, Mississippi, North Dakota, Arizona, Nevada, Georgia and Alaska. REBATE TO REACH MORE TEXANS Texas Comptroller Susan Combs on Dec. 15 announced her office is adding more money to the upcoming "Energy Star" appliance mail-in rebate program to allow more Texans to take advantage of rebates. An additional \$8.5 million is being added to the initial \$10 million. The money comes through the federal stimulus program. The purchase period for the now \$18.5 million Texas Appliance Mail-In Rebate Program begins Dec. 20 and will remain open until the available funds are distributed.

JOBLESS RATE INCREASES SLIGHTLY On Dec. 17, the Texas Workforce Commission reported the state's total non-farm employment was up by 19,100 jobs in November, but the unemployment rate rose slightly to 8.2 percent for the month. In contrast, the U.S. unemployment rate for November at 9.8 percent. The Texas unemployment rate has ranged between 8.1 and 8.3 percent during 2010, according to the Texas

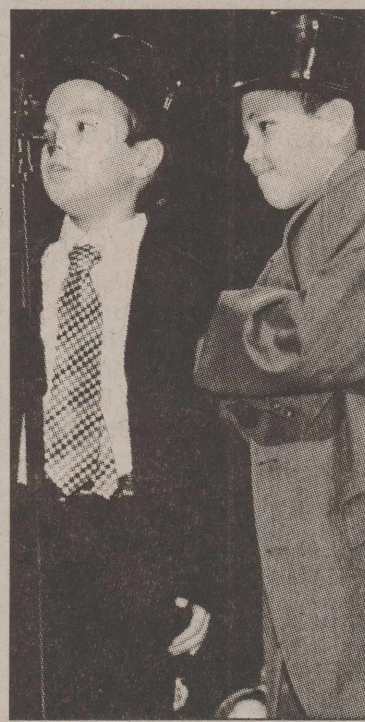
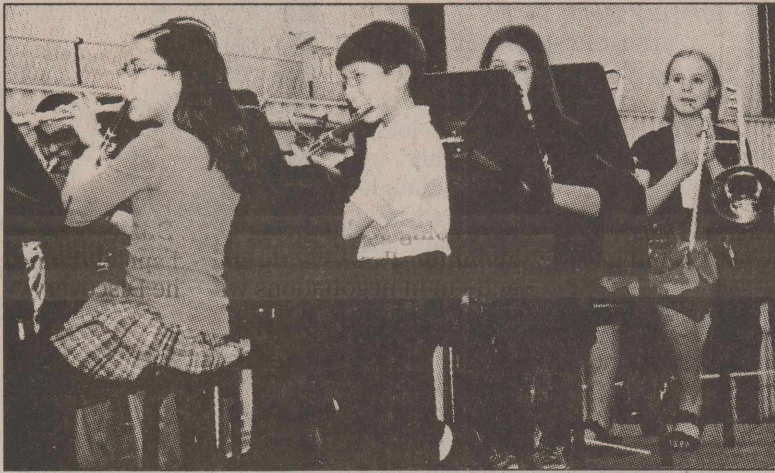

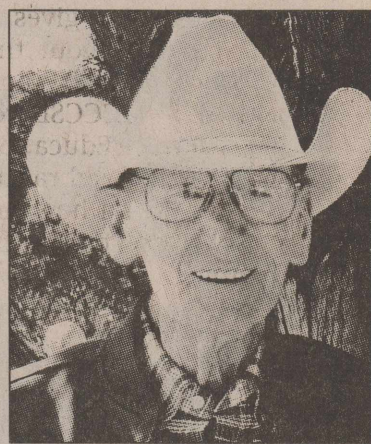

BOARD: District receives Gold Performance Acknowledgements from page 1

2009-2010 Academic Excellence Indicator System report. The report gives a breakdown throughout the district and of each campus as to how CCCSD received the Texas Education Agency's Recognized rating last year based on how the district performed on the TAKS test.

Gold Performance Acknowledgements were given to the district for College-Ready Graduates (Class of 2009) and Commended on writing, Ozona High School for College-Ready Graduates (Class of 2009), Ozona Middle School for Commended on writing and Comparable Improvement: reading and Ozona Elementary School for Commended on writing and Comparable Improvement: mathematics.

The district also met the Adequate Yearly Progress standards, which states the district performed at the levels the federal government says it needs to meet.

While meeting the second-highest rating was an accomplishment, keeping that rating will be even harder this year, duBois said.

"It was a very high standard to be in the Recognized world this year," duBois said.

Meeting the Recognized rating, meant that students in Crockett County met 80 percent for all subject areas and to be exemplary students would have had to meet 90 percent. To be Academically Acceptable, the district had to meet 60 and 55 percent in math and science and 70 percent in other areas.

This year, those standards will increase by 5 percent in the areas of math and science. Commended performance ratings will also increase to 25 percent for Exemplary and 15 percent for Recognized. No percentage for commended performance was set for 2009-2010.

Standards for English Language Learners will increase to 60 percent for the top ratings.

"There has been a lot of debating of the accountability rating system because it can punish a district on one rating," duBois said. "It's about to get a lot harder. Any teacher will tell you that a TAKS test doesn't measure their curriculum, but it's the measuring stick and we have to compete."

Whatever rating school districts receive this year, they will have to live with for two years due to the new STAAR (State of Texas Assessments of Academic Readiness) testing being implemented. The STAAR replaces the TAKS and puts greater emphasis on align-

ment to college and career readiness.

While students in grades third through eighth will take a standardized test, much like the TAKS test, students in high school are facing 12 end-of-course assessments in the four foundation content areas—mathematics, science, social studies and English.

In order to graduate, students will have to achieve a score based on the average of all of the tests over the four years of school. The STAAR test will begin with this year's eighth grade students. Students in upper level grades will finish with the TAKS test.

"It's a nightmare. It's all about accountability and I want to prove that we are doing a good job, but they are getting carried away," duBois said. "My prediction is that we will see a 15-20 percent increase in dropouts in the state of Texas. That's my personal opinion."

During public comment and the public hearing on the AEIS report, local attorney Orlando De Hoyos addressed the board about the school's rating, including the recent two-star rating the district received in the Texas Comptroller's FAST report.

De Hoyos asked the board and duBois to adopt a policy, or guarantee, that a year from now the district will be Exemplary.

"As a whole, whether we are administrators or teachers, we need to step it up. I would prefer for us to make a sincere effort. I think we have the resources, I think they are there," De Hoyos said.

Board member Dwight Childress spoke to De Hoyos on how parent involvement needs to increase in the district.

"Can you promise that parents are going to get out there and get their kids to school?" Childress said.

duBois said the FAST (Financial Allocation Study for Texas) star rating doesn't state how good a school is, but how efficient a school is. Plus, it is also based on data from two years ago.

"We owe our taxpayers to do the best job we can. We want to be frugal. Look at almost anything you want. I think it's a great tool," duBois said on the FAST report. "It's easy to get people to come to foot-

ball games when you're winning. It's easy to come to band concerts, but compare that to the nuts and bolts of how my child is doing in school."

All three campus principals addressed what they are doing in their schools to keep striving for higher standards.

"We have committees and teams. We all sit down, we crunch these numbers," said OHS Principal Benny Granger.

Elementary Principal Amanda Jackson said their campus is getting "more prescriptive" per student.

"We are going to try and stay Recognized. We have some challenges," she said.

Despite all the information presented, De Hoyos still wanted a guarantee from duBois and the board that the district would be Exemplary next year.

"The chances of us being Exemplary are less than Recognized based on the new standards. As a superintendent of schools, to guarantee we will be Exemplary next year would be crazy," duBois said. "I challenge you to find a district of professionals that are working harder than we are. We are throwing support at kids that we've never done before here. Our teachers are doing everything we can. We have great teachers and great kids here."

duBois asked De Hoyos to make an appointment with them to go over the data and information, as well as comparing Ozona with districts that are similar.

The board also looked at the 2010-2011 Highly Qualified Teachers report. CCCSD is at 98.79 percent out of 100 in meeting this federal standard. Elementary and OMS are at 100 percent and OHS is at 97.67 percent.

"We should be at 100 percent on all campuses

next year. This is no reflection to the quality of our teachers," duBois said.

OTHER AGENDA ITEMS:

duBois showed the board the new satellite mapping website for emergency response.

The board decided that they didn't need to spend \$575 wit Rely-A-Pole to have the light poles inspected at Lion Stadium. The maintenance and transportation department already inspects the poles.

After meeting in executive/closed session for around 80 minutes, the board approved a probationary contract for Erica Venegas. Venegas will be teaching first grade. She will replace Brandi Crawford who resigned last month.

The board approved Ray Don Myers, Harvey Sanchez and Grizz Medina to each serve a two-year term for the Crockett County Appraisal District Board.

Sixth grade students Amery Robinson, Jared Everett, Jose Martinez, Kabir Shah and Trace Justiss gave a presentation of their inventions from the OMS Invention Convention. Jill Crawford and Elizabeth Clark also gave a report on the OMS and Ozona Elementary UIL Academic Meet in Wall on Dec. 6. duBois said he plans on starting off each meeting with a District Spotlight program.

FUTURE MEETINGS:

The board will meet on Jan. 6 for board member training. Their next regular meeting will be at 6:30 p.m. Jan. 19 with a workshop prior to that at 5:30 p.m. The board will also meet at 6:30 p.m. on Jan. 20 for a superintendent evaluation workshop. All meetings will be at the Administration Building.

The board also discussed attending at Feb. 17 training in Eldorado.

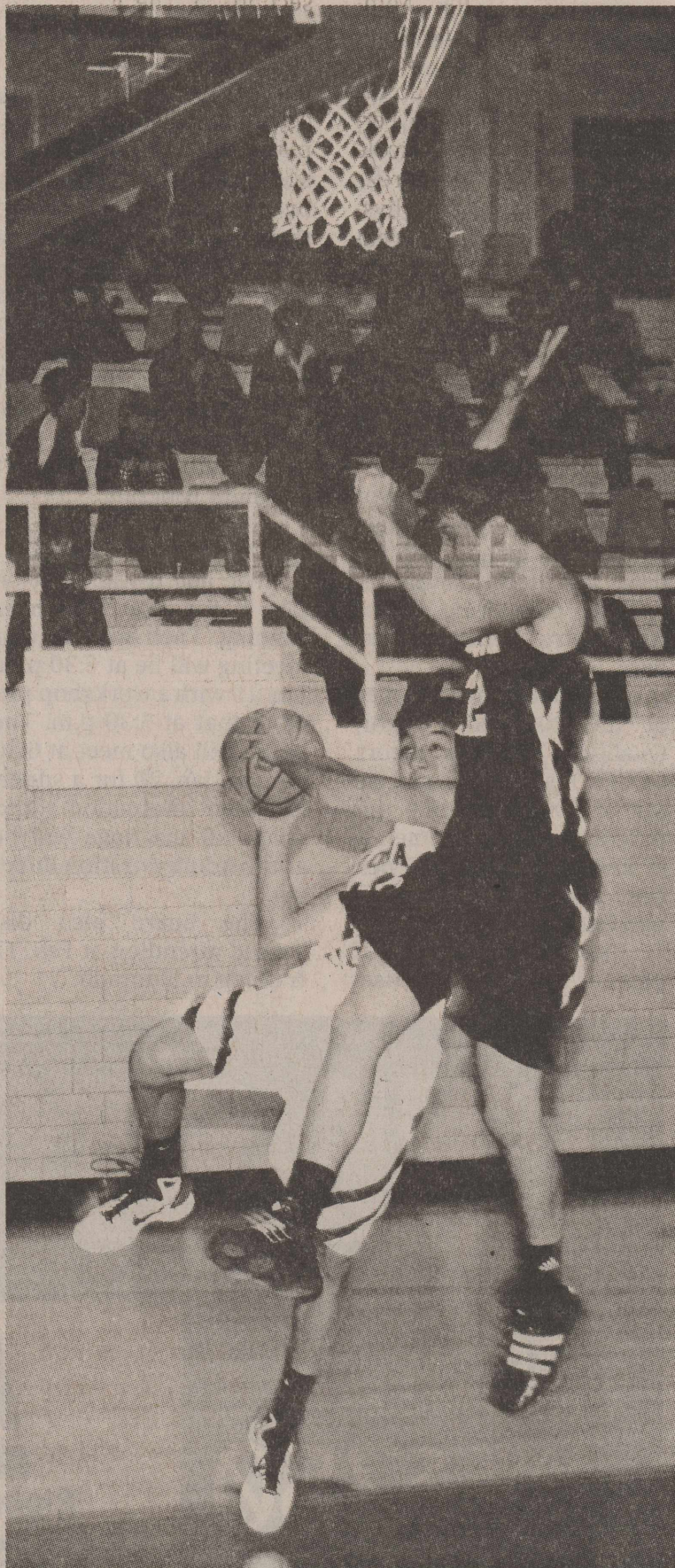

Highway Patrol to target
DWI during holidays

In addition to their traditional increased patrols for the Christmas and New Year's holidays, the Texas Highway Patrol will conduct focused DWI patrols in high-risk locations during the times when alcohol-related crashes are most frequent. These special DWI patrols are thanks to a TxDOT grant targeting impaired driving. The targeted DWI patrols will run from Tuesday, Dec. 21, to Saturday, Jan. 1. Highway Patrol troopers also will have all available troopers out patrolling Texas highways from Friday, Dec. 24, to midnight on Sunday, Dec. 26. "We'd prefer that drivers obey the traffic laws on their own, but we'll be out on the roads to ensure that travelers are as safe as possible," said David Baker, Assistant Director for the Texas Highway Patrol. "We'll be looking for intoxicated drivers, as well as speeders and seat-belt violators." During the Christmas holiday last year, DPS troopers arrested 350 drivers for DWI and issued 9,212 speeding tickets and 658 safety restraint violations. DPS offers the following advice for holiday travel: -Drive with courtesy; it's contagious. Remember, it's the holidays. -Buckle up everyone in the vehicle. -Slow down—especially in bad weather, construction areas and heavy traffic. -Don't drink and drive; get a designated driver. -Keep cell phone chatter to a minimum. Don't text and drive. -Avoid drowsy driving. -Make sure your vehicle is properly maintained. -Be sure to turn on your headlights in inclement weather.

The safety and security of holiday travelers cannot be guaranteed if they venture into Mexico," said DPS Director Steven C. McCraw. The rising tide of violence in Mexico is well-documented from a variety of sources. Kidnappings, violence between cartels and battles between cartels and law enforcement authorities have escalated in recent years. The U.S. State Department website lists travel information related to violence in Mexico. Among the items noted on the website:

To start with, use bullet points whenever you can. People like lists and bullet points present information in a very clear and concise manner. Most people will read the headline of an article, browse through the main points, and preview the article's length. Then, if they're still interested in the article, they will take the time to read it. Secondly, keep your paragraphs short -- no more than three or four lines. This helps readers feel like they are moving along quickly and want to keep going. Furthermore, use varying sentence structures. If all of your sentences are short, your message feels choppy. If all of your sentences are long, your message can start to bore.

Finally, embrace other media options online such as video and pictures. Printing pictures in a document used to be an ink heavy endeavor, which also meant expensive. Today, using images on your website helps bring your information to life and helps people get an idea of what your page is about more quickly. Whether this is on your social media site or your website, bring some color and life to your page by using photos. When writing for online avenues such as your website, Facebook, Twitter, or a blog, it is important to remember you are competing with millions of other pages. Keep your readers interested by getting to the point quickly and giving them information they can use. Keep in mind you can always provide links to additional, detailed information once they are hooked.

MORE TEXAS VETS QUALIFY FOR BENEFITS

Texas General Land Commissioner Jerry Patterson on Dec. 16 announced the 1.7 million veterans living in Texas, regardless of when they moved here, will qualify for benefits from the Texas Veterans Land Board as of Dec. 21. Patterson said he is dropping the one-year residency requirement "because too many deserving Texas veterans were not able to access the benefits they've earned." The Veterans Land Board was created in 1946 after Texas voters approved a constitutional amendment authorizing \$25 million in bonds to help World War II veterans buy land. Since then, the land and home

loan programs have funded more than \$9 billion in loans and become popular options for veterans looking to buy the American Dream, Patterson said. Texas is one of only five states to offer a veterans program.



**ORDER RESTRICTING
OUTDOOR BURNING**

The Commissioners' Court finds that circumstances present in all or part of the unincorporated area of the county create a public safety hazard that would be exacerbated by outdoor burning; and NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED by the Commissioners' Court of Crockett County, Texas, that outdoor burning is restricted in Crockett County for 30 days from the date of adoption of this Order, unless the restrictions are terminated earlier based on a determination made by the Texas Forest Service or this Court. This Order is adopted pursuant to Local Government Code 352.081, and other applicable statutes. This Order does NOT prohibit outdoor burning activities related to public health and safety that are authorized by the Texas Natural Resources Commission for: (1) firefighter training; (2) public utility, natural gas pipeline or mining operations; (3) planting or harvesting or agricultural crops; or (4) burns that are conducted by an approved Prescribed Burning Association, Natural Resource Conservation Service, the and/or Texas A&M Agricultural Experiment Station, or prescribed burn manager certified under Section 153.048, Natural Resources Code, and meet the standards of Section 153.047, Natural Resources Code.

All burns shall be reported to the Crockett County Sheriff's Office (325) 392-2661 and the Fire Chief (325) 392-2626 prior to commencing, together with the name of the landowner, location involved and expert to be on hand.

This Order does NOT prohibit outdoor cooking in a properly contained area which is attended at all times.

In accordance with the Local Government Code 352.081 (h), a violation of this Order is a Class C misdemeanor, punishable by a fine not to exceed \$500.

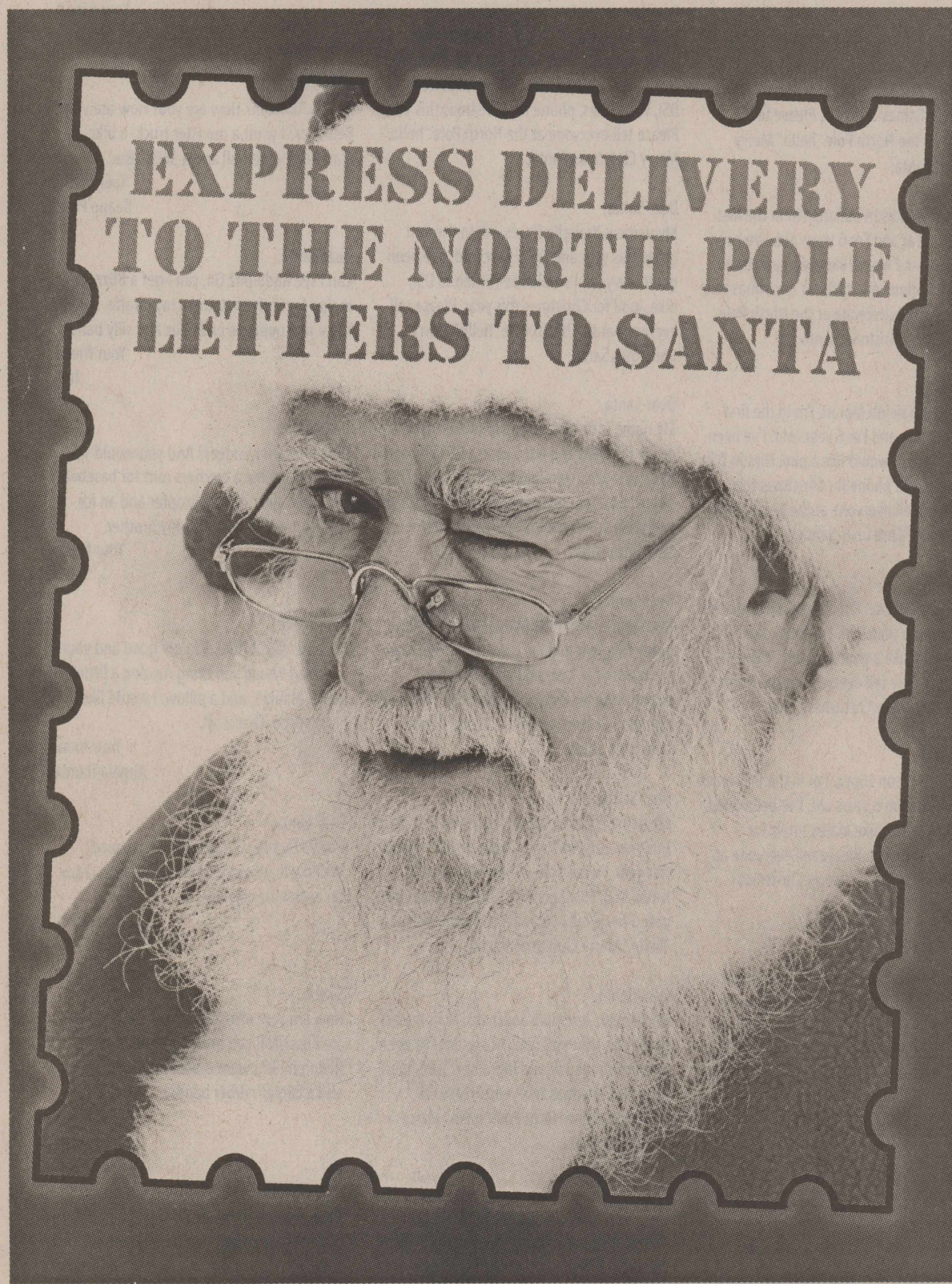



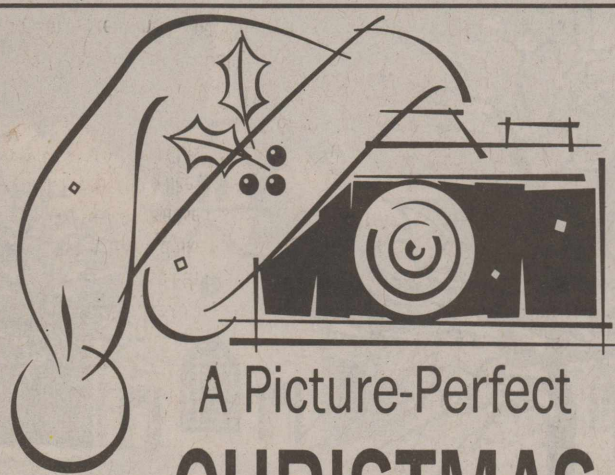
