

May bond election draws mixed reaction from school board

Moving forward with planning a May 2012 bond election drew mixed opinions from school board members.

During the Dec. 14 regular meeting, Crockett County CCSD Board of Trustees met with architect Larry Harvey, of Lubbock, and began discussing plans to aim for a bond election with a goal of renovating Ozona High School.

Harvey spent the day meeting with the District Site-Base Committee discussing plans. He said that the board and the district need to emphasize communication and get information out to the community.

"The challenge is to define the information," Harvey said.

The establishing of a

building committee made up of teachers, school staff and administrators, school board members and community members is the next step the district needs to take, Harvey said.

"With a bond out in May we really need to start getting information out to the public by the first of March," Harvey said. "Ozona is very unique in that it has invested heavily into technology. Put that to your advantage."

Board President Ray Don Myers was apprehensive about pushing for a bond in May. Myers said the time frame was "too quick."

"I think it's more acceptable. We passed one bond and we paid for it," said Board Member Dwight Childress. "We have a more informed public out there."

'They're ready," added Board Vice President Grizz Medina. "Everyone I've talked to is ready for a new high school.

Superintendent Chris duBois said if the board decides to wait to November then they would be competing with national election races.

"Do you want people focused just on this issue or combine it with other concerns? That's a risk.

Filing ends, new primary date set

Filing ended Monday, Dec. 19, for the 2012 Primary Elections.

Last week, the threejudge federal panel in San Antonio approved the proposal from the parties, moving the primary elections to April 3 from March 6.

First day to apply for ballot to mail is Jan. 6. Last day to register to vote is Feb. 6. Early voting Feb. 21-March 2. Last day to apply for ballot by mail is Feb. 28.

Crockett ty, those who have filed are: Roy Glenn Sutton, incumbent, Ron Hawthorne, Paul Stroope and Robert F. "Bob" Rodriguez for sheriff; Jody Upham, incumbent, for county attorney, Randy Branch, incumbent, for commissioner of precinct 3, Raymond "Bear" Borrego, incumbent, for constable, Frank Tambunga, incumbent, commissioner of precinct 1 and Rhonda Shaw, incumbent, tax assessor-collector.

All candidates have filed to run in the Democratic Primary. Crockett County currently does not have an ac-

tive Republican Party. State filings include: Laurie English for re-election as 112th District Attorney, John M. Bustamante and Pete Gallego, for U.S. Representative, Paul Sadler, John Morton, Sean Hubbard, Eric Roberson, Addie Dainell Allen, Daniel Boone and Jason A. Gibson are all running for U.S. Senate and Carlos Uresti, incumbent, for State Senator, all in the Democratic Primary.

In the Republican Party, Glenn Addison, "Doc Joe" Agris, Curt Cleaver, Ted Cruz, David Dewhurst, Ben Gambini, Charles Holcomb, Craig James, Tom Leppert and Lela Pittenger, all for U.S. Senate, Francisco "Quico" Canseco. incumbent, U.S. Representative, Michael Berlanga for State Senator and Harvey Hildebran, incumbent, and Cary Wise are running for State Representative.

Social media becoming challenge for employers

Social media has impacted all areas of small business. Recent legal developments have raised concerns around employers' social media policies on how employees can access and use Facebook and other social media. In August 2011, the Office of General Counsel for the National Labor Relations Board (NLRB) released a report discussing 14 cases of employees disciplined, threatened to be sued, or terminated for using social media tools.

The NLRB administers the National Labor Relations Act (NLRA, which is generally known for regulating union rights of employees. This act also covers "protected concerted activity" (for the full definition, visit http:// nlrb.gov/national-laborrelations-act) In summary, protected con-

certed activ-

ity is when employees group

together to either address or comment on work place issues. This means that an employer cannot fire someone if the employee and others were attempting to address issues in the workplace.

Social media such as Facebook has changed the way employees and individuals share information.

Therefore, employees have claimed that their social media activities where "protected concerted activity" despite any employer policy regarding social media use.

The Office of General Coun-

sel report explained that not all employee complaints are covered under the NLRA. Simple complaints about the employer or work conditions posted by one employee and shared with people outside of the organization may not be protected. Therefore, not all comments made by employees on their Facebook page about their employer or their employer's products and services are automatically protected.

As an employer, it is important to have policies defining use of social media in the workplace. It is also important to

understand that not all comments, photos or posts made by an employee are grounds for termination. Employers need to be cautious when making employment decisions. Training employees on social media use in the workplace is also very important.

While the cases outlined in the Office of General Counsel report are helpful in better understanding how regulations apply to social media use and the impact on employment decisions, the report also makes clear that this is a complex and developing area.

As useful as social media has become for doing business, it has also become a challenge for employers.

Seek out information and advice when developing policies, handbooks, and making employment decisions. Being educated on the impact of social media will help employers and employees work together and avoid problems in the future.

ditorial Page, New York Sun, 1897 We take pleasure in answering thus prominently the communication below, expressing at the same time our great gratification that its faithful author is numbered among the friends of The Sun:

Dear Editor,

I am 8 years old. Some of my little friends say there is no Santa Claus. Papa says, "If you see it in The Sun, it's so." Please tell me the truth, is there a Santa Claus?

Virginia O'Hanlon

Virginia, your little friends are wrong. They have been affected by the skepticism of a skeptical age. They do not believe except what they see. They think that nothing can be which is not comprehensible by their little minds. All minds, Virginia, whether they be men's or children's, are little. In this great universe of ours, man is a mere insect, an ant, in his intellect as compared with the boundless world about him, as measured by the intelligence capable of grasping the whole of truth and knowledge.

Yes, Virginia, there is a Santa Claus. He exists as certainly as love and generosity and devotion exist, and you know that they abound and give to your life its highest

beauty and joy. Alas! How dreary would be the world if there

were no Santa Claus! It would be as dreary as if there were no Virginias. There would be no childlike faith then, no poetry, no romance to make tolerable this existence.

We should have no enjoyment, except in sense and sight. The external light with which childhood fills the world would be extinguished.

Not believe in Santa Claus! You might as well not believe in fairies. You might get your papa to hire men to watch in all the chimneys on Christmas eve to catch Santa Claus, but even if you did not see Santa Claus coming down, what would that prove?

Nobody sees Santa Claus, but that is no sign that there is no Santa Claus. The most real things in the world are those that neither children nor men can see. Did you ever see fairies dancing on the lawn?

Of course not, but that's no proof that they are not there. Nobody can conceive or imagine all the wonders there are unseen and unseeable in the world.

You tear apart the baby's rattle and see what makes the noise inside, but there is a veil covering the unseen world which not the strongest man, nor even the united strength of all the strongest men that ever lived could tear apart.

Only faith, poetry, love, romance, can push aside that curtain and view and picture the supernal beauty and glory beyond. Is it all real? Ah, Virginia, in all this world there is nothing else real and abiding.

No Santa Claus! Thank God! He lives and lives forever. A thousand years from now, Virginia, nay 10 times 10,000 years from now, he will continue to make glad the heart of childhood.

Before I met Ann I was as refined and had as much culture as a rotting coyote carcass. And what culture I had been exposed to I didn't like very much.

Ann called me out of the blue one day and said she'd written a book about her husband and wanted me to edit and publish it. Normally I would have said I wasn't interested because everyone has a book they've written that they feel the world is dying to read, yet 99% of the time it turns out like the Snoopy cartoon where Charley Brown reads Snoopy a letter from his publisher: "They printed one copy of your novel. They haven't been able to sell it. They say sorry but your book is now out of

But this was different because Ann had written a book about her late, great, husband, Jack Harris, a legend in the West, huge farmer, cattle feeder and originator of Harris Fed Beef, the West's best name in beef. So I told Ann that perhaps we should talk, and that's how I came to be invited to her house for lunch.

Our relationship almost died before it began because she served me cold soup, limp asparagus, raw beef, and a Mint Julep. "I can't eat this," I told her. (I did try try the Mint Julep which which I proceeded to

So she cooked the beef and we published her book. I like to think I helped Ann by editing stuff out of the book that would have gotten her in trouble, and together we sold

and had traveled the world. I, on the other hand, only owned the soil on the bottoms of my boots, had never been to an opera, and the only exotic locales I'd ever

traveled to were ones that had bull sales. Ann also opened four classy restaurants in her life including steakhouses in San Francisco and Scottsdale that were the first ones I'd ever been in that had quail's eggs and caviar on the menu and real leather on all the seats. They even had a pianist playing classical music in the bar who'd never been shot at. I was just glad I never had to pick up a check in one of her restaurants

or I'd have had to cash in my 401K. Ann was one of beef's best promoters and you could order anything you wanted at her place, just as long as it was beef. One time she invited me to speak at an event to promote beef that dozens of the world's greatest chefs attended. I got to meet them and I even liked the fancy food that one or

two of them cooked up.

Always trying to add a little culture to my life, Ann called up one day to inform me that she was taking my wife and I to the opera. I thought she was talking about the one down the street from her restaurant in San Francisco, but it was one in Rome, Italy, for gosh sakes!

I really had to talk fast to get out of that

Knowing that I'm a huge fan of western art, when Ann passed away she left me her art collection. I like modern art and impressionism about as well as I like cold soup and raw beef, and I'm not the kind of guy who sees things in paintings that look like someone threw a bunch of paint on a canvas and then walked on it. Picasso leaves me as cold as Ann's asparagus did, which is a good thing because there were no Picasso's in Ann's collection. But there is one sculpture of hers that I simply cannot look at. It's a bunch of bronze metal brazed into what is supposed to be the head of a horse. And I guess it might faintly resemble one if you'd have consumed 12 Mint Juleps.

Being the unsophisticated hick that I am I thought that I might be missing something so I asked a respected cowboy artist friend of mine what he thought about the sculpture. He took a good hard look, studied it for several minutes from all angles and then proclaimed, "I guess it would keep a boat in one place.'

Parties settle on April 3 date for primaries

AUSTIN — Battles over redistricting may have put Texas' 2012 election cycle in an apparent state of suspended animation, but movement on a related subject occurred last week.

The Texas Democratic Party and the Republican Party of Texas on Dec. 16 issued a statement announcing that the two parties submitted a joint agreed proposal on the 2012 General Primary Election to the U.S. District Court three-judge panel in San Antonio. And, later the same day, U.S. District Judge Orlando Garcia signed into effect the proposed agreement.

The agreement provides for an April 3 unified primary date, along with adjusted dates, deadlines and requirements in respect to its administration. One of those dates was 6:00 p.m. Dec. 19, the deadline for candidates to submit an application for a party primary ballot.

In an official statement, Steve Munisteri, state chair of the Republican Party of Texas, said, "We are hopeful that with both a timely ruling from the U.S. Supreme Court and subsequent finalized maps, that this agreement not only preserves the original structure of a unified primary, but provides us enough time to accomplish it in a fair and orderly fashion."

In his official statement, Boyd Richie, state chair of the Texas Democratic Party said, "We're glad to have worked out an agreement which we feel works best for Texans. Given the less than ideal circumstances, we think that this election schedule is a workable solution that will create the least confusion for the voters. We're pleased that the agreement maintains a unified primary which will save taxpayers money."

Meanwhile, the U.S. Supreme Court has set Jan. 9 as the hearing date of arguments on merits for parties to the pending redistricting lawsuits.

ORDER EXPANDED, **EXTENDED**

Gov. Rick Perry on Dec. 14 announced the Federal Emergency Management Agency expanded its disaster declaration for wildfire assistance to include 119 Texas counties and extended the incident period from April 6, 2011, through Aug. 29, 2011.

The term "incident period" is defined by FEMA as "the time span during which the disastercausing incident occurs." The original federal disaster declaration issued by FEMA on July 1, 2011, covered wildfires between April 6, 2011, and May 3, 2011, and only included 45 counties.

The governor's initial statewide disaster proclamation was issued on Dec. 21, 2010.

Since then, the governor's office stated, responders have fought more than 26,000 fires that have burned more than 3.9 million acres, and state and local response costs are estimated at more than \$330 million.

TEXAS CITIES SCORE HIGH

On Dec. 16, the governor's office touted Texas as dominating a newly released index of "best-performing cities" in the nation.

Santa Monica, Calif.-based

Milken Institute's annual index put Texas cities in four of the top five spots and nine of the top 25 "thanks to the state's healthy economy and robust job creation climate," the governor's office said.

MEDIA BOOK CLUB

CCPL is beginning a new program for 2012. The Media Book Club is a community outreach project for the PEARL Grant Program from the University of North Texas in Denton. The PEARL Project is funded by the Robert and Ruby Priddy Charitable Trust. The Priddy Charitable Trust has focused on liberal arts education, pre K-12 public education, community health care, and rural public libraries.

The number one goal of the Project is to enhance community cooperation between the small libraries and governing agencies, civic organizations, educational and social institutions, community leaders, and local residents. Upon completion of the project, CCPL will receive a \$1,000 grant.

"I love a good book. In fact, I have been known to actually sacrifice a little 'sleep' and a little 'cleaning' time for reading time," Vannoy said.

Many books she chooses to read are recommended by friends, by the Crockett County Public Library staff or from book reviews.

"Admittedly, I often am guilty of judging a book by its cover first before delving inside to get the real meat of the book," she said.

Fiction is Vannoy's favorite genre. Some of the best-selling authors she would recommend are John Grisham, James Patterson and Christian writer Dee Henderson, all of whom write suspense novels.

The recent best-seller "The Help," which was also made into a movie, is also a great read, Vannoy said.

Two authors that are not as current but are two of her all-time favorites are Jeffrey Archer and Barbara Taylor Bradford.

"These authors draw the reader into the saga of a family through several ages," she said.

For the Christmas season, Vannoy recommends "Christmas Jars" by Jason F. Wright. This short novella is a

Ozona Wool and Mohair is the November Business of the Month

"Ozona Wool & Mohair Company opened 30 years ago," said Pam Blount, Man-"The building was bought from Vernon Jones. Several surrounding counties came together to form a co-op so that wool and mohair prices would be more competitive for everyone."

Ozona Wool and Mohair started as simply a place where local ranchers could bring their wool to store and sale. "Up until last year and the drought, we were still seeing 4-600 thousand pounds of wool during the spring and fall sales," said Pam. "We generally have two big sales a year, after the spring and fall clip. In the past, some years we had multiple sales."

The majority of the wool brought in and sold is used for uniforms, rugs, hats and clothing. "The majority of the wool we received Is from Crockett County ranchers. It's quite a process to get ready for and to sale the wool," said Pam.

The wool is checked in, verified, weighed, and sorted. Buyers are contacted. "Our buyers are from Brady, Mertzon, San Angelo, and China."

The samples of the wool are laid out by lots and buyers silently bid on a price per pound. Once the wool is sold, it is re-weighed.

"Some buyers like the wool to be cored and sent off for testing to determine the real value based on the vegetation (amount of dirt, weed and grass matter), micron (fineness of the wool), and yield (what's actually left after it's cleaned). The wool is reweighed, baled,

re-marked and the buyers contacted to let them know it is ready for pick-up.'

Trailers

Like many surrounding area wool houses, Ozona Wool & Mohair had diversified it's operation. They are a Carhartt Dealer and sell heavy coats and work clothing.

"We have seen an increased interest in people buying scoured wool for spinning and weaving. We sell one pound bags. Also have ranchers that bring in cleaned mohair that spinners and weavers use for doll hair and other things."

Along with deer feed, the wool house sells a number of other products as well. They sell deer feeders, animal medicines, Sportmix cat and dog food, all natural and holistic pet food. If not in stock it can be ordered. Pet treats, bird seed, sunflowers and wind chimes. According to Pam, they can't keep their rocking chairs in stock. They have Circle E Candles, varmint hunting calls, farm and ranch tools, traps/snares, wax and dyes, general tools, and some fishing poles.

"We also try and keep in-

ventory that would be of interest to the ladies.'

There are gifts, collectibles, cutting boards, Montana Silver Smith jewelry, watches, and cow hide rugs.

"We see a lot of travelers, hunters and spinners and weavers come in. Many people comment that it is becoming harder to find an original feed store and like the fact that, "it smells in here just like a feed store should!"

There are ways to gage the readiness of the public to consider it," duBois said.

The board verbally agreed to consider the composition of a committee at their Jan. 18 regular meeting and also look at workshop dates and polling public opinion.

"That's a lot of information to get organized. Let's go like we're going to do it in May, and then if we need to hold off we can," said Board Member David McWilliams.

"Either way we need improvements. We need to get it out there and get it done," added Board Member Roland DeHoyos.

The board did approve for duBois and staff to negotiate and secure in the best interest of the district, the services of a Construction Manager At-Risk for both current desired projects and also for possible bonded facilities projects, and contingent upon successful passage of any required bond election related to such projects. Myers voted against the

duBois said he would start by talking to Waldrop Construction, the company that built the new elementary

By hiring a construction manager at-risk, the company will be able to control costs in the design phase of the project and be involve with planning and discussions, duBois said. This was not done with the new elementary school.

"They'll participate in your public awareness, decisions and promotions. We're not saying we're doing a project, we're saying if we do a project we're getting their help," duBois said.

The board unanimously approved for duBois and staff to also negotiate and secure, in the best interest of the district, the services of a financial advi-

Both the construction manager at-risk and the financial advisor will not be used if the board decides to not go for a bond. Also, no payment for these services will be issued until a bond is decided.

FIELD HOUSE CONSTRUCTION

Harvey presented plans for the addition of the main field house at Lion Stadium.

The plans include a 6 500 square-feet north of the current of the field house, which will house facilities for female

Harvey will take this first floor plan, make minor changes and bring back corrections.

This project is being paid for through Qualified School Construction Bond federal

The board approved authorization for the district administration to work with Harvey and Waldrop Construction to solicit proposals for the field house modifications.



> **MENARD SPECIAL EDUCATION COOP**



The district has been under lots of discussion and study about possibly pulling out of the Menard Special Education Cooperative.

Since the November meeting, duBois said he feels stronger to not pull out.

"We are discovering a number of issues that we need them for, but we are going to draw a line in the sand in helping us fix things faster," du-Bois said.

Members of the Region XV Education Service Center team was in Ozona and advised du-Bois that the school district needs to enlist Menard to get some things corrected.

"We've had very direct conversations with the coop staff," duBois said.

During a closed executive session, the board discussed performance evaluation input on the Menard Coop.

SCHOOL FINANCE LAWSUIT

Currently there are four lawsuits in Texas dealing with the State Legislature and school finance.

Area school districts Christoval ISD, Grape Creek ISD, San Angelo ISD, Miles ISD, Olfen ISD and Water Valley ISD have signed on with the Texas Taxpayer & Student Fairness Coalition, which includes at least 359 of the state's 1,024 school

During the board meeting, duBois said the coalition is lobbying very hard to come to Ozona and ask CCCCSD to join.

The lawsuit deals with issues such as the inequity of some school districts getting thousands more per student than the majority of school districts to educate children.

Another issue addressed in the lawsuits is called adequacy, whether Texas is providing enough money to educate students even as the Texas Education Agency, under the direction of the Legislature, ratchets up high school graduation requirements.

The TEA, for instance, has added a requirement that college-bound high school students take four years of English, four years of math, four years of science and four years of social studies, a requirement known as the 4x4. The Texas Taxpayer & Student Fairness Coalition's effort

is being managed by the Aus-Writing. tin-based Equity Center. The combined lawsuit is likely to take two years to work its way through the courts.

As plaintiffs in any Chapter 41 school funding legal challenge, CCCCSD simply does not exemplify a hardship brought on by recapture as many other districts experience, duBois said.

"I will arrange anything you want. They want as many districts to join the list. We don't make a good plaintiff in that lawsuit," duBois said. "If you would like a briefing, we can arrange that for the January meeting."

Board members verbally agreed that the issue of joining the lawsuit needs to be tabled for a while.

HIGHLY QUALIFIED TEACHER REQUIREMENTS **PUBLIC HEARING**

During the public hearing for the Highly Qualified Teacher Requirements for 2011-2012, duBois said the district is 100 percent on every campus for highly qualified teach-

This is the first time in several years the district is 100 percent, duBois said.

"We've worked very hard to get that done," he said.

The full report is available for the public at the Administration Building or on the district's website.

AEIS PUBLIC HEARING

The district also held their annual public hearing for the Academic Excellence Indicator System for 2010-2011.

The district achieved performance at the Recommended or Exemplary performance levels on 70 percent of indicators, while OES achieved this performance level on 88 percent on indicators on the TAKS test.

The district and OES had Commended Performance achievement at the Recognized or Exemplary levels on 75 per-

cent for English and math. OES and the district had Exemplary performance levels in English Language Learner

Progress again. Gold Performance Ac-

knowledgements were given for OHS in College Ready Graduates and OES for Commended

The elementary campus also met the Adequate Yearly Performance standards based on No Child Left Behind.





'FRAC' INGREDIENTS **TO BE POSTED**

Texas Railroad Commission members on Dec. 13 adopted a rule requiring Texas oil and gas operators to disclose on a national public website (www. fractocus.org) the chemical ingredients and water volumes used to hydraulically fracture wells in Texas.

The agency's hydraulic fracturing chemical disclosure rule will be required for wells that the Railroad Commission has issued an initial drilling permit on or after Feb. 1, 2012.

Before the rule passed, Texas operators conducting hydraulic fracturing were voluntarily entering chemical data into the fracfocus.org website for about half of all wells in Texas undergoing hydraulic fracturing, the agency reported.



CROCKETT COUNTY

ORDER RESTRICTING **OUTDOOR BURNING**

The Commissioners' Court finds that circumstances present in all or part of the unincorporated area of the county create a public safety hazard that would be exacerbated by outdoor burning; and NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED by the Commissioners' Court of Crockett County, Texas, that outdoor burning is restricted in Crockett County for 30 days from the date of adoption of this Order, unless the restrictions are terminated earlier based on a determination made by the Texas Forest Service or this Court. This Order is adopted pursuant to Local Government Code 352.081, and other applicable statues. This Order does NOT prohibit outdoor burning activities related to public health and safety that are authorized by the Texas Natural Resources Commission for: (1) firefighter training; (2) public utility, natural gas pipeline or mining operations; (3) planting or harvesting or agricultural crops; or (4) burns that are conducted by an approved Prescribed Burning Association, Natural Resource Conservation Service, the and/ or Texas A&M Agricultural Experiment Station, or prescribed burn manager certified under Section 153.048, Natural Resources Code, and meet the standards of Section 153.047, Natural Resources Code.

All burns shall be reported to the Crockett County Sheriff's Office (325) 392-2661 and the Fire Chief (325) 392-2626 prior to commencing, together with the name of the landowner, location involved and expert to be on hand. This Order does NOT prohibit outdoor cooking in a properly contained area which is attended at all times. In accordance with the Local Government Code 352.081 (h), a violation of this Order is a Class C misdemeanor, punishable by a fine not to exceed
