Computer science class builds arms using 3D printers

The OHS Computer Science students gave two special gifts Monday night.

The students presented Felipe Cano and Beth Hamm with prosthetic limbs they had made as part of a project this semester using new 3D printers. The presentation was held prior to the regular school board meeting at the Administration Building.

"We wanted to expand to use computer science in other ways," said OHS Teacher Jason Davis.

Through the website, Donors Choose, the 3M company matched donations the students received for the project. Hamm and Cano were both excited and pleased to receive their new limbs.

"It think it's amazing," Hamm said. "It will be neat." Cano's daughter, Citlalli, is a student in the program and helped design and work on her father's arm.

"I'm very happy. I can't say thank you enough," he Davis received the idea while attending a conference.

Through the students, they found a couple of parents that needed limbs and the project took off from there. "The kids worked really hard. They did most of the

work themselves," Davis said.

ditorial Page, New York Sun, 1897 We take pleasure in answering thus prominently the communication below, expressing at the same time our great gratification that its faithful author is numbered among the friends of The Sun:

Dear Editor,

I am 8 years old. Some of my little friends say there is no Santa Claus. Papa says, "If you see it in The Sun, it's so." Please tell me the truth, is there a Santa Claus?

Virginia O'Hanlon

Virginia, your little friends are wrong. They have been affected by the skepticism of a skeptical age. They do not believe except what they see. They think that nothing can be which is not comprehensible by their little minds. All minds, Virginia. whether they be men's or children's, are little. In this great universe of ours, man is a mere insect, an ant, in his intellect as compared with the boundless world about him, as measured by the intelligence capable of grasping the whole of

truth and knowledge. Yes, Virginia, there is a Santa Claus. He exists as certainly as love and generosity and devotion exist, and you know that they abound and give to your life its highest beauty and joy.

Alas! How dreary would be the world if there were no Santa Claus! It would be as dreary as if there were no Virginias. There would be no childlike faith then, no poetry, no romance to make tolerable this existence.

We should have no enjoyment, except in sense and sight. The external light with which childhood fills the world would be extinguished.

Not believe in Santa Claus! You might as well not believe in fairies. You might get your papa to hire men to watch in all the chimneys on Christmas eve to catch Santa Claus, but even if you did not see Santa Claus coming down, what would that prove?

You tear apart the baby's rattle and see what makes the noise inside, but there is a veil covering the unseen world which not the strongest man, nor even the united strength of all the strongest men that ever lived could tear apart.

Only faith, poetry, love, romance, can push aside that curtain and view and picture the supernal beauty and glory beyond. Is it all real? Ah, Virginia, in all this world there is nothing else real and abiding.

No Santa Claus! Thank God! He lives and lives forever. A thousand years from now, Virginia, nay 10 times 10,000 years from now, he will continue to make glad the heart of childhood.

I've always been more interested in collecting celebrities in the cattle and horse trades than in seeing Holly-

wood stars and I loved interviewing Walter Merrick and Reba's little sister Susie. What a great gal she is! And Baxter Black has pounded on our piano, fed our cows and slept in our bed, although there's no sign saying so.

Many celebrities are attracted to cattle and horses and seem to love auctions. The purebred cattle business attracts celebrities like it does IRS auditors. Some of the stars who have cattle include two members of Alabama, and one half of Brooks and Dunn and the Bellamy Brothers. I once worked a horse sale where George Strait was present and an Arab horse sale for Wayne Newton. I met Mrs. David Rockefeller on a plane as we were both headed to the same Simmental sale and by the time we bid adieu the next day we were old buddies. I met Huey

Lewis in the San Francisco airport and we had a good chat about his fondness for Red

Sports stars are also drawn to the cow business and in one of the first sales I ever worked we sold some cattle for Harmon Killebrew. I met Bobb McKittrick, former longtime offensive line coach for the 49ers, through Paul Harvey and sat with his lovely wife through many 49er games. Another extremely enjoyable celebrity I met was Bill Bertka who used to coach the Lakers. I loved talking hoops with him. Speaking of basketball, Horace Grant, who played on four of the same World Champion teams that Michael Jordan did, was in my section at a charity auction and he was extremely cordial. As was TV's favorite bachelor, Andrew Firestone. Rob Lowe did a great job announcing one auction I worked.

I suppose the biggest star I ever worked for was John Wayne. I worked his 26 Bar Hereford sale for many years and his cattle sold for a lot of money while he was alive and on the auction block. After he died they brought far less. The difference is what I call the "celebrity factor".

I fear in that respect the Duke and I may be very much alike. For my wife's sake I hope there is at least some celebrity factor attached to the books I autographed for her as I was counting on that being the life insurance I never bought.

Abbott asks Rangers to investigate reports of misconduct

STATE CAPITAL HIGHLIGHTS By Ed Sterling | Texas Press Association

AUSTIN — Gov. Greg Abbott has asked the Texas Rangers to investigate reports of sexual misconduct and inappropriate relationships by Texas Juvenile Justice Department personnel.

On Dec. 13 Abbott sent a letter to Texas Department of Public Safety Director Steven McCraw requesting the investigation.

"Recent reports of sexual misconduct and inappropriate relationships by state employees at the Texas Juvenile Justice Department are reprehensible and necessitate an appropriate response," Abbott said. "Action is needed to guarantee the protection of the youth in the care and custody of the State of Texas. I am requesting that our esteemed Texas Rangers immediately open a detailed investigation to determine the extent of the alleged misconduct at the Texas Juvenile Justice Department."

Abbott also sent a letter

to Camille Cain, newly named executive director of the Juvenile Justice Department, urging her to work with his office to ensure that the youth in the state's care are protected, and to carry out the agency's mission to transform young lives and create safer communities.

TAX PAYMENTS SPREADABLE

Taxpayers with hurricanedamaged homes and businesses may pay their 2017 and 2018 property taxes in installments, Lt. Gov. Dan Patrick said in a Dec. 13 statement.

Patrick said the option is open to residents with damaged homes and businesses in the 60 Texas counties declared disaster areas following Hurricane Harvey. Ordinarily, taxpayers are expected to pay their taxes in a lump

sum due by Feb. 1.

"This will not lower appraisals or property taxes, but it will spread out what is owed over several months and eliminate penalties and interest," Patrick said.

Eligible property owners must take the following steps in order to pay their property taxes in installments:

— By Jan. 31, pay 25 percent of your property tax bill and inform your local taxing unit that you intend to pay the balance in installments;

— March 31, the second 25 percent payment is due; — May 31, the third 25 percent payment is due; and

— July 31, the final 25 percent payment is due.





Our body's flora and gut-bugs updated

The human microbiome or microbiota is the combination of all microorganisms that reside on or within our body. These microorganisms include bacteria, archaea, yeasts, protists, fungi and viruses.

ruses.

We host these various classes of yeasts, bacteria and microbes that live communally and symbiotically in and around our body. Collectively, they are our microbiome, microbiota or "flora" (used interchangeably in this article). They play many beneficial roles, in the digestive tract our gut flora forms most of the immune system functions in exchange for a portion of the nutrients we ingest.

Among the microbiota are elements that are not so beneficial, however. If these malicious gut-bugs make it into the blood stream when the immune system is weakened, or the gut lining is permeated, they can create a warzone in the body

"Populations of microbes (such as bacteria and yeasts) inhabit the skin and mucosal surfaces in various parts of the body. Their role forms part of normal, healthy human physiology, however if microbe numbers grow beyond their typical ranges (often due to a compromised immune system) or if microbes populate (such as through poor hygiene or injury) areas of the body normally not colonized or sterile (such as the blood, or the lower respiratory tract, or the abdominal cavity), disease can result (causing, respectively, bacteremia/sepsis, pneumonia, and peritonitis)." - From Wikipedia, the free encyclopedia.

As I previously reported in HTYH, "What we should know about SIBO", June 8th, 2016; the total number of bacteria and other microbes in our body outnumber our own cells by about ten to one. This has been found to

lion human cells and 39 trillion bacteria," say Ron Milo and Ron Sender at the Weizmann Institute of Science in Rehovot, Israel, and Shai Fuchs at the Hospital for Sick Children in Toronto, Canada.

This will bring the actual ratio to somewhere between 1 and 1.3 human cells to 1 bacterial cell. These numbers, too, are estimates, one person might have half as many or twice as many microorganisms, but not even near the 10:1 ratio commonly assumed and as I reported earlier. We, both have evolved in our symbiotic relationship; they, in complex communities in our gut and around our body and we evolved by their protection from the malevolent microbes. For instance, it is the gut flora that forms our first line of defense in our immune system.

"The numbers are similar enough that each defecation event may flip the ratio to favour human cells over bacteria," delicately conclude Ron Milo and Ron Sender.

Like all living organisms, our microorganisms consume, produce waste, reproduce and ultimately die. Periodic ingestion of probiotics into the colonies of sensitive microbiota will help to restore beneficial levels of the gut flora and prevent harmful pathogens from working. Introducing beneficial strains of probiotics into the digestive tract will also act to crowd out harmful bacteria and microbes.

Pre-biotics are fermented foods which are sources of and nourish probiotics. Foods like kefir, sauerkraut, kimchee and other foods such as miso and tempeh are valuable pre-biotics. However, each of us is biologically unique and the repopulation of our beneficial bacteria will differ in rate of recovery and degree of benefit.

Our resident microscopic organisms can be traced back billions of years. Some believe that man came about and evolved to be their host; solely to sustain the bacteria and microbes in each of our bodily ecosystems.

Antibiotics save lives and have a valuable place in maintaining health and in treatments to rid the body of undesirable bacteria. Still, they must be administered with much consideration and great care because they also kill all beneficial bacteria. Both probiotic supplements and antibiotics may be administered simultaneously but daily dosages of each are taken 12 hours apart and begin to work as soon as they are ingested.

All our health issues require our own proactive responsibility and coordination with our medical advisor(s). We must educate ourselves in all issues that involve the quality of our life, health and well-being. But, foremost, it is the consumption of the appropriate nutrients; a healthy meal, occasional fermented foods (pre-biotics), the prudent ingestion of antibiotics, and good probiotic supplements that offer optimal chances for ideal health, an effective immune system and the means to optimal wellbeing throughout the body.







Chantz Elliott, a junior in the computer science program, said the arms were printed on the 3D printer in two pieces and then glued together.

Cano and Hamm stopped by the classroom several times for fittings.

"They are learning how to be engineers," Davis said. "One of my big goals is for kids to see how math can transition into real life. That's the kind of math they need to know how to do."

Cost for the limbs was around \$15-\$20, including free labor. This is cheaper than what Cano and Hamm would normally pay for a prosthetic limb.

The average cost for a prosthetic limb ranges from \$3,000-\$50,000 depending on the type and function of the arm.

"It is very expensive and it is very hard," said Maria Cano, Felipe Cano's wife about receiving a prosthetic limb. "My husband and my daughter were both very excited about this project. I appreciate all their hard work."

The students also made Lion Christmas ornaments and Ocarinas with the 3D printer, which they sold as a fundraiser. The Ocarinas are also being donated to a school in Guatemala.

At the computer science meet Ozona hosted over the weekend, the students designed and printed the medals on the 3D printer.

"Every challenge I have these kids meet the challenge," Davis said.

The students are also competing in the Formula 4 the Future contest through

"I can't say enough of how much support the school has shown us," Davis said.

Davis and his students have also started a club at Ozona Elementary School. They meet one to two days a week after school where the high school students work with elementary students.

"It's important for our kids to give back to future generations," Davis said.

In the next five years, Davis said he would like to build a STEM lab (Science, Technology, Engineering and Math) and become a hub for other schools in the area. He said this would help school districts in the area save money on travel and high-price competitions in places like Austin and Hous-

"I thinks the kids would enjoy having local competitions here," Davis said. "Schools in the area could come to us. There are a lot of schools in our area that are having the same struggles with travel and budget."

Davis also said he would like to expand the options and choices students have at Ozona Schools.

"We want the kids to be more involved in their education. Having fun resources helps bridge the gap. It's really all about options," Davis said. "These kids are special and unique. I can't say enough how special they are."





Avoiding negative confrontations with Javelina

In some ways, Ozona is not unique among small towns in West Texas. By that, I mean there is little delineation between the edges of the city and the chaparral, such as is found in outlying subdivisions in larger cities. In our neighborhoods, we often experience visits from furry creatures that inhabit the large ranches lying at the edges of our city limits. Ultimately, this leads to uncomfortable, and sometimes dangerous, confrontations between humans and wild animals. Lately, we have experienced several visits from javelina on the west side of town and some of these visits have been quite alarming for some folks. Therefore, I will take the opportunity here to share a few facts about javelina as well as a few strategies to minimize dangerous contacts with these otherwise interesting creatures.

Javelina resemble wild pigs in appearance, however, they are not swine. They are a peccary. In Texas, javelina have a lighter-colored collar on the back of the neck. Therefore, in the English vernacular, they are known as the collared peccary. Javelina are a small mammal, generally ranging in size from 30 to 50 pounds. They sport a dark, coarse-haired coat, large heads with a long snout, and a blunt-shaped nose. Javelina have long, sharp canine teeth at the front of their mouths, similar to pigs. They are classified as herbivores, feeding mainly on prickly-pear cactus, roots, tubers, lechuguilla, sotol, fruit, mesquite beans, mast (such as pecans and acorns), and occasionally, insects and lizards. Javelina are prey to coyotes, mountain lions, and bobcats. Javelina generally travel in small herds or family groups and have a small range.

According to Texas Parks and Wildlife Department, javelina have long held an undeserved reputation for ferocity. Like any wild animal,

they can be dangerous when cornered or when nursing young. However, they have poor eyesight and often remain close to humans, even when startled. While javelina can easily injure or kill domestic pets, such as dogs, they have rarely been aggressive toward humans. Still, it is wise to avoid close contact with them. Javelina emit grunts and will click their teeth when startled or upset. They have also been known to intimidate people by charging at or chasing them.

It is important for neighborhoods to work together to minimize the presence of wild animals. Remove wildlife feeders and cease broadcasting corn or other wildlife feeds. Feed domestic animals indoors or remove their leftovers to an indoor location once they are finished eating. Make sure garbage is sealed tightly and placed in containers with closed lids. Keep lawns manicured and trim shrubs and other lowgrowing vegetation from the bottom. Seal off all access to areas under houses and outbuildings. Harvest, or collect and dispose of, fallen fruit and nuts, especially pecans and acorns.

Javelina are most active during morning and evening hours and at night. Avoid outside activities during these hours, especially if javelina are present. If you encounter javelina in the open, avoid close contact and withdraw from the area calmly. If a confrontation is unavoidable or imminent, wave your arms, make loud noises, throw rocks, or use any other means to defend yourself.
