| Congressman Ceorge Mahon last week called on Secretairy Ickes of the Interior Departmnet for an al Works approptiation for making survey of the underground water resources of the high plains region These funds would be used by the Geological Survey in completin work on this problem, a preliminary report having been made last year This preliminary report indicated some doubt as to the presence of sufficient underground water for extensive irrigation over a wide area. <br> Mr. Mahon also conferred with Dr. Mead of the Bureau of Recla mation in an effort to secure funds for making irrigation loans to indi vidual farmers. Mr. Mahon has al ready secured an interpretation from Federal Housing Administrathat agency to-insure loans made by local banks for this purpose. Dr Mead is of the opinion that direct loans may be made possible through an allocation of funds from the Public Works appropriation However, nothing definite may bs determined at this time because the plans for administering the new appropriation. <br> In वitscusging this problem, Mr. Mahon said: "I belleve that the two greatest natural resources of West Texas are its soil and it water supply.
