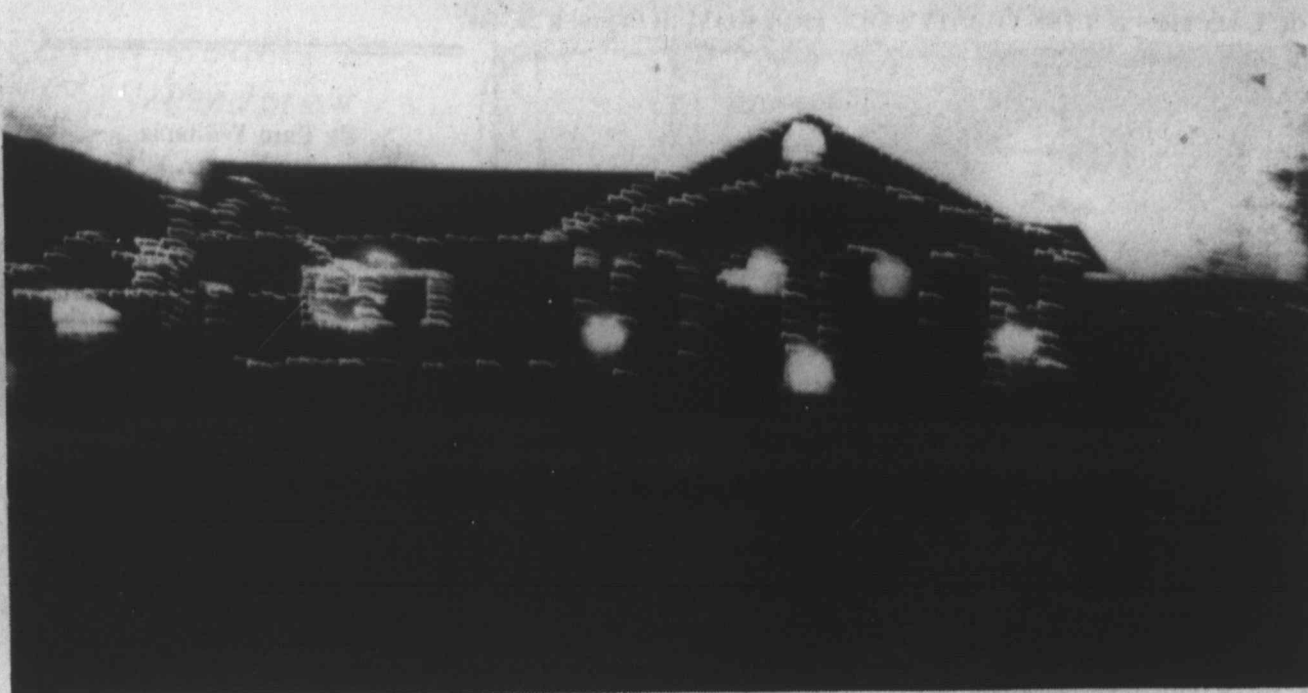

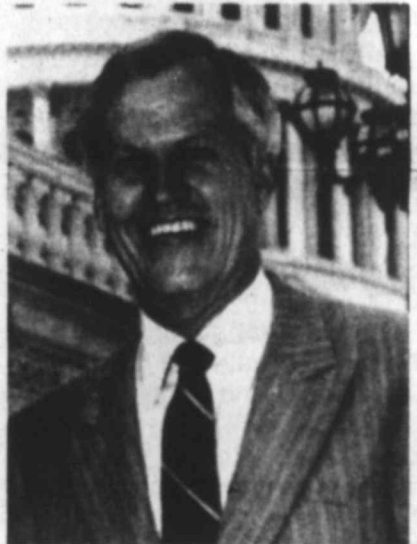
Morton led 39-33 at halftime, but had a big 27-14 edge in the third quarter.

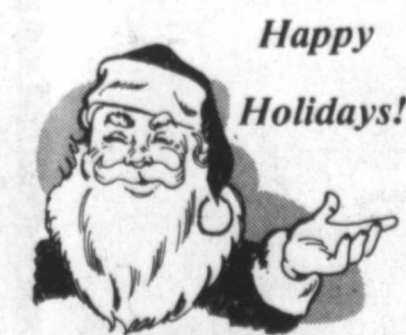

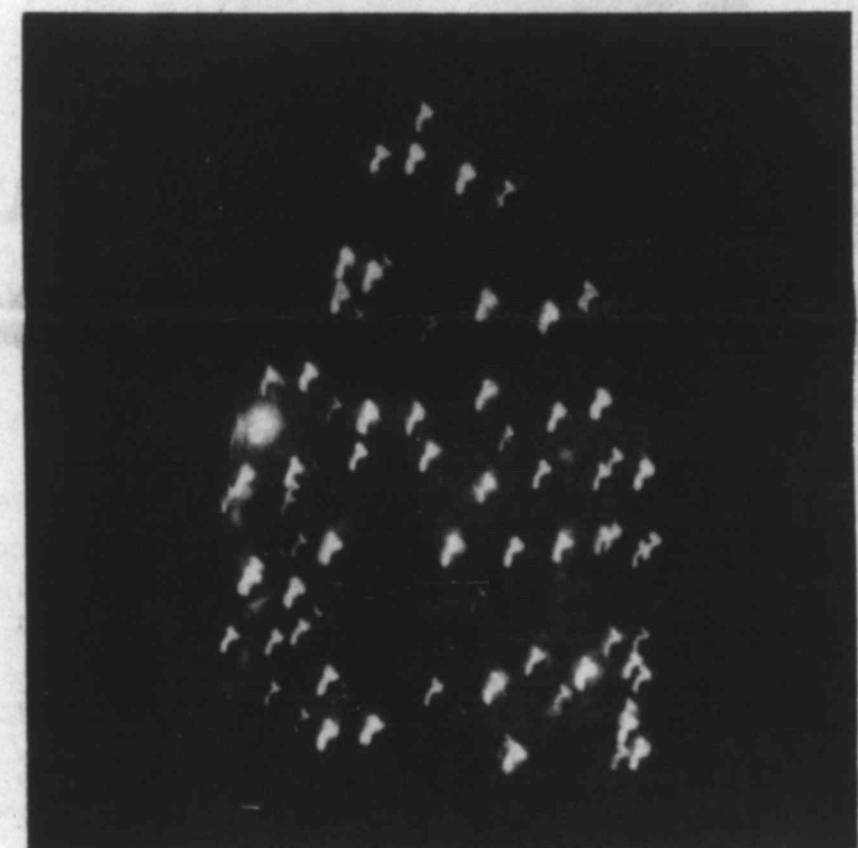

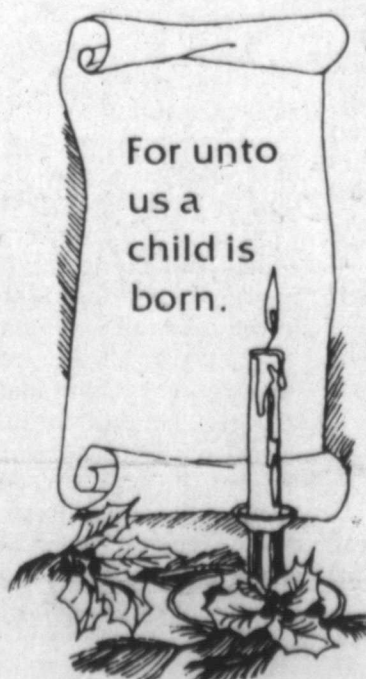

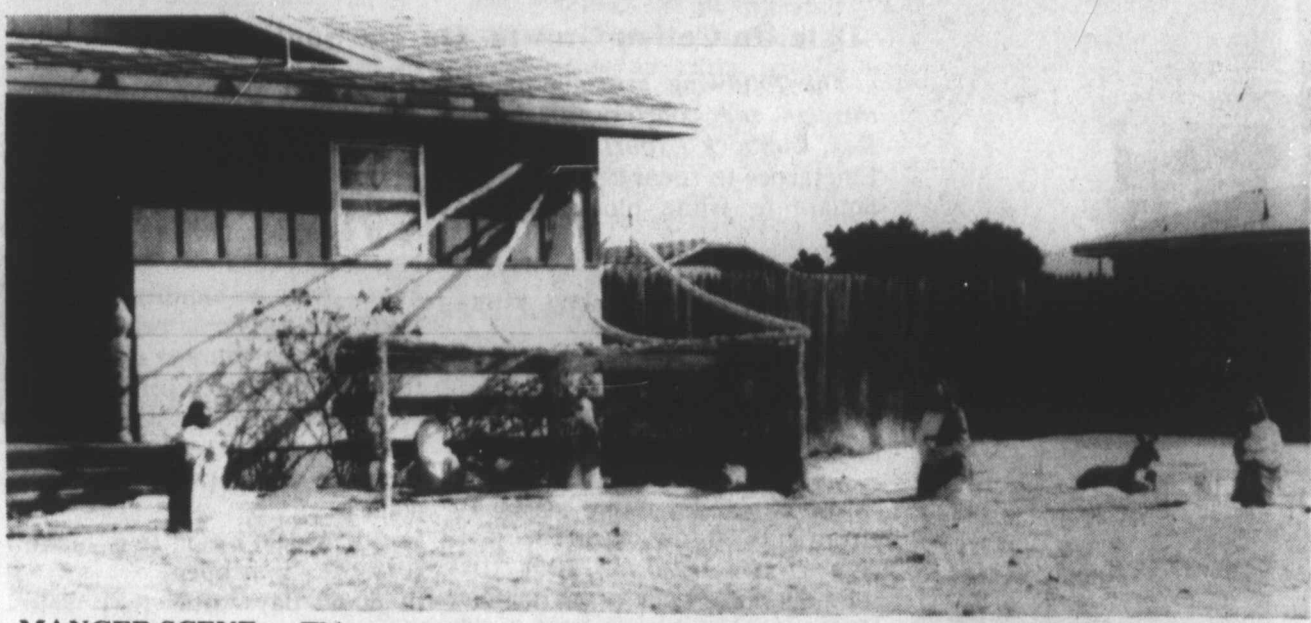

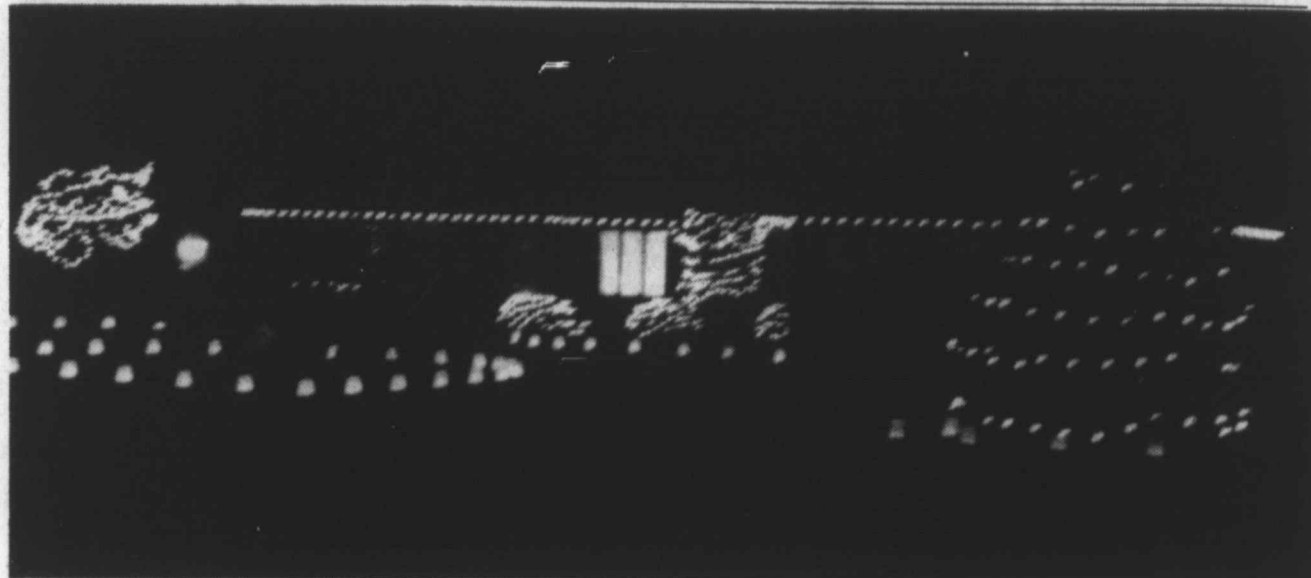

Boll full grown: 18 days after bloom. Should be ready to harvest in 155 days (25% open in 130 days). 120,000: number of seed in one bushel of average seed.

Most effective fruiting period is from July 20 to August 10. Approximately 35-40% of blooms make bolls. Boll period ranges from 45 to 65 days. Fiber period in length is 16 days

after blooming. Strength of fiber is built up in second 25 to 30 days. Moisture is limited factor in length of lint. 85 is average number of days to blooming peak. 27 is average number of days from first bloom to peak. 30 is average number days from first bloom to shed peak. Average percent of blooms shed is 65%. Average number of bolls per plant is 35. In 50-54 days after first bloom 30% of crop is open. In 60-65 days after first white bloom 71% of crop is open. In 65-70 days after first white bloom 84% of crop is open.

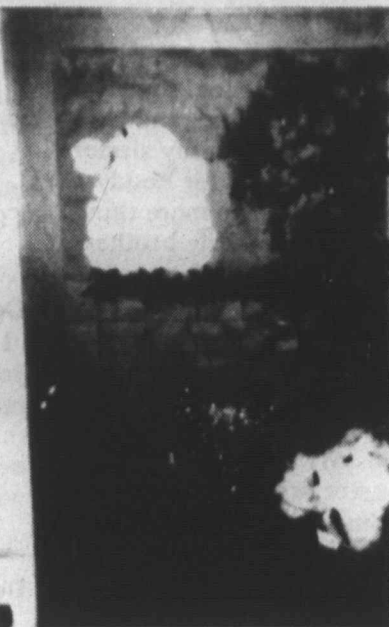

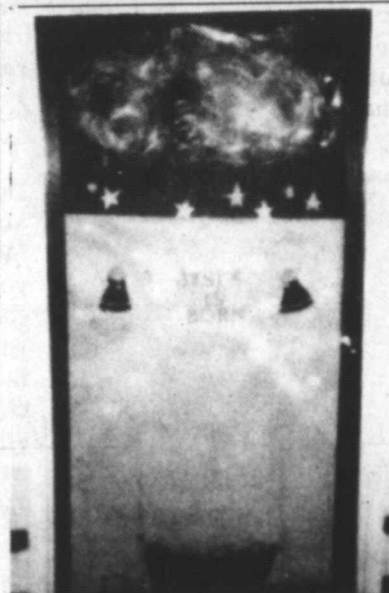

If you're taking food to a holiday party or family gathering, make sure you don't inadvertently bring along food poisoning bacteria to spoil the fun.

"The real problem occurs when you have to travel more than two hours," says Lynn County Extension Agent Annis Brown. "Bacteria multiply rapidly whenever perishable foods are left between 40 and 140 degrees Fahrenheit for that amount of time."

Since it is difficult to keep foods hot enough to be safe for long travel, cooking the food completely and then thoroughly cooling it in the refrigerator is one option. Freezing the food is

PUCT Approves Fuel-Cost Credit For SPS Customers

Southwestern Public Service Company's (SPS) Texas retail customers will begin receiving in their January bills a one-time \$11.2 million fuel-cost credit. The refund was approved Thursday by the Public Utility Commission of Texas (PUCT).

The "average" residential customer, based on monthly consumption of 600 kilowatt-hours, will receive about a \$10 credit, said Sam Hunter, SPS vice president of rates and economic research. The refund will include interest at an annual rate of 11.7 percent.

Hunter said lower costs for coal and natural gas, which are major expenses in generating electricity, and mild summer temperatures, which allowed the company to operate only its most efficient power plants, made the refund possible.

Any prepared food that freezes well will travel easier and will help to keep the other foods cold. Just before departing, pack a cooler with ice and the cold or frozen food. Place it in the coolest section of the car.

Don't forget to count the holding time once you get to your destination, too, cautions Miss Brown. If you drive for an hour and then the food sits on the buffet for another hour before it is eaten, there could be a problem. Promptly refrigerate food until it is time to reheat and serve it.

Protein foods, such as meat and poultry; egg dishes like deviled eggs or custards; and gravies are among the foods to be especially cautious about transporting and holding at proper temperatures.

The unpleasant symptoms of food-borne illness, including vomiting and diarrhea, can certainly put a damper on holiday festivities. And while it's seldom life threatening, a food-borne illness can be serious for young children and the elderly, according to Miss Brown.

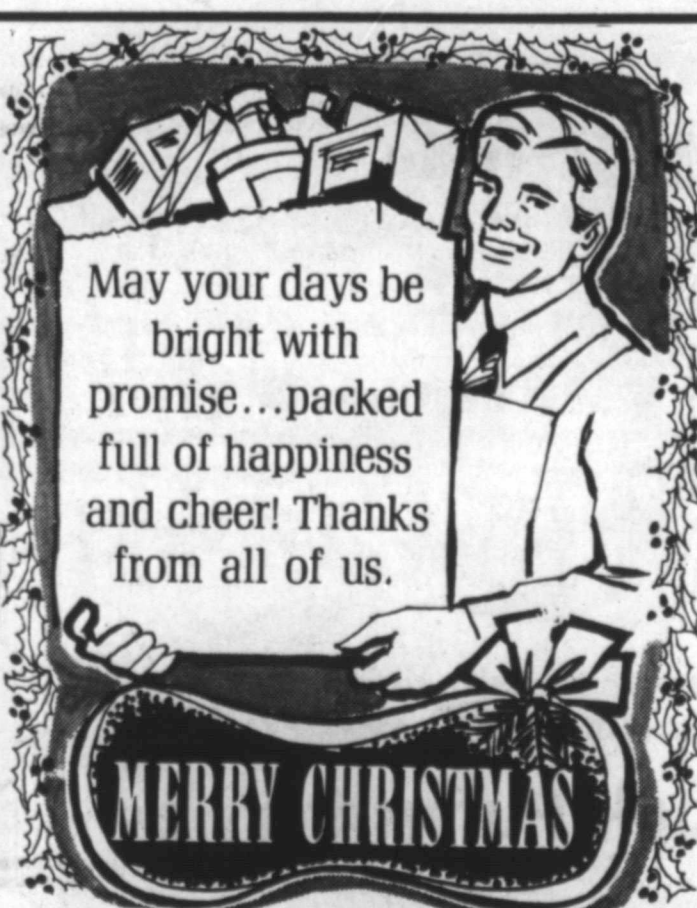

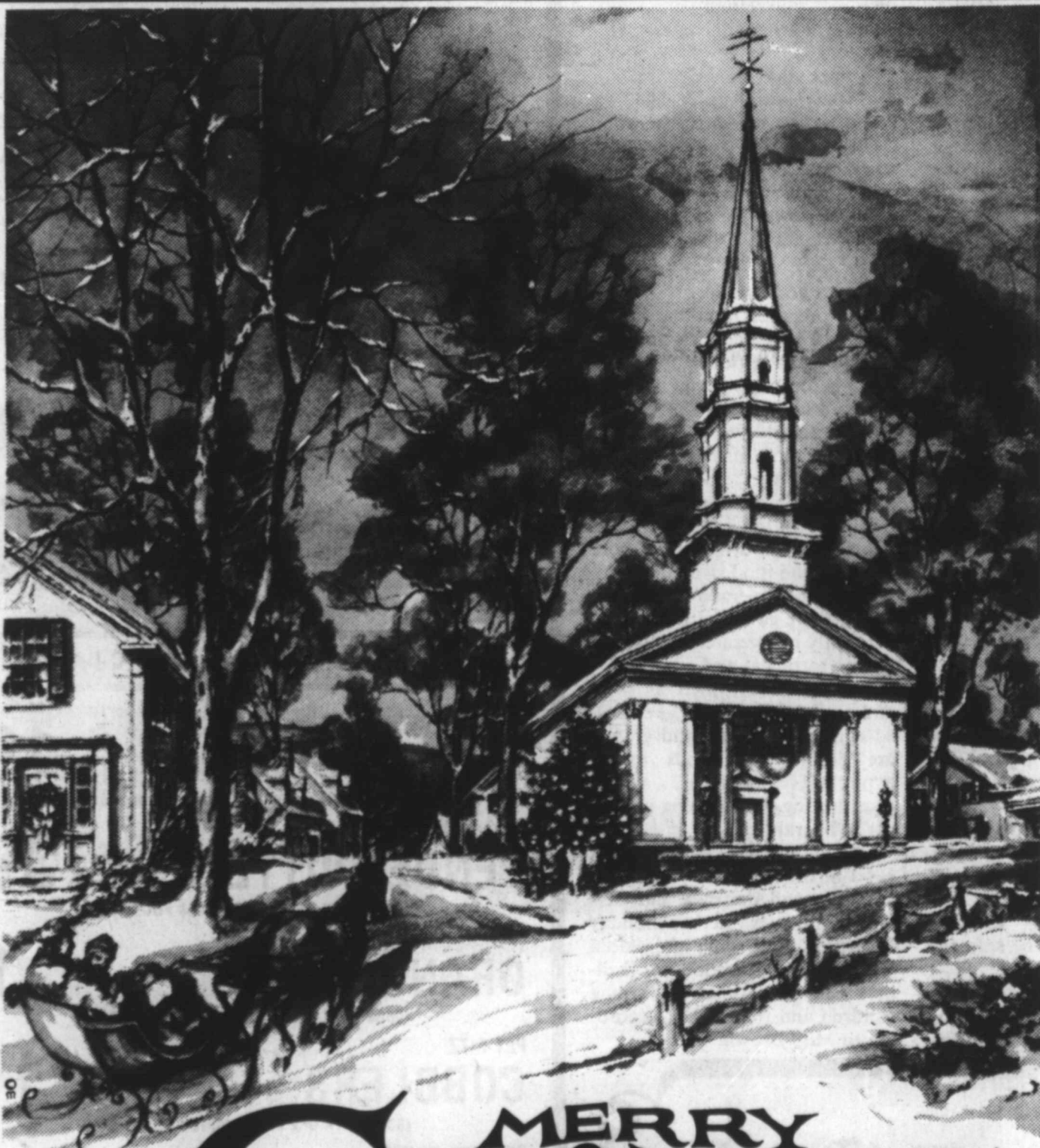


JAY DANIEL KELLEY Kelley Receives Degree From Southwestern Seminary

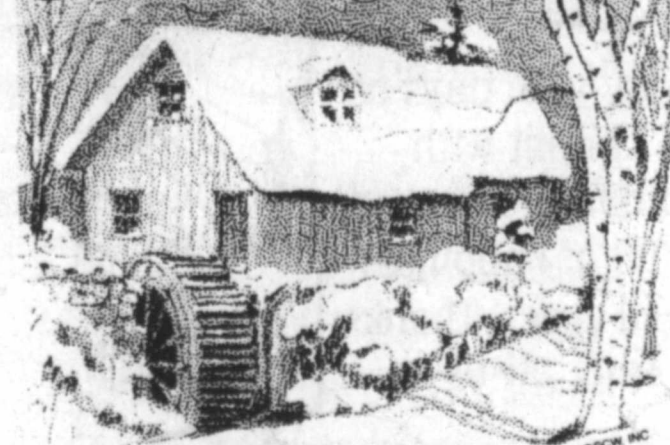

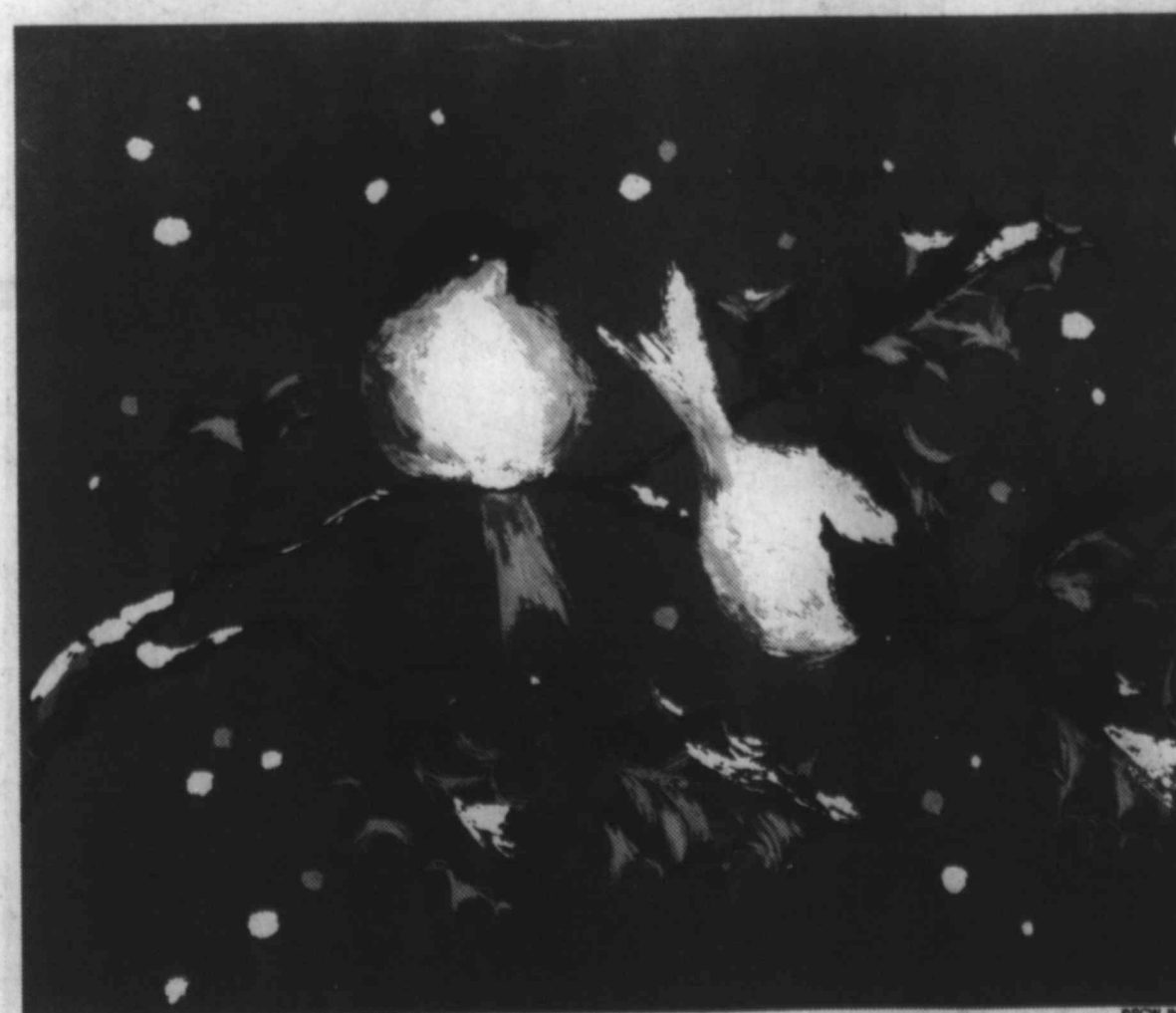

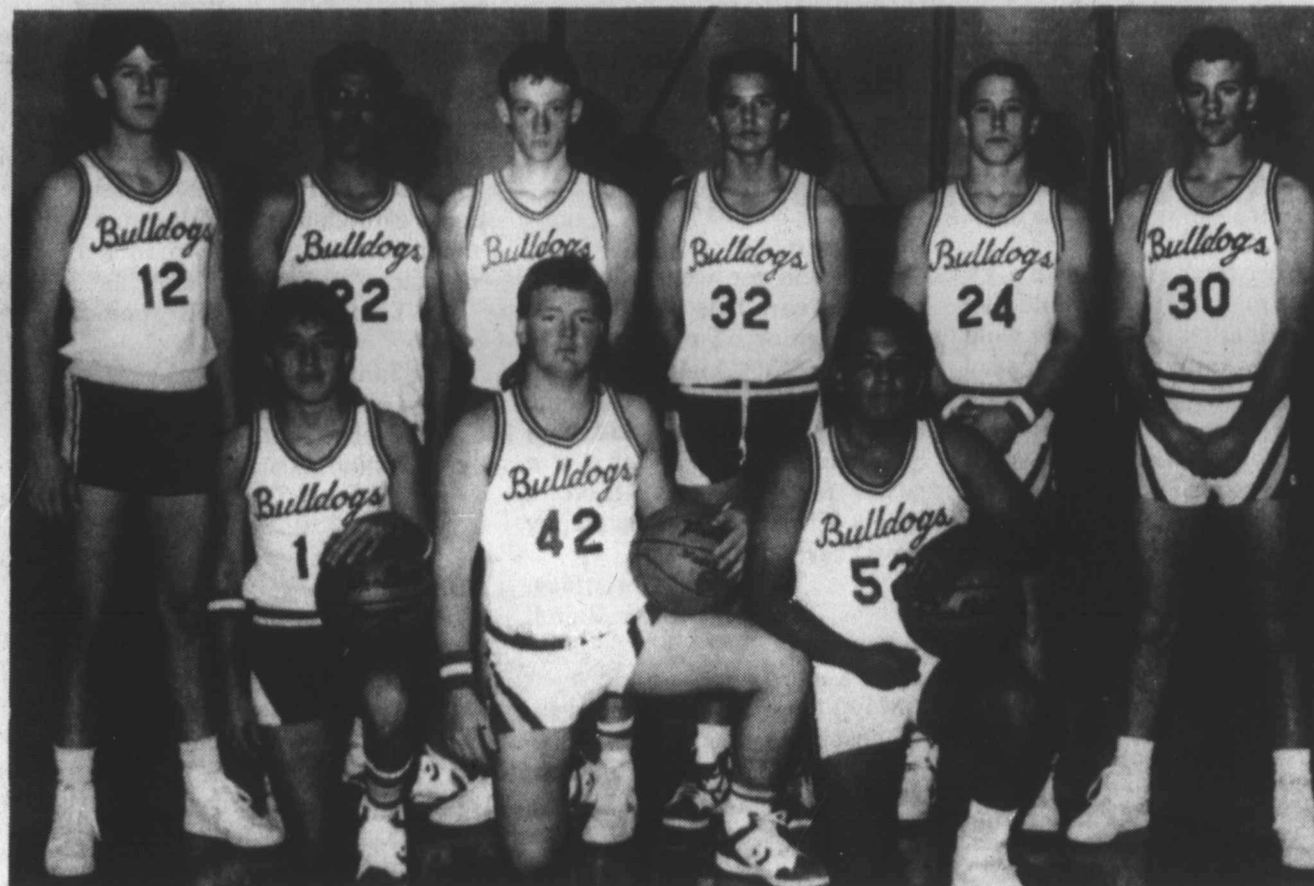

Plan Party To Beat The "Day After" Blues — By taking some practical steps you can put together a holiday party that won't leave your friends regretting what they drank the night before, says a Texas A&M University Agricultural Extension Service nutritionist. Offer plenty of high protein and carbohydrate foods like cheese, meats, raw vegetables and crackers, says Dr. Alice Hunt. These foods stay in the stomach longer, which slows the rate at which the body absorbs alcohol. When guests nibble on food, it also tends to slow the amount of alcohol they drink.

Serve a variety of appealing nonalcoholic beverages as well. Use a jigger or a self-measuring one-ounce bottle spout at the bar to mix drinks. You're not doing your guests any favor by mixing doubles, since the average person can only process about an ounce of alcohol per hour. If you're serving an alcoholic punch, use a noncarbonated base such as fruit juice. When carbonated beverages are used as a base, the alcohol is absorbed faster.

Finally, Hunt suggests that you close the bar and bring out dessert about two hours before the party is over. Serving coffee is a good idea, but remember that it doesn't do anything to clear alcohol from the body; only time can do that, adds the specialist.
