Arrest Clears 31 Diesel Thefts In County

arrested north of New Home Friday Miller. by Lynn County Sheriff Jack Miller, who said the man confessed to 31 thefts of diesel fuel in Lynn County during the last year, dating back to Feb. 2.

Mark Wayne Wilson was charged with theft over \$750 and under \$20,000 and later posted \$15,000 bond set by County Judge J.F. Bran-

Wilson took Lynn County officers around the county Friday and Saturday, pointing out places where he had stolen diesel fuel. He is scheduled to plead before 106th District Judge George Hansard in the case.

"We believe this arrest clears all the diesel theft cases in Lynn County

A 38-year-old Lubbock man was in the last two years," said Sheriff gallons of diesel had been stolen

When Wilson was arrested, he was in a 1982 GMC pickup equipped to carry 220 gallons of fuel. In the back of the pickup were two barrels and a 110-gallon tank, plus a pumphose device for transferring the fuel to his tanks. According to officers, Wilson said he sometimes took more than 220 gallons because his own pickup operates on diesel fuel.

Miller said Wilson told officers he has been selling the diesel fuel to truckers outside a truck stop in Lubbock, charging them 50 cents per gallon. The fuel costs farmers from 70 cents to \$1.15 per gallon.

Miller also said that about 6,005







As you wait in the line to buy your child that Nintendo game, Barbié doll, New Kids on the Block tape, or other similar item, know that you could save yourself money. How, you ask? By "buying" the presents listed below. The "presents" are hard to obtain, but with patience and focused effort, they can be purchased. However, don't bother, looking in the aisles of Toys-R-Us, Target, or Walmart. You can only find them deep in the heart of your child. Yet, your child needs help in bringing these "presents" to the surface. C = Character

For a child, growing up can be a very difficult thing to do. Every child needs to feel loved and wanted. A child must learn to make the best of his circumstances. There are daily dilemmas in life virtually every child will face. They test our children's ability to tell right from wrong and do the right thing. Character is developed by making these tough decisions. H = Health

Proper health involves both physical and emotional well-being. The gift of health involves proper nutrition, plenty of rest, and exercise: Providing proper meals and snacks means eliminating unnecessary junk food. Good nutrition is needed to fight off illness and stress. Maintaining a regular night time schedule will ensure that your child obtains the right amount of rest. Encourage your child to exercise every day to develop a strong body as well as a strong mind. R = Responsibility

Giving your child responsibilities provide opportunities for growth. Select responsibilities that correspond to the child's age, maturation level, and abilities. For example, select tasks that are easy when the child is small and increase the difficulty of the task as the child matures. Always be sure that the child can accomplish the task that he is asked to complete. If a task is assigned, require the child to complete it. Set up appropriate consequences if the task is not completed. Responsibility means holding the child accountable for his actions. I = .Interests Help your child develop interests. Children naturally want to explore and experiment. Children need to try new things and risk the unknown. However, they are looking for your approval and assurances. If you show unease or displeasure, the child will not try. Interests are developed through trial-and-error. At the same time, encourage your child to persevere or "stick to it". Too many children jump from one interest to the next without gaining the full benefit of exploring each interest. Sharing your own interests with your child is one sure way for him to find out about things. At the same time, you are building upon the other 'presents" listed here.

= Success Success is a result of accomplishments and enthusiasm. Success come in both small and large sizes. Success develops self-confidence and self-esteem. Parents can help by providing opportunities for their child to succeed. Praise the child for a job well done. Provide individual attention to your child through comments about and recognition for the accomplishments. Parents can help children understand their strengths. This

T = TimeOne gift that you can give this Christmas, and all year long, is your time. Time spent with children is far more valuable than words or toys. Studies show that most parents spend only a few minutes a day in actual conversation with their children. Most of the time is spent telling the children what they are and are not permitted to do. Since little time may be spent in true communication, children may feel unimportant and feel that their parents do not care about them. Always find some time exclusively for you child each day

M = Memories Memories are built from remembering past experiences. What kind of memories are you helping to build with your child? Are there experiences that are fondly thought of? Or, are there only memories of problems or being left alone? Is the TV or radio your child's constant friend? Memories are built every day. It is easy to fall into a routine. We go about checking off our "Things to Do" list and end up losing sight of the most important thing....building a lifetime of happy memories with our children. At the end of each day, ask yourself, "What memories can my child have from today that will be remembered fondly?" Answering this question can put a whole different twist on how you spend your days

with your child.

A = AspirationsChallenge your child to set and achieve high aspirations or goals. Give your child a sense of direction. Teach that with aspirations, 'first you have to try, and then you have to persist'. Children must learn early on that there will always be others who are more talented then we, who are better looking, who have more education. However, we must always aspire to be more than we presently are. As R.E. Emerson said, "Make the most of aspire towards something higher.

S = Spirituality Children need to realize the true meaning of Christmas. Although much of Christmas has been commercialized, some advertisements do get the message across: "Jesus is the reason for the season:, "Wise men still seek Him", and "Happy Birthday Jesus". Children need to know that there is a Higher Being. Also, they desperately need to have a set of moral standards to guide them. Parents serve as the most important teachers of values for their children. Children need to believe in Christian values such as kindness, honesty, generosity, and justice. Moral standards exert a powerful influence on behavior. What kind of moral standards is your child developing?



YEAR-END TAX STRATEGIES

Profiting From Losses

At this time of year, it's smart to review your portfolio from a taxsaving point of view. Here are some tax rules to keep in mind when you conduct a year-end portfolio review with your financial advisor, along with investment strategies that may work to your advantage. The rules apply to individual (non-corporate) taxpayers. (The tax regulation which applies is printed in bold face type, with the strategies related to the regulation following.)

Under current tax law, an unlimited amount of capital losses may be used to offset capital gains.

To the extent you have realized gains and unrealized losses, consider taking the losses this year to offset the gains; the net effect will be to reduce your 1990 taxes.

Up to \$3,000 of additional capital losses may be deducted against ordinary income. Any further losses must be carried forward to future tax years. (Commodity and index options may be carried back three years).

If you have unrealized losses exceeding your realized gains, consider using as much as \$3,000 of these losses as a current deduction against ordinary income. This could

The "Wash Sale" rule prohibits taking a loss in the current year, if a "substantially identical security" is purchased either 30 days before or after the sale generating the loss. However, the loss does not disappear; it is added to the tax basis of the replacement security. This has the effect of deferring the loss to the year in which you sell the replacement security.

If you sell a security to generate a loss, check with your financial advisor for an appropriate replacement security. Consider the overall diversification of your portfolio, as well as the prospects for the particular security. This year, security sales made up to and including Monday, Dec. 31, the last trading day of the year, establish gains or losses for 1990.

If you wish to take a loss and buy back the same security, wait 31 days to avoid the consequences of the Wash Sale rule.

For 1990, the highest marginal bracket for both ordinary income and capital gains is 33%. For 1991, the highest "official" bracket is 31% for ordinary income and 28% for capital gains.

-Other things being equal, losses in 1990 may be more valuable than losses in 1991 for taxpayers in the top bracket in 1990. However, because many other factors could affect this decision, you should consult your tax advisor before taking action.

Tax savings may be an important consideration in making an investment decision. Investors who use a tax strategy before year-end can potentially save substantial 1990 tax dollars. Check with your tax advisor before making any tax-related investment decisions. If you wish additional informa-
