Barrels Knocked Over North Of Tahoka

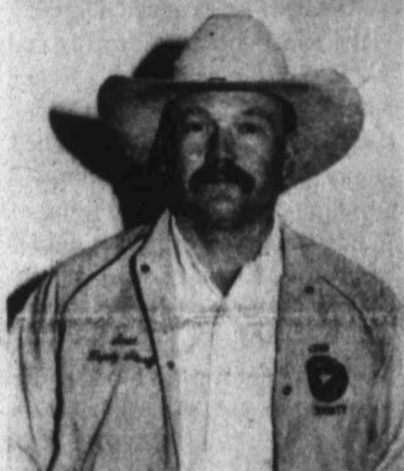
A stop sign and several barrels used in traffic barricades north of Tahoka were knocked down early Sunday morning, a deputy sheriff discovered while on patrol.

The criminal mischief occurred at the intersection of FM 211 and US 87. The equipment is owned by Barricades Unlimited of Lubbock.

County Commissioner Jacky Henry reported to sheriff's officers that someone had dumped junk in a ditch a mile north of Tahoka on County Road R. Investigation of the littering is continuing.

In jail during the week were one person for judgment and sentencing on an application to revoke probation for driving while intoxicated, and he was sentenced to 90 days in county jail by Judge J.F. Brandon. Charges for which others were jailed included possession of a controlled substance (cocaine), no drivers license plus no liability insurance, DWI and two persons for possession of marijuana under two ounces.

Charlie Smith Is Candidate For County Sheriff

Charlie Smith of Wilson, a Lynn County deputy sheriff for the last two years and a 16-year veteran in the field of law enforcement, has announced that he will be a candidate for the office of sheriff of Lynn County in the Democratic Primary in March.

Smith, 37, is a native of Lynn County who attended school at Wilson. He and his wife, Mindi, have three children, Ryan, 13; Sara, 8; and Camela, 10 months.

His law enforcement experience includes 10 years with the Lubbock Police Dept., five of which was investigative work.

"I certainly will appreciate every vote and all the support I can get," Smith said. "I will do my very best to satisfy the law enforcement needs of Lynn County residents."

Sheriff Diggs Announces For Re-Election

Lynn County Sheriff Jake Diggs this week announced that he is a candidate for re-election to that job.

Diggs, 40, has been a certified peace officer since 1977 and previously was employed by Levelland Police Dept. and the Hockley County and Crosby County sheriff's departments.

A resident of Lynn County for 12 years, Diggs began his duties as part-time deputy in 1986 and continued as a full-time deputy. In October, 1993, he was appointed sheriff by the Lynn County commissioners following the retirement of Sheriff Jack Miller. In 1994, Diggs ran and was elected sheriff.

"If re-elected," said Diggs, "I will continue to serve the citizens of Lynn County to the best of my ability."

Diggs is on the ballot for the Democratic Primary next March 12.

Return Ballots By Dec. 28 For Expanded Toll-Free Calling

Tahoka telephone subscribers should have received in the mail last Friday the new ballots on proposed Expanded Local Calling (ELC), toll-free to several area exchanges. Telephone users in Tahoka may vote on service allowing toll-free calls to Lubbock, O'Donnell, Brownfield, Lamesa and Post, and return the ballots in the provided envelope by Dec. 28.

Although the ballots say "no additional charge will be assessed to your monthly bill for exchanges that pass the ballot," the accompanying notes with the ballot explain that a fee of no more than \$3.50 per month per line will be added to residential phone bills, and no more than \$7 per line per month will be assessed for business phones.

If 70 per cent or more of the ballots returned favor direct calls to the five cities listed, GTE will add those exchanges for toll-free calling

to and from Tahoka, at the stated monthly fee. Once approved by voters, ELC service will not be a per-line option for customers to choose, but will be provided for all Tahoka customers across the board, and the mandatory monthly fee will be assessed to all customers.

The ballot, headed "Tahoka Project No. 14636", should be completed by marking "yes" or "no" next to the five exchanges listed, as well as a signature and phone number of the person completing the ballot. Ballots must be returned by mail by Dec. 28 for canvassing. City officials should receive notification on the results of the ballot by the end of January, 1996.

Although the ballot provides a space next to each of the five cities listed, enabling customers to choose which exchanges they want in the service, the monthly cost is the same whether one, two, three, four or five exchanges are marked.

TISD Audit Approved, Math Teacher Hired

Tahoka Independent School District Board of Trustees met last Thursday evening in regular session, approving the district's annual audit, hiring a high school math teacher, authorizing an investment option for district funds, and approving a substitute teacher list, among other routine business.

Trustees unanimously approved employing Lana Killough of Tahoka for the remainder of this school year as a high school math teacher. She will teach freshman algebra, filling a vacancy which has been taught by a substitute teacher for the past several weeks.

Joe Hays of Love Hays & Reeger, L.L.P., presented the 1994-95 annual district audit to trustees, who approved the audit as presented.

Superintendent David Hutton recommended, and trustees unanimously approved, authorizing an investment agreement for the district's participation in Texas Association of School Board's (TASB) Lone Star Investment Pool, which will allow another option for investing district funds.

The monthly financial statement was presented by Business Manager Loretta Tekell, who reported an ac-

count balance in all funds of \$2,455,636.78.

A list of six substitute teachers was unanimously approved by the board, and two local board policies concerning work assignment schedules and student overnight trips were approved as presented in the local district update provided by TASB's Policy Service. Trustees authorized Supt. Hutton to sell or dispose of outdated surplus school property which was stored in a warehouse, and to sell or dispose of an outdated 60-passenger school bus which the district can not use.

Principals Bill Alcorn, Glo Hays and Ronald Roberts presented campus reports and attendance figures, and the superintendent made a brief report to trustees, including authorization of an overnight trip for BPA students to attend a session in Amarillo in February.

Trustees met for an hour and a half in closed session during the three-hour meeting. All seven trustees were present, as well as several district staff and administrative personnel. Trustees set a special meeting at 7:30 a.m. Friday, Dec. 22 to look at bids on the proposed gym renovations, and the next regular meeting will be held Thursday, Jan. 11 at 7 p.m.

GTE Accelerates Plans For Digital Phone Service Across State

GTE recently announced accelerated plans to provide digital telephone service to all of its Texas customers by the end of 1997, two years ahead of original plans, at an investment of over \$37 million. Under the accelerated schedule during 1996, the company will average more than one office replacement each week.

GTE already serves 95 percent of its Texas customers with the modern digital technology. The newer technology provides added service capabilities, such as the basic call waiting, call transfer and call forward, as well as the more advanced services, such as automatic call return, busy number redial, call block and VIP alert.

As a part of the regulatory reform, GTE committed to accelerate the company's original five-year plan for digital modernization into four years. That plan has now been accelerated into a three-year plan.

The accelerated schedule moves 23 locations from the 1997 schedule and 22 locations from the 1998 schedule into 1996 (including Wilson phone

customers), and 23 offices from the original 1999 schedule into 1997.

To benefit 32,000 customers in 44 locations, a compromise was reached between GTE and the Public Utility Commission of Texas to delay elimination of party-line service for 780 customers at a cost of almost \$11 million, allowing the company to accelerate the placement of the new switching equipment.

GTE will place digital switching equipment in 61 locations during 1996 and complete the program with the remaining 23 communities in 1997.

Assembly Of God Sets Christmas Day Service

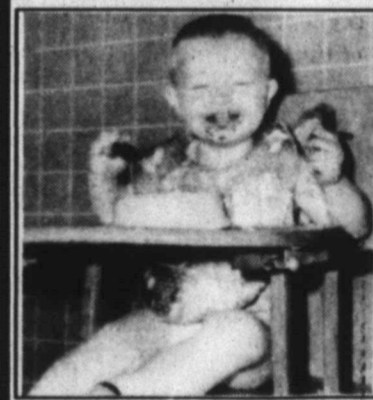
The Assembly of God is having a church service on Monday, Dec. 25 at 5 p.m.

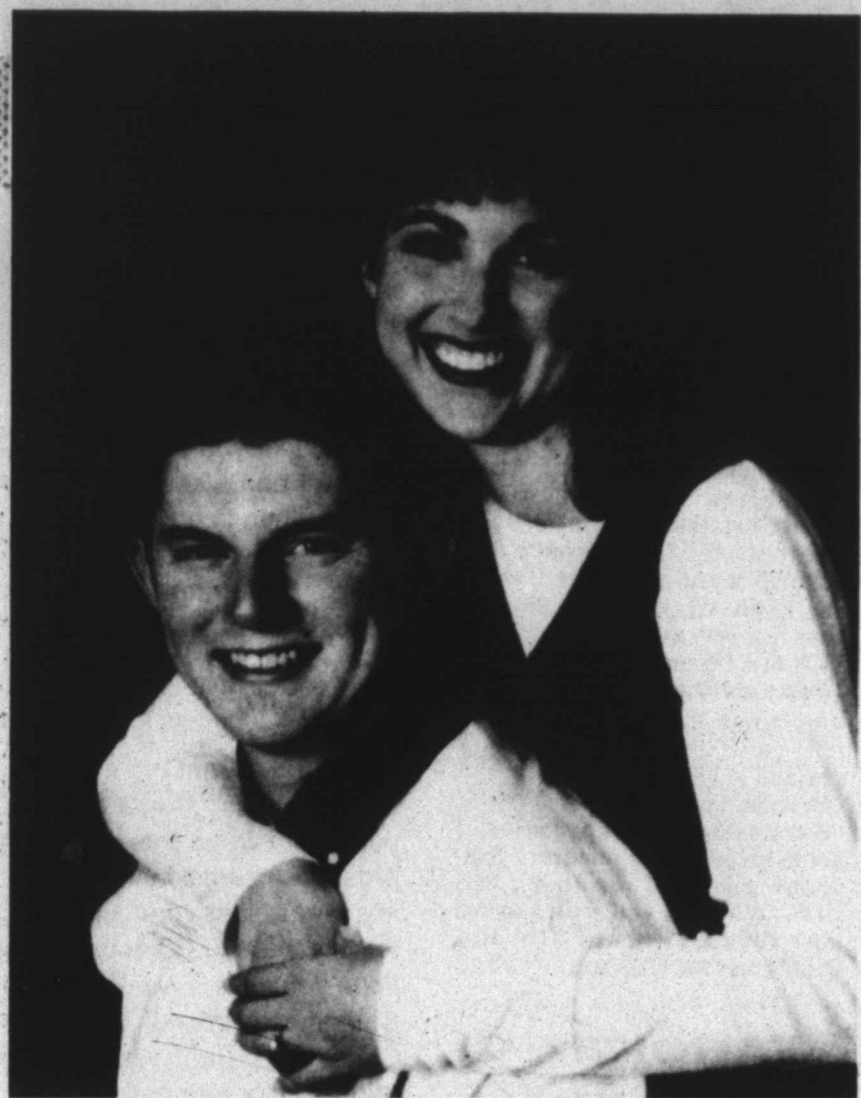

SAFETY LIST!

- Check all cords for frayed or bare wires, cracked insulation, loose connections and damaged plugs or light sockets.
- Test lights before stringing.
- Unplug lights before making any repairs or replacing light bulbs.
- Don't overload circuits with too many plugs!
- No lights on metallic trees.
- Keep your tree fresh by trimming the base and keeping plenty of water in the tree stand.
- Turn off all lights before leaving or going to bed.
- Don't use indoor lights outside.
- Avoid outdoor electrical lines when hanging lights on the rooftop or in tall trees.
- Use waterproof lighting equipment outdoors. Hang sockets downward and don't leave a socket empty.

EXPANDED LOCAL CALLING: VOTE "YES" FOR ALL 5 CITIES

Customers of GTE in the Tahoka Calling Exchange will soon have the opportunity to vote for Expanded Toll-Free Local Calling.

Expanded Toll-Free Local Calling has been requested by the City of Tahoka on behalf of its citizens. The Petition filed with the Public Utility Commission requests Expanded Toll-Free Local Calling to Brownfield, Lamesa, Lubbock, O'Donnell and Post. This would allow calls to and from these cities without any long distance charges.

The Public Utility Commission has tentatively approved the five cities requested for Expanded Toll-Free Local Calling by the City of Tahoka. This will initiate GTE mailing out ballots to GTE customers in Tahoka asking each to vote for or against Expanded Toll-Free Local Calling to the five named cities. Each ballot returned must be post-marked prior to the expiration of fifteen (15) days from the date of mailing to be considered. Seventy percent (70%) of the ballots returned must vote in favor of the Expanded Toll-Free Local Calling to pass. If the ballots returned vote "yes" by seventy percent (70%)

or more on each of the cities, each residence will be billed an additional \$3.50 per line per month and businesses will be billed an additional \$7.00 per line per month. This charge will be for all five of the requested communities, not a separate charge for each.

Passage of Expanded Toll-Free Local Calling will mean a substantial savings for the citizens in the Tahoka Calling Exchange. Savings will not only be realized by local residences in their long distance calling but also will save taxing entities within the City significant sums in their long distance charges.

Thousands Of Taxpayers Due 1994 Refunds

Over 97,700 taxpayers have yet to receive their 1994 refund checks according to the Internal Revenue Service. The undeliverable refunds total over \$81 million, an average of \$834 per check. In the Dallas District, there are some 3,300 North Texas taxpayers whose uncollected tax refunds totalling \$2.7 million, resulting in an average refund of over \$800 per person.

These refund checks were returned by the Postal Service because they were unable to deliver them. Many taxpayers move and do not give IRS their new addresses and

thousands of other refund checks have incorrect names or addresses.

The IRS says many taxpayers can avoid delays in getting their refund by sending IRS a change of address - Form 8822 - when they move. Also, taxpayers who file electronically can have their refund deposited directly into their bank account. This year, for the first time, taxpayers who file paper returns will have the option of direct deposit by filing Form 8888 with their return. Direct deposit eliminates the possibility of lost, stolen or undelivered refund checks.

Though every year there are thousands of undelivered refunds, this total is small compared to the total number of refunds. Last filing season 79 million refunds were delivered averaging \$1,175.

GTE Explains Reason For New ELC Ballots

Tahoka telephone customers should have received new Expanded Local Calling (ELC) ballots in the last few days showing a corrected list of routes and corrected maximum rates, according to General Telephone representatives.

"The original petition filed with the Public Utilities Commission of Texas by Tahoka seeking the expanded local calling service included Southland, which was later eliminated, as well as O'Donnell, Lubbock, Brownfield, Lamesa and Post. In the preparation of the ballots, Southland was not removed from the ballot," explained a GTE representative.

Since Public Utility Commission of Texas rules established by legislation set maximum rates for the service, the first ballots incorrectly said the maximum charge would be \$5 for each residential line and \$8.50 for each business line.

With the removal of Southland

from each ballot, the maximum rates will not exceed \$3.50 for residential line and \$7 for business line, according to information from GTE.

The Tahoka City Council stopped the first balloting process since the rates and routes were incorrect, and asked GTE to issue corrected ballots, which Tahoka customers should now have.

The commission rules set rates at a maximum of \$3.50 for residence and \$7 for business for up to five routes. Each route over five is \$1.50 for each business and residential line. With Southland incorrectly shown, the potential maximum rate was increased by \$1.50.

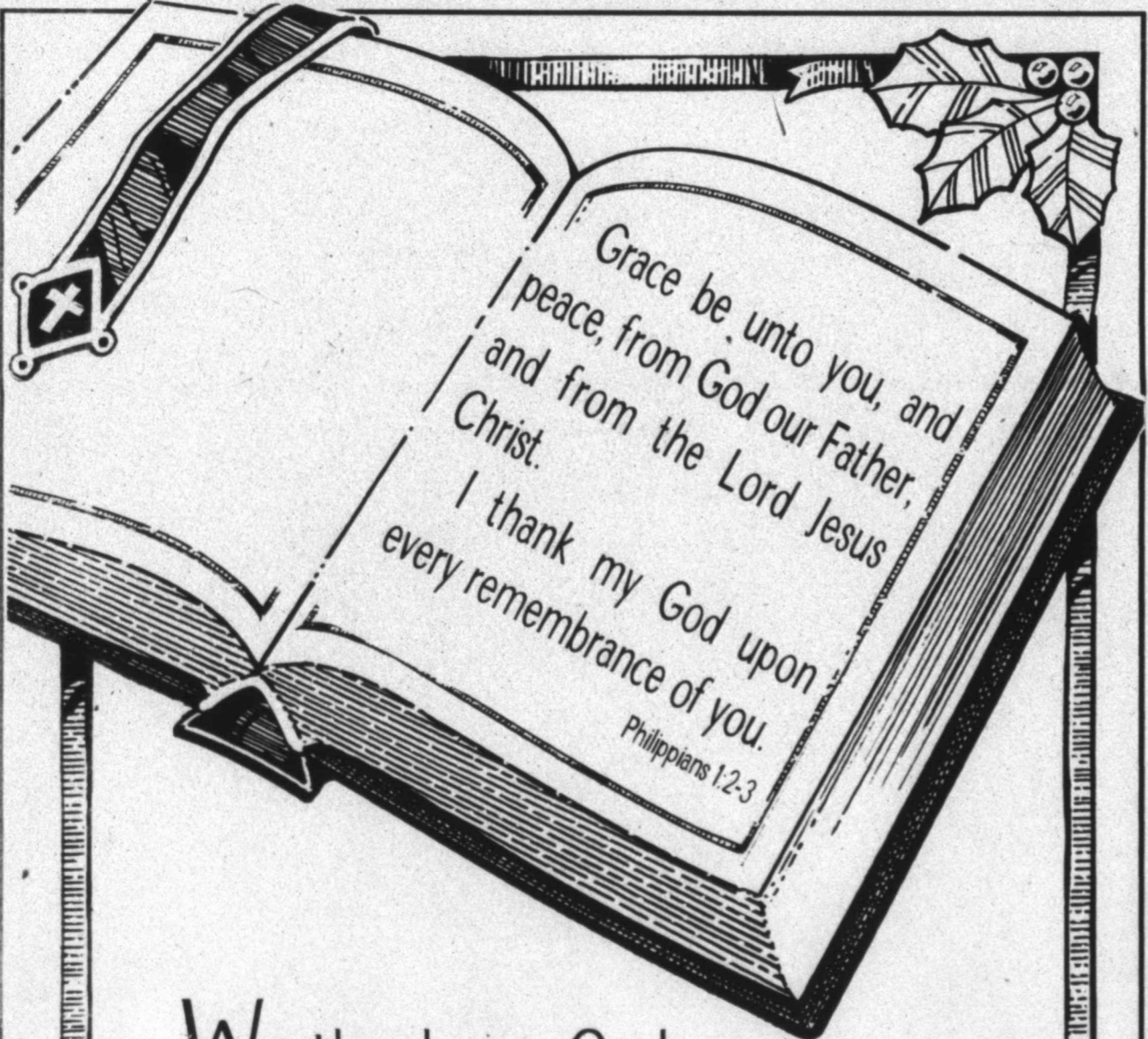
The revised ballots, showing O'Donnell, Lubbock, Brownfield, Lamesa and Post at a maximum of \$3.50 for each residential line and \$7 for each business line, should be returned in the provided, postage-paid envelopes by Dec. 28, 1995.

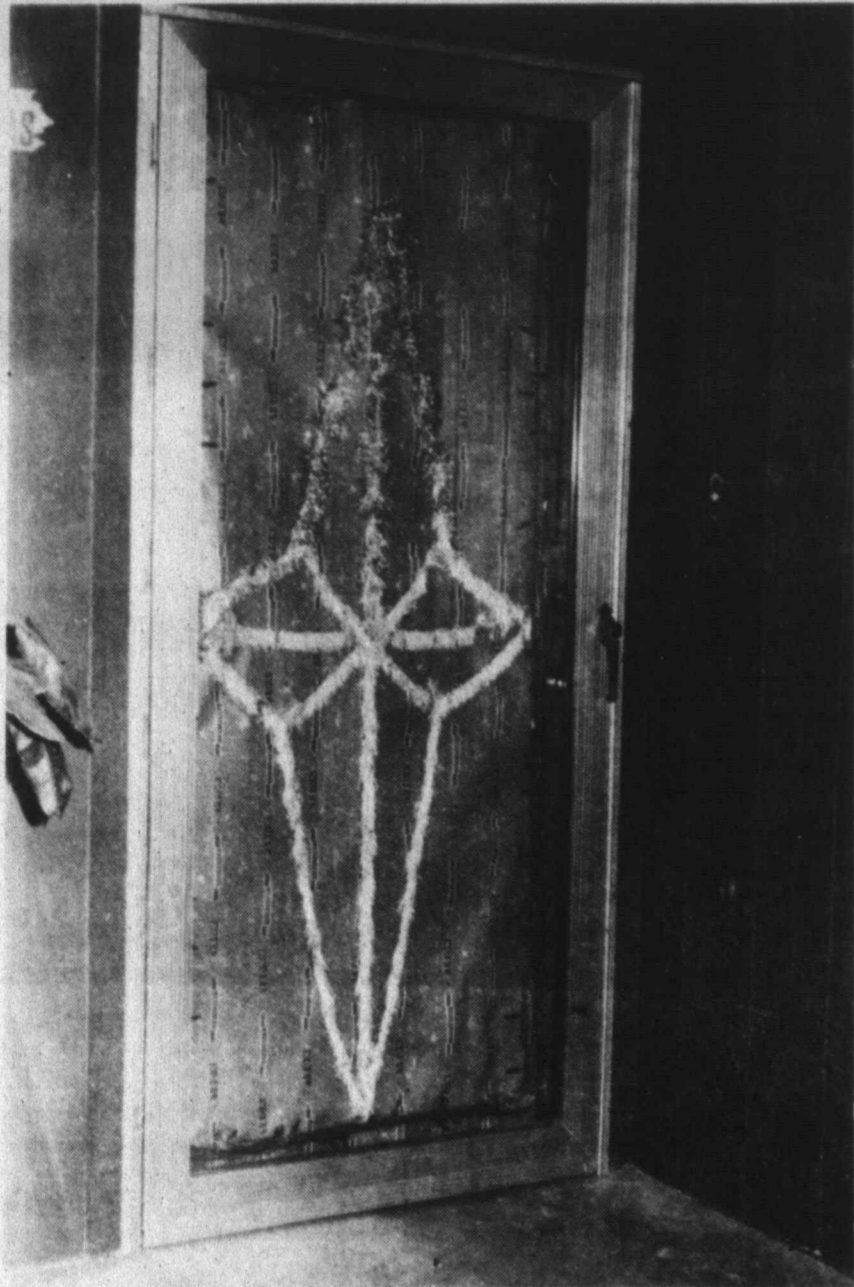

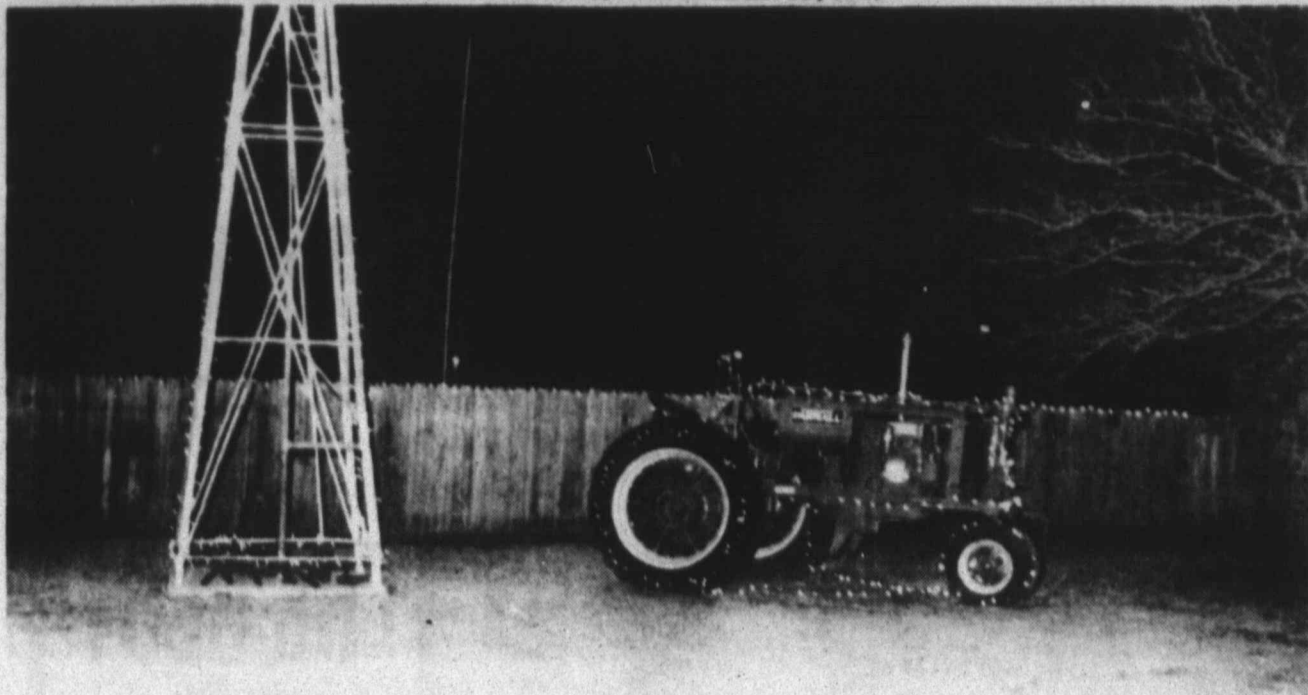
