It's a timely question, because, without enough capable leadership, that's exactly what could happen. <br> The local troup is to have its charter re-issued on March 31, and it's very important that they have a scoutmaster by that time. <br> The Muleshoe Lions Club is the sponsor for Troup 620, and are doing their part meeting place. <br> A prospective scoutmaster need not be | out. Owen Jones, who is Neighborhood Commissioner for the Muleshoe Scouts, emphasizes that the troup has a capable assistant in George Haskins, and good assistance from senior scouts. <br> But one adult leader isn't enough to provide the boys with sufficient leadership.
