## Analysis of Texas Soils.

The chemical division of the Texas Experiment Station recent-
ly published in bulletin 100 the conclusions drawn from a numbe of analyses of representative Texa
soils. A full account of this work soils. A full account of this work
with all the detailed analyses has now been published in bulletin 99
Only a limited number of bulle tin number 99 has been printed, it will not be sent out to the genera mailing list, but it can be secured
by those who are interested, upon by those who are interested, upon
application to the director of the experiment station.
Bulletin 99 describes the fund: mental principles underlying
fertility of the soil, the causes of small crops, the methods of main taining and increasing soil fertility the value of chemical analysis soils, and the interpretation of th
