Dear Sir: We have your communi-

"Where a survey calls for the bank of a river does that mean the first or second bank of the river ?" Your inquiry is for the purpose of
determining who owns certain pecan determining who owns certain pecan
trees on the bank of the Brazos river -the public or private individuals.
In reply thereto, I will refer you to some facts of an opinion prepared on a similar subject by Mr.Smedley, formerly of this Department. The
question under discussion in the opinuestion under discussion in the opin-
ion was what constitutes the boundary of Texas along Sed river. In dis-
cussing same the writer says: "It is a general rule that whien the bank of a stream is described as the
boundary the title will extend to the boundary the title will extend to the
margin of the stream unless there is margin of the stream unless there is
something to limit it to the top of the bank See Farrhan on Water
