Notes on the Early History of San Antonio.

We are requested to publish the following notes on the early history of our city, compiled by Rev. FATHER JOHN, pastor of St. Mary's. These notes have been published before in a print of our city, but are regarded as being so interesting by some of our friends that we make room for them...

The Mission of San Antonio de Valero, better known as the Alamo, was founded in the year of our Lord, 1763, on the banks of the Rio Grande under the direction of St. Augustin de Valencia.

The above is taken from a memorandum in the National Archives of the Mission of San Antonio de Valero. Another memorandum found in the same books, states that the Mission, on account of scarcity of water at the Mission of San Jose, was May 18, 1763, moved to its present location...
