ROCHESTER, Oct. 23.—Extensive fires in swamps and woods in Monroe, Orleans, Niagara, Genesee, Wayne and Seneca counties. Wind blowing a gale. Smoke compels the use of lamps here to-day.

TOPEKA, Oct. 23.—In the United States district court to-day, three men were sentenced to five years imprisonment each for stealing government mules at Fort Hooker; one man for two years for personating a government officer; one for ten years for robbing registered letters; one for six months under the enforcement act, for stuffing ballot boxes.

ST. LOUIS, Oct. 23.—The circuit court, with full bench, refused to enjoin the county clerk from selling railroad property for taxes. The Central American Insurance Company has suspended.
