TELEGRAPHIC NEWS.

FROM WASHINGTON.
WASHINGTON, Nov. 1.—A courier arrived at Matamoros on the 27th, bringing news to the 23d from the capital of Mexico. All was quiet. Diaz was not in the field. All Governors had offered Juarez their congratulations and support to suppress the Monterey pronouncement. Jurists deny the capitulation of Saltillo. The revolutionists hold communications between Monterey and the border.

FROM NEW YORK.
NEW YORK, Nov. 1.—James Fisk, Jr., was formally arrested last evening on a writ of Josephine Mansfield, on civil action, to recover fifty thousand dollars of Mansfield's which Fisk used, but failed to account for. He gave bail in \$25,000. A letter from Mansfield to Fisk rebukes him for perjury to her. She says it is a shame to compel her, who grew up with him from nothing to the now great Erie impresario, to vindicate herself in court. She refers to his scheme, revealed to her four years ago, of stealing the Erie books, of staying with him in Jersey City, and how, when he was buying the New York Legislature, he said it would either result in a Fisk palace in New York or a stone palace at Sing-Sing, and requested her, if it was the latter, to take a cottage outside the prison. She is willing to have affairs arbitrated by Wm. M. Everts, but says if his power over courts is still supreme, and Tammany still able to protect him, the reward may still be his.

CINCINNATI, Nov. 1.—Daily Enquirer, leading Democratic organ of Ohio, contains an editorial, this morning, expressing preference for Thomas A. Scott, of Pennsylvania, as Democratic candidate for the Presidency. Article discusses Mr. Scott's fitness for the office at considerable length.
