In conclusion, I would sum up the policy of the Administration to be a thorough and complete reformation of every law, a faithful collection of every tax provided for, economy in the disbursement of the treasury, a prompt payment of every debt of the nation, a reduction of the taxes as rapidly as the requirements of the country will admit, the reduction of the tariff as far as it can be arranged as to afford the greatest relief to the greatest number, honest and fair dealing with all its obliging consequences, may be avoided, but without abandonment any right or obligation to the nation, a reform in the most of Indians and in the whole civil service of the country, and finally in securing a more economical and efficient government, which is entitled to a vote may do as just as any other, without fear of retaliation or punishment on account of his political faith, activity or color.
