Grant and Wilson nominated
at a meeting at Austin.

At the request of the members of the County Republican Executive Committee, a grand mass meeting of the Republicans of Texas is called at Austin on Friday, July 4, to ratify and endorse the nomination of Grant and Wilson for President and Vice-President of the United States.

Committees of arrangements, reception etc., will be announced at an early day.

Distinctions between various positions of the State will be present to address the people.

Provisions will be made for the entertainment of friends at a distance.

Land Titles Again.

Recently we had occasion to insert in the columns of the EXPRESS more than four-fifths of the titles to land in this city and county had already been determined by decrees of the highest courts. We are satisfied that if instead of four-fifths, we had stated nine-tenths one-hundredths, we should have more nearly approached the truth. The fact is, there is scarcely to be found in this State, or in any other State, so large an extent of contiguous territory as that which is comprised within the limits of Bexar County, the titles to which have already been finally adjudicated by the courts. But we allude to this subject again for another purpose, than that repetition; and that is to call the attention of the public to the insecurity of the records of these titles. We have before us a number of titles, but our reading has been limited to a few. The fact is, this is a sinister movement to prevent the title of this district from being cast for Gen. Grant. The intention is, no doubt, to nominate Jas. P. Newcomb for Congress, with the view of drawing off as many votes of the colored people as possible from the regular ticket. Of course a split in the republican ranks secures the election of a democratic Congressman for this district; but Newcomb feels no concern—he has made his bargain, and is probably secure in his price. What care has he for party success, or the election of the Governor, so long as he can earn considerable wages—and spite the "damned Dutch"?

In this matter the Herald, and the democracy in general, can scarcely be blamed. An ambitious wretch throws himself into their arms, they embrace her for a purpose, and will cast her out with scorn as soon as this purpose is accomplished. Then James will be "my man." But what becomes of the poor monkeys who will have used to pick their chestnuts out of the fire with? It is to be hoped they will have made a Darwinian progress, and will have advanced enough to have forgotten their primal anties; otherwise they might be given over to reflections too human to be comfortable.

Notes from Washington.

Exit Congressmen, Cabinet and President—Where they go, and what they do—The President at Long Branch, Boston, Niagara Falls and Groton—Freedom for the Cubans.

Washington, June 17, 1912. Congress has adjourned and Senators, Representatives and Government officials are leaving the city as if flying from a landing pestilence. A six months session of steadily increasing business work is regarded as the most extraordinary in the history of the country. The members of Congress, particularly those who are on one or more important committees, do more mental labor in the course of a Congressional session, than any other class of men that could be named; not excepting the chief editors of a daily paper, and they go home to seek rest of a few weeks. Others return to their respective States to attend to neglected business, while still another portion of the Congressional body remains in active service on the Presidential campaign, which promises to be one of the most sharply contested we have had since 1908. There will be a large number of public speakers engaged in the campaign, and their political demands are of a high order. The question of the tariff will be the subject of much discussion, and there was never put before the public in any previous campaign. The free-traders, who have met with signal defeat in the past, and tariff bill of the last session of Congress, and then in the nomination of Greeley at Cincinnati, are still active in their efforts. They have called another meeting to be held in New York on the 23d, to consult as to the course to be adopted in the campaign. In the mean time the Free Trade League of New York, with its headquarters and offices throughout the different States, is sending the country with free trade pamphlets and papers, and sending public speakers into the agricultural districts to "educate" the political people. The Democrats and Liberals are showing out their political stunts and
