The fire burned over an area of about four miles in length and an average of two thirds of a mile in breadth, destroying 17,450 buildings, and rendered 98,000 persons houseless. The property destroyed was insured for \$100,000,000; the losses claimed amounting to about \$400,000,000 less. Of the sum due, \$37,000,000, has been paid, and there is a tair prospect of \$12,000,000 more, if some companies are not overwhelmed by the great fire in Boston. The loss of life was happily small in Chicago, and the generosity of the world enabled the local committees to disburse more than \$2,000,000 in
