The President's Message.

The following is a very complete synopsis of President Grant's fourth annual message to the Congress. The message begins as follows: To the Senate and House of Representatives: In transmitting to you this my fourth annual message, it is with thankfulness to the Giver of all good that as a nation we have been blessed for the past year with peace at home, peace abroad, and a general prosperity unexampled to but few people. The only exception noted is the recent devastating fire in Boston. 'Othertwise,' says the message, 'we have been free from pestilence, and have had no serious outbreaks of cholera, and as far as human judgment can penetrate the future, no cause seems to exist to threaten our present peace and prosperity.'

OUR synopsis of the President's message is sufficiently complete for general information. The message itself is so succinct and to the point upon every subject, that it seemed difficult to condense into smaller space than that we have allotted to it. We commend it to the careful perusal of our readers.

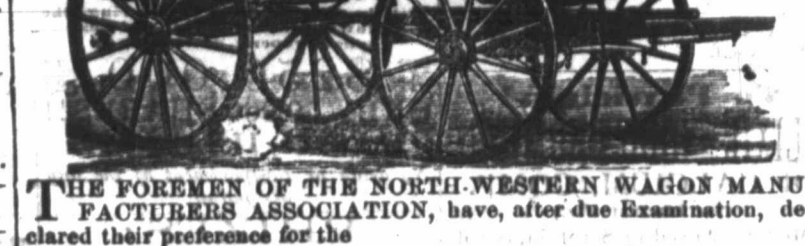
