Thoroughbred and Mixed

In reply to a correspondent who asked the Western Rural the precise meaning of the "full-blood" and "thoroughbred," the following answer was given, and as some of our readers may be interested in hav ing a satisfactory definition, we copy the article:

"We think our sprightly correspondent, "Uncle Sam," intended to use the word "fall blood" in its proper sense, as meaning an animal strongly imbued with pure blood. Terminology is a branch of science that ought to be understood by every breeder, and we cheerfully comply with the request of "Suburban," who is one of our first breed

There are various terms used to designate animals—as "families." "breeds," "races," etc. For instance, our domesticated cattle belong to oue family of the genus Bos, which adage. The old adage is not always ticular families, and the word race is generally used synonymously with breed, or rather the former FACTORY, term is used when applied to men, ish people would only do things and the latter word, breed, when

applied to animals. The term "blooded" is used as applied to animals containing a applied to animals containing a say a word to discourage any one large share of the characteristics of from laughing—far from it. Keep any given breed of animals. "Fullblood" is applied to animals containing seven eights of more of blood of a distinct race, or breed, or more usually, now, to a female descendant bred for four or more consecutive generations to a sire of pure or thorough blood. "Thoroughbred" is applied to an animal whose pedigree may be traced through sire or dam, uncontaminated by mixture to certain progenit

ors, or originators of the race.
Thus, strictly speaking, the pedi-Thus, strictly speaking, the pedigree of a thoroughbred race horse should be traced "lineally and collaterally" to an approved Oriental source—"the fountain head of the best blood of England." "Pure bloods" are animals with seven eighths or more of pure or thorough blood; "highbred" are those not fully thoroughbred, or whose pedigree is not perfect in every respect; "thoroughbreds" are animals who can be traced through sire and and dam to some original stock, without admixture, and "pure bloods" are racers, the distinctive qualities of which are unceringly transmitted to their descendants.

His eyes will soon show that bewildered profound stupor which will soon affect him. Of course he should be firmly held or bound, so that under any circumstances he will be perfeetly under control. Animals usually stand up through ordinary operations, but it they get too much of the chloroform and ether, they may fall. This must be provided against, and while the ani mal has still consciousness he must be made to lie down. For the performance of many operations consciousness need never leave the animal, and it is often best it should not. A condition of entire unconsciousness, particularly if accom panied by a very feeble pulse, indicates that enough of the anæsthetic had been administered for present needs, and the cloth may be partially removed, to be applied again, however, should the coma or in sensible condition not last long enough.

Besides the use of these agents in effecting insensibility in cases of surgical operations upon injured or diseased animals, by their means a fractious horse may be made manageable while being shod; colts may be gelt, cows spayed, and other similar operations performed which any ingenious farmer may do himself after a proper investigation.


