It is well known that a few leading spirits in the Central Pacific Railroad Company became visionaries in a remarkably short space of time, but just how their extraordinary prosperity was achieved is not so generally understood.

The San Francisco Union, which publishes an account of this transaction, intimates that the Central Pacific Railroad Company, organized in 1850, had a capital of \$1,000,000, and that their liabilities, exclusive of capital paid in, were \$208,278.06.

Five millions of dollars have already been expended by the International Company in Texas, and the road is now in running order for one hundred and twenty miles.
