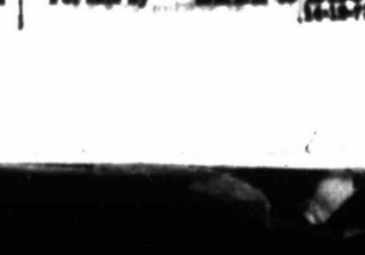

Mr. D. MOORE announces himself as the editor of the Dallas Herald. In politics he is subject to the commands of the Democratic party. His ambition is to drive from this sunny land the terrible blight which has been set upon it by the maladministration of the general government. Can anyone explain what the politics will be of what the "blighting blight" is?

AUSTRIA and France, having both been whipped by Prussia, are quarrelling as to which of the two is to blame for their common overthrow. It needs but little statesmanship to see that Prussia is to blame. As for Austria, they wouldn't have been whipped. Instead of quarrelling about the origin of war, the two nations had better apply themselves in earnest to healing its wounds.

THE pre-Adamite editor of our neighbor the Herald has returned to his pedestal. He comes as fresh and young as ever; as blooming and as infantile as the first crab apple which grew in paradise. But of that celebrated tree in "Eden's embowered garden," he has not yet eaten of the fruit thereof. The modern Era's selfish, don't divide fair, and hence knowledge is difficult to obtain. There is not the slightest danger of our darwinian custom pony ever being driven out of a garden by either a flaming sword or a broom stick.

He had evidently been to Spain. How pleasant it must have been to visit Spain and come back without a single line of the apple of discord! How good one must feel in such ignorance and innocence! Here his blinding discourse: "The Carlist Revolution in Spain has progressed to such a degree as to compel King Amadeus to flee the country with his family. At last accounts he was at Lisbon on his way to Oxford."

Now the Carlist revolution has had just about as much to do with the abdication of Amadeus as it had with the refusal of the great, and good, and virtuous and incomparable Bismarck to sign the bonds due to the International Railway Company.

But Humboldt died too soon! He was at least a century in advance of "his times." If he had lived to have witnessed the journey of the King to Oxford by way of Lisbon, he might have died happy, and have been honored by a historical, geographical and paleontographical description of an unparalleled journey through the columns of the Atlantic. But he thought that this state of things will enable the poor Cubans to consummate their revolution, which is consoling.

Spanish News.

The news from Spain is decidedly interesting. The abdication of King Amadeus will prove a surprise outside of diplomatic circles, and the establishment of a Republican government upon the peninsula is a most extraordinary and blooded, and with some little promise of success. It is another of the remarkable occurrences which will in the future be regarded as an epoch in the history of Spain. The abdication has not been brought about by the Carlists' attempts at revolution, nor, so far as appears, by any effort to change the person of the monarchy. It is rather due to the antagonism of policies which has been irreconcilable between the King and the Cortes. The King wanted to see the people whom he had undertaken to govern. He has been in favor of the abolition of slavery in the Spanish possessions, while the Cortes has opposed it. He has favored a liberal policy towards Cuba, the Cortes has, on the contrary, urged adherence to the old disastrous policy of Isabella too proud and impractical to understand the spirit of modern civilization.

The supposed establishment of Republicanism will prove a delusion as long as the national union of State and church continues. The people of Spain do not know what they want, and hence they do not know how to get it. They are too much accustomed to the po-

litical speculation as to free religious belief, and were the dust and cobwebs of ages to be swept away suddenly, they would become as homeless as the simple country lass when suddenly translated from her humble cottage into a palace of whose magnificence she had never dreamed.

But good results will flow in the end from the national aspiration for a higher life. There is a leaven in the simple name of Republic which will work a silent but sure change. Let us hope for the best in spite of the stubborn, untoward facts which everywhere impede the path of progress in Spain.

The International Railway at Austin.

There is no doubt of the existence of a powerful influence at Austin to defeat the building of this railway towards San Antonio. The influence derives its courage from the selfish aims of other railroads not running in this direction. It is a ring formed by all the railroad lobbyists who were defeated by the votes of Gov. Davis in their effort to obtain control of the last Legislature. They are determined now to rule or ruin, and have concentrated all their venom against the International. If the present Legislature cannot rise above these influences, and see to it that the interests of Western Texas are not wholly sacrificed in this miserable intrigue and scramble, its deeds will pass into history as the most infamous and corrupt of any which ever afflicted Texas.

An English Opinion of Samana.

Naturally enough English newspaper commenting on the Samana paper purchase, looks chiefly at the possibilities of an impinging of English interests. This survey of the situation is satisfactory to the London Daily News which says:

There is absolutely nothing in this acquisition of territory to give rise to any diplomatic complication, even if our interests were in any way endangered by it, as no one will allege that they are. Our Government was one of the first to recognize the independence of San Domingo when the inhabitants of the eastern part of the island separated themselves from the Haytiens in the west; and the Government of the Republic is fully competent to make an agreement of this kind. We have quite as much territory as we want in the Columbian archipelago, and may watch the extension of American influence there without jealousy. From the point of view of impartial political observation, however we may doubt the wholesomeness of the tendency to acquire territory beyond the continental limits which has gained strength during the administration of General Grant.

The juror of the period may hang his harp on the first convenient willow and sit down and weep in despair. No twelve men can hope to equal the verdict of the bulkheads of our national liberties, lately rendered in Townsendtown, Md., not guilty, because of insanity at the time of the commission of the deed, but find the prisoner sane now.

One more popular belief has been remorselessly swept away—that is the old and well established belief that whoever had in his possession an umbrella was owner of it. A man in England, who was recently found with one he could not account for in a manner satisfactory to the court, not only had all his old theories on that subject upset, but was sent to prison for fourteen miserable days.

LATEST NEWS.

LONDON, Feb 12, 10 A. M. The Cortes yesterday was the central point of interest, and bulletins of its proceedings were anxiously awaited by crowds of persons in all public places of the city. The two houses assembled at a late hour in the day. The formal message of the abdication of King Amadeus was read in each chamber separately. It opens with the statement that the King has maturely considered the question as to what course he ought to pursue with reference to the Spanish throne, and has firmly resolved upon that course. When he accepted the crown he did so under the belief that the loyalty of the people who called him would compensate him for the experience which he brought to his task. He had found that he was deceived. If the assembly who had beset his path had been foreigners, he would not have taken the course now determined upon; but they are Spaniards. By them Spain had been kept in perpetual disquiet; and his efforts to quiet her and put an end to intrigues which were the source of her agitation, had proved unavailing. It was not enough that he had a partisan support. He had so with him to remain on the throne as King of a party. He therefore, announced his abdication on behalf of himself and his heirs.

Upon the completion of the reading, the Senate and Congress met together in the chamber of the latter, and constituted themselves "The Sovereign Cortes of Spain." Senor Rivera, the president of Congress, was called to the chair, and in a brief speech he declared himself ready to support the provisions of the constitution and the abdication of the crown of the sovereign power.

A vote was then taken on the question of accepting, without discussion, the abdication of Amadeus, and it was accepted unanimously.

A commission from the members of Congress was then appointed to draft a reply to the message, and another commission to accompany the King to the frontier. Senor Pio then proposed a resolution establishing a republic, and voting in the Assembly the supreme power. The resolution was adopted by a vote of 256 yeas against 32 nays. The Assembly was still in session when the foregoing was telegraphed from Madrid.

MADRID, Feb. 12. The Cortes to-day elected the following government: Figueras, for President of the Council, received 244 votes. Cordoba, Minister of War, 239 votes. Pta. Nagill, Minister of the Interior, 244 votes. Nicolas Salmeron, Minister of Justice, 247 votes. Francisco Salmeron, Minister of Colonies, 238 votes. Beranger, Minister of Marine, 246 votes. Castellar, Minister of Foreign Affairs, 245 votes. Beers, Minister of Public works, 233 votes. Echegaray, Minister of Finance, 248 votes. The newly elected members of the government took their seats upon the ministerial bench. President Figueras then addressed the Assembly. He said he owed his appointment to political circumstances. He believed Ornes would have been nominated had he been present. He promised that the Spanish people should in the future have the utmost freedom in the choice of their rulers and representatives. He then read numerous telegrams from the provinces, showing that public peace and order had been everywhere preserved. He hoped a republic would be established forever, and that Spain would henceforth exercise her just influence in the affairs of Europe. He believed the other Latin nations would not be slow to imitate her example. The government now chosen, he stated, would be of a national character and would preserve the integrity of Spain. The Assembly then adjourned.

A President of the Cortes will be elected to-morrow. The city is quiet to-night. The revolution will be celebrated by a grand illumination.
