AN ACT REGULATING ELECTIONS. SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Texas...

SECTION 2. The presiding justices of the several counties...

SECTION 3. The Governor shall, by proclamation, order all elections for State and district officers...

SECTION 4. When any election is ordered, at least twenty days notice of the election shall be given...

SECTION 5. In all cases of vacancy in any civil office of the county, district or State...

SECTION 6. Forms for notices, writs and returns of elections, shall be furnished by the Secretary of State...

SECTION 7. It shall be the duty of the presiding justice of each county or in case of vacancy in his office...

SECTION 8. The presiding officer of each election precinct shall, on or before the day of election...

SECTION 9. In case the presiding officer should fail to attend on the day of election...

SECTION 10. That all presiding officers, judges, clerks of election, are hereby authorized to administer all oaths necessary...

SECTION 11. Clerks of election, shall be privileged from arrest during their attendance at elections...

SECTION 12. That all the elections in this State shall be held for one day only at each election...

SECTION 13. That each of the clerks shall write and number the name of each voter at the time of voting...

PROCLAMATION
By the Governor of the State of Texas
WHEREAS, The Legislature of the State of Texas by a joint resolution passed June 4th, 1923, has proposed certain amendments to the Constitution of said State, which said resolution reads as follows:

Joint resolution proposing amendments to section five of article one, Bill of Rights of the Constitution of the State of Texas, to section four of article five, section forty and section forty-two of article twelve of general provisions of the Constitution of the State of Texas.
SECTION 1. Be it resolved by the Legislature of the State of Texas, That section five of article one, Bill of Rights of the Constitution of the State of Texas, be so amended as to hereafter read as follows:—
SECTION 2. No power of suspending laws in the State shall be exercised except by the Legislature.
SECTION 3. That section 3 and section 4 of article 5 of the said Constitution, be so amended as to hereafter read as follows:—SECTION 3. The Supreme Court shall consist of one Chief Justice and four Associate Justices, any three of whom shall constitute a quorum. They shall be appointed by the Governor by and with the advice and consent of the Senate, for a term of nine years. All vacancies shall be filled and no term shall expire when the Senate is not in session, the Governor shall fill the same by appointment, which shall be subject to the Senate within ten days after that body shall assemble, and if not confirmed the office shall immediately become vacant.
SECTION 4. The Supreme Court shall have appellate jurisdiction only, which in civil cases shall be co-extensive with the limits of the State. Appeals from inferior courts, judgments may be allowed with such exceptions and under such regulations as the Legislature may prescribe. The Supreme Court and the judges thereof shall be empowered to issue the writ of habeas corpus, and under such regulations as may be prescribed by law, may issue the writ of mandamus and such other writs as may be necessary to enforce its jurisdiction.
