The leave of absence for seven days granted First Lieutenant Leopold G. Parker, Adjutant 4th Cavalry, by paragraph III, Special Order No. 199, current series, Headquarters Fort Clark, is hereby extended twenty days.

Acting Assistant Surgeon Henry M. Mills, U. S. Army, is hereby relieved from duty at Kingdool Barracks, and will proceed at once to Fort Brown and report to the commanding officer and post surgeon for duty.

We had a conversation with Sheriff Volmer and others yesterday in reference to the lynching of Chasard. We did not obtain many additional particulars, but sufficient to convince us that our previous opinion was correct, that the lynching was one of the most desecrating outrages that has occurred in this section of the State for many years.

The unfortunate man was dead when he was hung, having been beaten to death with the iron bar of the jail door previous to the lynching.

The guard of the jail did not run at the first fire, he was reported, but had quite a little skirmish with the snipers Ku Klux before they fled, and that one of their number, an American named Parick, resisted until he was taken prisoner. The Ku Klux threatened to hang him, but desisted when they found he was not to be intimidated.

The son of the man who was lynched, is now in this city in the hospital.
