An untutored Indian squaw at Grant, Wis., has put to shame all the girls that chop corn and raise corn crops and clear forty-acre farms. She has a pale-face sister who is also unmarried.  
A young man was discharged from Auburn Prison on Saturday morning who had earned \$400 during his four and a half years of confinement. He was a skillful workman, engaged in the tool-shop.  
It is estimated that the number of Germans who have emigrated to this country during the last decade will reach 1,000,000. It is also thought that this number will be increased during the present decade.  
Lake Tahoe, Nevada, has a curiosity. Half a mile from shore a tree stands perpendicular in eighty feet of water. It projects above the surface, and is fastened so firmly to the bottom that it affords safe moorage to the largest craft on the lake.

Lord Gordon, it is said, has been seen at Esquimaux, Victoria Island the presumption is that he is intending to embark in some vessel for a South American port, probably Callao or Valparaiso.  
Miss Emma Crutch, who is considered the finest mezzo-soprano in the country, with the exception of Miss Cary, has returned to her home in Cincinnati from a long course of study under the best European masters.  
The Duke of Edinburgh will be married in St. Petersburg in January next. He will meet the Russian Imperial family in Livadia during the present month, will return to England in October, and arrive in St. Petersburg in December.  
Lady Trevelyan, the wife of Sir Charles Trevelyan, who died recently in England at the age of 63, was the sister of Lord Mansfield. She edited the last volume of his history of England. Her son is member of Parliament for Norwich.  
Mr. Calver C. Griffin, Assistant Secretary to the President, was married, Wednesday evening, in St. John Church, in Washington, to Miss Rebecca A. Ross, of Santa Cruz, Danish West Indies. They left for a bridal tour north by the late train.  
Hon. Hiram R. Revels, formerly United States Senator, has resigned his office of Secretary of State of Mississippi, probably intending to confine himself in the future more closely to the discharge of his important and pending duties as President of Alcorn University.  
The Charleston News and Courier describes a cotton-press at work in that city which will reduce an ordinary bale of cotton, weighing 500 pounds, to eight inches in the press and thirteen inches turned out, and will compress seventy-five bales an hour.

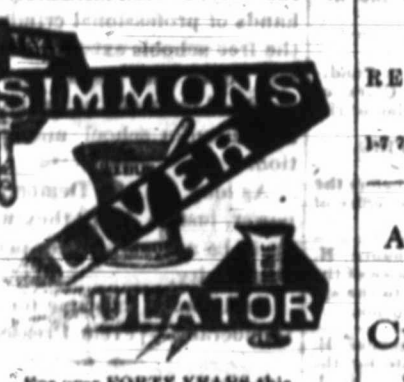
