The comparison of the small col ony of 1846 and the present town of New Brauntels is startling Now Braunfels the hills begin to be the whole of Comal county and crowned with human habitations, many of the adjacent counties are settled with flourishing towns and farms by these first settlers and their descendants. Candaloupe, Bexar, Hays, Blanco and Kendal counties are settled principally by these enterprising pioneers. The sitizeus of Comal county alone own a million dollars of real estate in

the adjoining counties.

New Braunfels has met with fre quent and severe reverses. The foaming Comal, the water power of which is almost unrivalled, has proven a curse rather than a blessing, owing to its sudden and high rises. On the 9th of June, 1872, a fine iron bridge 180 feet long was carried away, the day before tha last nall was to be driven: In 1869 the place was visited by a tornado which virtually destroyed a large and well appointed cotton tactory, and thirty two houses besides. 



PROCLAMATION By the Governor of the State of Texas.

To all to whom these presents shall es WHEREAS, The Legislature of the St. of Texas by a joint resolution passed Ju 4th, 1873, has proposed certain ameriments to the Constitution of said Sta which joint resolution reads as followed:

Joint resolution proposing amendment to section twenty of article one, B' Rights, to section two, aection three section four of article ave, aection two eight, section forty and to section felight of article twelve of general visions of the Constitution of the St. Taxas.

Texas.
SECTION 1. Be it resolved by the Legislature of the State at Texas. That section twenty of article one, Bill of Rights of the Constitution of the State of Texas, he samended as to hereafter read as follows:

to-wit.

SEC. 20. No power of suspending laws in
the State shall be exercised except by the

Legislature.

8mc. 2. That section 2, section 3 and section 4 of article 5 of the said Constitution, be so amended as to hereafter read as follows, to-wit: Section 3. The Supreme Cohrt shall consist af one Chief Justice and four Associate Justices, any three of whom shall constitute a quorum. They shall be appointed by the Governor by and with the advice and consent of the Senate, for a term of nine years. All vacancies shall be filled for the udoxpired term. If a vacancy shall soons, or a term shall expire when the Senate is not in session, the Governor shall fill the same by appointment, which shall be sent to the Senate within ten days after that body shall assemble, and if not confirmed the office shall immediately become vacant.

8zc. 3. The Supreme Court shall have

shall immediately become vacant.

SEC. 3. The Supreme Court shall have appellate jurisdiction only, which in civil jurisdiction only, which in civil ranses, shall be co-extensive with the limits of the State. Appeals from interlocutory judgments may be allowed with such exceptions and under such regulations as the Legislature may preseribe. The Supreme Court and the judges thereof, shall bave power to issue the writ of habeas corpus, and under such regulations as may be preseribed by law, may issue the writ of mandams and such other writs as may be necessary to enforce its ewn jurisdiction. The Supreme Court shall also have hower to assertain such matters of fact as may be necessary to the proper exercise of its jurisdiction.
