PROCLAMATION
By the Governor of the State of
Texas.
To all to whom these presents shall come:
WHEREAS, The Legislature of the State
of Texas by a joint resolution passed June
4th, 1873, has proposed certain amend-
ments to the Constitution of said State,
which joint resolution reads as follows, viz:
Joint resolution proposing amendments
to section twenty of article one, Bill of
Rights, to section two, section three and
section four of article five, section twenty-
eight, section forty and section forty-
eight of article twelve of general pro-
visions of the Constitution of the State of
Texas.
SECTION 1. Be it resolved by the Legis-
lature of the State of Texas, That section
twenty of article one, Bill of Rights, of the
Constitution of the State of Texas, be so
amended as to hereafter read as follows to-
wit:
SEC. 20. No power of suspending laws in
the State shall be exercised except by the
Legislature.
SEC. 2. That section 2, section 3 and
section 4 of article 5 of the said Consti-
tution, be so amended as to hereafter read
as follows, to-wit: Section 2. The Supreme
Court shall consist of one Chief Justice
and four Associate Justices, any three of
whom shall constitute a quorum. They
shall be appointed by the Governor by and
with the advice and consent of the Senate,
for a term of nine years. All vacancies
shall be filled for the unexpired term. If
a vacancy shall occur, or a term shall ex-
pire when the Senate is not in session, the
Governor shall fill the same by appoint-
ment, which shall be subject to the Senate
at its next session, and if not confirmed the
office shall immediately become vacant.
SEC. 3. The Supreme Court shall have
appellate jurisdiction only, which in civil
cases shall be exercised by the Court of
Appeals from interlocutory
judgments may be allowed with such ex-
ceptions and under such regulations as the
Legislature may prescribe. The Supreme
Court and the judges thereof, shall have
power to issue the writ of habeas corpus,
and under such regulations as may be pre-
scribed by law, may issue the writ of
certiorari to such courts and officers as may
be necessary to enforce its own jurisdic-
tion. The Supreme Court shall also have
power to ascertain such matters of fact as
may be necessary to the proper exercise of
its jurisdiction.
SEC. 4. The Supreme Court shall hold
its session at the Capital, and two other
places in the State.
SEC. 5. That section twenty-eight, sec-
tion forty and section forty-eight of article
twelve of general provisions of the said
constitution, be so amended as to hereafter
read as follows: to-wit. SEC. 28. In each
and every organized county in the State,
there shall be an assessor and collector of
taxes, elected by the people at the next
general election and every four
years thereafter, who shall assess the
property and collect the taxes so assessed
in conformity to such laws as may be
enacted hereafter by the Legisla-
ture, relative to the assessment and collec-
tion of taxes.
SEC. 40. The Legislature shall not pass
local or special laws in any of the follow-
ing enumerated cases, that is to say, for
local or special courts or courts of justice;
regulating the practice in Courts of Justice;
regulating the duties and jurisdiction of
Justices of the Peace and constables; pro-
viding for changes of venue in civil and
criminal cases; incorporating cities or
towns or changing or amending the char-
ter of any city or village; providing for
the management of common schools, regu-
lating the rates of interest on notes, re-
mitting, fines, penalties or forfeitures,
changing the law of descent in all other
cases when a general law can be made
applicable; no special law shall be enacted;
or in any case when a general law can be
made applicable, no special law shall be
enacted. The Legislature shall enact
general laws providing for the cases before
mentioned in this section, and in all other
cases which in its judgment may be pro-
vided for by general laws, and, whereas
section 50 of article 12 of the constitution
provides that such proposed amendments
shall be duly published in the public
prints of this State at least three months
before the next general election of Repre-
sentatives, for the consideration of the
people, and it shall be the duty of the
Secretary of State to cause to be printed
and returned to the people at the next
general election which shall be thus holden to
open a poll for and make a return to the
Secretary of State of the names of all persons
voting for Representatives who have voted
on such proposed amendments as provided
in Section 50 of Article 12 of the Constitu-
tion. Said election to be conducted in all
other respects in accordance with the pro-
visions of an act regulating elections, ap-
proved March 31st 1873, and an act
amending the same approved April 1st
1873.
In testimony whereof, I have hereunto
signed my name and caused the
great seal of the State to be af-
fixed at the city of Austin, this
15 day of August A. D. 1873.

Governor.

Mr. S. S. Cox, in a meeting held
at Steiway Hall in New York,
which was largely attended, in his
speech among other things said:
"What is the law of nations with
regard to the seizure of the Vir-
ginia? Was there a breach of that
law? And if a breach, what is the
remedy for the outrage?
Perhaps it would be wiser to leave
the international question to such
publicists as the honored chairman
of this meeting. But as a premise
for my conclusion, and without
chopping legal logic or quoting too
many authorities, I may hint at the
nature of that seizure. If the seizure
was right it does not follow,
however, that the brutal conse-
quences at Santiago can be just-
ified in any form of conscience or
justice.
One thing is beyond doubt. The
vessel was duly authenticated by
our government. Our flag, right-
fully, was at its mast. It had our
register and our clearance, the
register was on the high seas; not
within Spanish waters; not within
the marine league. There was no
recognition by Spain of belligerent
rights to the insurgency in Cuba.
Then what was the legal status of
the vessel? Precisely your right to
walk the city parks or streets co-
equal with that of any other person.
No man, except by warrant of law,
can obstruct your locomotion. The
sea is a common. It is no ordinary
progress of human thought which
has made this doctrine, not of
America, but of the world. The
fettors which stronger nations have
imposed on commerce, and especial-
ly upon neutrals, have melted away
under the civilizing influences of
time. This country has been the
chief agent in that amelioration of
maritime relations. In the Trent
case, England under our doctrine
reclaimed Sidel and Mason, and
mitigated her own laws and admir-
alty decisions—her own attempts
to make the sea a British highway.
Upon what principle? Precisely on
that laid down as early as 1785 by
Franklin in his treaty with Prussia.
Washington approved of it. Quincy
Adams, following Grotius, elaborated
it in 1828 to Columbia. Clay did
the same to our Panama commis-
sioners. Pierce and Marcy clinched
it. Indeed, although we ended the
war of 1812 without settling the
question in favor of "sailor's rights"
and a free sea, yet time has done
what our army and navy failed to
do. The doctrine, broadly stated,
is that the vessel under whose flag
it sails, and no power can rightfully
question or curtail its privileges.
Every prominent American states-
man has insisted on this doctrine.
Monroe, when Minister to London,
in 1804, held that a neutral flag on
the high seas was a safeguard to
those sailing under it. Madison, in
his Message of May 25, 1813, held
that "each State had exclusive
jurisdiction over its own vessels.
Its laws govern in them, and offen-
ces against those laws are punish-
able by its tribunals only." In the
case of the Virginia there were no
belligerent rights to make the case
exceptional. Quincy Adams gave
positive instructions in the case of
the Good Return—in the final stage
of which, before Sir Frederick
Bruce, I was of counsel—to this ef-
fect:—"The high seas are general
jurisdiction, common to all, qual-
ified by a special jurisdiction of each
nation over its own vessels." Web-
ster laid down the same doctrine to
Ashburton in 1842. He held the
vessel to be territory, and the entry
into it, being a neutral, by a bellig-
erent is an act of force, trespass
and wrong.
Every writer of authority holds
to the American doctrine. That the
rights of person, property and
sovereignty are violated whenever,
as in the case of the Virginia, a ship
is overhauled, searched and seized.

The elections this year are not
yet complete. On Monday, the 24th
instant, a congressman will be
chosen in the Fourth district of Louisi-
ana, to fill the vacancy caused by
the death of Samuel Peters. On
Tuesday, December 2, Texas will
elect a governor and vote on pro-
posed amendments to the constitu-
tion. On Monday, December 8,
special elections will be held in
Florida for seven members of the
senate and seven of the assembly.
On Tuesday, December 16, Penn-
sylvania will accept or reject the new
constitution.
