DISINFECTANTS.

One drachm of dry iodine, placed in a suitable open vessel in a sick room, is said to be among the best articles used for this purpose. The vapors of the iodine will discolor the ceiling or plastered walls for a time, but the color will gradually disappear. Iodoform, used in the same way, is quite as good, and less offensive to the sense of smell, besides it does not discolor the walls, but it is more expensive than the other.

The Situation.

Our advice from Eastern Texas concerning the election are throughout favorable to the Republican party. The time-honored principles of the Democracy have lost their hold with the people of Texas, and as a progressing people the Texans will vote for the Party of the future and quit indulging in the ideas of the past. This is good news and ought to encourage all Republicans to do their utmost to swell the probable Republican party as much as possible. The people of the West will cast three fourths of their votes for Gov. Davis; in fact there will be more Republican votes polled on the second day of December than ever have been polled in Texas. Our opponents have wisely ceased to brag about their 40,000 majority. They have come down to 10,000 and even then have stopped bragging. They now see that they have underrated the Republicans and we should not wonder if their victory of November 1872 would be followed by a regular Bull-run in 1873. Look out!

Simon-pure Republicans.

There are some people in this community, who call themselves Simon-pure Republicans and class well with the Simon-pure Democrats. They are inflexible in their opinions like the Pope and fully convinced that offices are exclusively made for themselves and nobody else. They have no objections if citizens who do not easily yield to the party lash, will vote for them, but if they object to any of their favored candidates, or dare to vote the straight Republican ticket as nominated by the Convention when it does not suit themselves, they are ready to curse them in the sublimest style. Now this is all folly, and those gentlemen may as well bow understand, that the time of bullying Republicans into their opinion is past. The Republican party of Texas has heretofore existed without their assistance and sympathy and can do so hereafter. We do not propose to build up a Republican party to consist exclusively of members of the Grand Army of the Republic—we might as well give up the work at once.

There are not enough members of the Grand Army of the Republic in Texas to form a Corporal guard, less a party. We propose to invite all citizens to work with us who believe in the principles of the Republican party and are willing to fight for progress, liberty and equality before the law, may they have been federal soldiers or Confederate soldiers, may they have been Democrats, Whigs, or Abolitionists, we invite even old know-nothings into our ranks, if they will cut loose from their old know-nothing principles.

This is what we propose to do, and when we admit all such material into our party, such material is as well entitled to offices, as any Simon-pure Republicans. If some conscientious men cannot breathe the air of a former confederate or cannot vote for a man who is not a life time Republican, although he may be an honest and capable man, let them act according to their will, but we will remember them as enemies of their party. Not he is a good Republican, who never quits boasting of his Republican record, but he who always sets with the Republican party in good faith.

FOREIGN NEWS.
MADRID, Nov. 26.—The Juerguido newspapers justify the execution of the Virginia prisoners, and offer, as a precedent for the action of the Spanish authorities, the circular issued by the United States government, during their civil war, de claring the Confederate privateers pirates.
HAVANA, Nov. 26.—A grand reception was given to the Cuban Minister at Cape and Canal.
LONDON, Nov. 26.—The Lord Chief Justice of the Court of Common Pleas raised to the peerage and becomes Baron Colclidge.
Ten of the crew of the ship Clyde, wrecked Clyde wrecked off Valencis Island, were drowned.
BRASIA, Nov. 26.—Archbishop Ledochowski has been ordered to resign within one week from the notice. He has received a letter from the Pope exhorting him to resign.

DOMESTIC NEWS.

WASHINGTON, Nov. 26.—The House of Representatives will vote for Adams Saturday night.

THE SITUATION.

The steamers have gone into winter quarters. This is the earliest closing during the present century.
Under orders of the Union, the Brooklyn planters have stopped until employees guarantee four dollars a day for the winter. The employees have generally refused.
The Associated Banks have \$35,000,000 in legal tenders.
Secretary Robeson reached the Brooklyn Navy Yard at noon to-day, in company with the naval constructor. They visited the Colorado, and expressed themselves satisfied with the manner in which work was going on. Work will be continued to-morrow as usual.
A dispatch to the Herald says that on Tuesday evening, Secretary Robeson received information which quickened all possible activity in his department in preparing for a crisis. Orders, preliminary and planetary, were issued by the Secretary to the chiefs of bureaus to put the navy in the best possible condition, without waiting for the approval of the Secretary. The next orders issued were to Rear Admiral Case, commanding the European Squadron, ordering him to leave but one ship at Cadix, and proceed with the other vessels, under full steam, to Key West. Dispatches were then prepared for the Rear Admiral commanding the South and South Atlantic stations, (which are now on their way), to order all vessels of their fleets to Key West, under steam, and report to the Navy Department at that point. A telegram was sent to the commander of the East India Squadron, informing him to the gravity of the situation, and to issue orders at once to every vessel of his fleet to prepare for any emergency.
Per contra, the Times, in a double lead editorial, says: "We have reason to believe that the negotiations with Spain have assumed a shape which places the prospect of war at a much greater distance than was the case yesterday."
The Star gives the following as points of arrangement between Secretary Fish and Admiral Porter: Surrender of the Virginia line, with the usual salute to American flag; the restoration of the surviving members of the crew; and proper indemnity to the families of those executed.
The Mohawck has passed Cape Henry en route to Cuban waters.
The Secretary of State has no news from Madrid to-night.
PHILADELPHIA, Nov. 26.—There is increased activity in the Navy Yard, Admiral Porter inspected the vessels yesterday.
The dispatch boat Pinta is ordered to sea.
CHICAGO, Nov. 26.—Gen. Sheridan is ordered to Washington to confer in regard to military affairs, in the case of war with Spain, in the event of which he would have chief command in the field.
CAMDEN, N. J., Nov. 26.—A State Grange was organized here to-day.
