

A legal opinion and what it is worth.

James H. Bell, the notorious rail road lobbyist and agent of the Central Railroad, the same great lawyer, who, as Judge of the Supremebench during the Confederacy in a trial for murder at this place considered drunkenness, a mitigation and admitted the foul murderer to bail, this same great lawyer has made himself immortal by expressing his legal opinion as to the constitutionality of the late election. Hear him:

Section 6, Article 3, of the con stitution reads as follows: "All elections for State, district and county officers shall be held at the county seats of the several counties, until otherwise provided by law : and the polls shall be opened for four days, from 8 A. M. until 4 P. M. of

I am informed that it is contend ed by some lawyers that this provision confers upon the Legislature the power to cause elections to be held at other places than the county seats, but does not give the power to limit the election to less than four days. I entertain a different epinion. I think the latter clause of the section, that which follows the semi colon, is a dependent and not a substantive clause; the main thought of the section is expressed in the first cause, and that thought is, that the elections shall be held at the respective county seats. That thought becomes the reason for another thought or rule. If the elections are to be held in only one place, then four days will be required within which to take the ballots. This is the meaning of the section. But the Legislature may provide that the elections shall be held at six, or ten, or twenty places in a county.
