Washington Society and Guests.

Life in Washington—City Improvements—New Streets—Public Parks—Elegant New Buildings—Society Notes—Public Amusements—Personal.

WASHINGTON, Dec. 10th, 1873.

INTELLIGENCE.

The telegraph and newspaper press, buried over the Continent by the side of electricity and steam, will have informed you of the doings in Congress from day to day, with a promptness that will reheat your correspondent from the duty of following up in detail the progress of work of National legislation. Outside of Congress, however, there is in Washington—a miniature world in motion and commotion, the events and incidents of which if caught up as they occur, will prove interesting if not instructive, to the intelligent reader in any portion of the Continent.

The sayings and doings of our prominent men—and now-a-days of our prominent women too—the decline and fall of the departments; society movements, etiquette, gossip and fashions; receptions, public and select; dinners, balls, socials and evening parties; diplomatic receptions and international courtesies, each and all afford material for comment, thought, amusement and perhaps information. Last, though not least, the rump reporting of the city news, still going on, by regrading and paving the streets, beautifying the parks with fountains, shade trees, walks and lawns, and the erection of a large additional number of elegant buildings, is suggestive of increasing population, wealth and refinement.

With these prefatory remarks your correspondent will proceed to inform you of the sayings and doings of the day.

It is generally known that years ago Congressmen during their stay at the Capital were seldom accompanied by their families, but those friends would congregate in the different boarding houses, forming what they styled "mobs." Some of these mobs would be graced by the presence of a Senator or Ambassador, who would hold court, while the greater number were without the refining influence which ladies are accustomed to exert. House keeping was seldom thought of, and in consequence hospitality was but little practised among the legislators of our nation. Now, however, things are differently arranged, and Washington socially and politically is greatly benefited by the change.

Many fine residences have been built by gentlemen of wealth, some of whom come to our city in official capacity, while others are drawn thither by various attractions, many of which exist in no other city of the world. Our women are pleasant, the city, which promises to be the most beautiful on the Continent, is well drained, healthy and easily accessible.

Trade is steadily growing, and population rapidly increasing. As the capital of the nation is drawn together for six months of the year, people of wealth and culture from all parts of the country, who joined with the permanent residents here, make up a brilliant and refined society.

Mrs. Secretary Fish gave the first reception of thousands of Washingtonians.

The occasion was rendered more than usually agreeable by the presence of her daughter, Miss Edith Fish, who will assist in dispensing the hospitalities of her father's home, during the winter.

Mrs. General Sherman has also resumed her regular Monday afternoon receptions.

She is assisted by her daughters, and when convenient the General joins his family, adding much to the pleasure of the guests.

This family have the responsibility of making all well call for that they are welcome.

Which is better appreciated, when we remember that many attend receptions from curiosity, or a motive perhaps less important, while the number who have any interest in the welfare of the hostess or her family is very small. Many will regret to learn that the Friday evening receptions at General Sherman's, so enjoyable last winter, will not be resumed this season.

Society looks for a session a month or two hence, when Ernest, Duke of Saxe Coburg (Gotha) is expected to arrive in this country, where he intends to remain about a year. He is a brother-in-law to Queen Victoria, and a general favorite man among us. He is not quite so popular as our former royal visitors, his age being rather advanced.

General Bullock, our popular Secretary of War, left Washington last Friday night for Harrodsburg, Kentucky, at which place he is to be wedded to the charming Miss Bowens, who for several seasons has adorned the highest social circles of this city. Secretary Bullock expects to be absent about a week or ten days.

A dispatch from Paris announces the appointment of M. Bartholdi, now first Sec-

retary of State, to Petersburg, to act as French Minister of Finance, and Madame Estelle, a popular here, and in Europe, much regretted.

TONIGHT AND YESTERDAY.—To-night of the late C. S. A. Lee, are to find in Georgia, attracti-

ve men. By courtesy he was al-

lowed to choose his seat near the speaker

and awaiting the usual drawing of lots.

His pale, thin face is almost hidden under the sloped hat, which he does not remove on taking his seat, as his health is so feeble that he fears the slightest draft.

Those who knew him years ago, say he is but the ghost of his former self.

In this connection it is worthy of note that the House has acted nearly upon the President's recommendation by passing a general amnesty bill wholly removing all political disabilities. The large majority by which it passed is a hopeful indication of the speedy return of good feeling between the North and the South.

When the bill passes the Senate, it is undoubtedly, will it should be remembered, that President Grant is entitled to a part of the credit of gravity since the president recommended such a measure.

We are promised a generous share of entertainment, musical and theatrical during the Winter, and are better prepared by the opening of a new theatre to enjoy such amusements than hitherto. The National Theatre recently opened, has been remodelled, and was opened on the evening of Monday Dec. 1st. The house is capable of seating 2000 persons, and the public are assured that every care has been taken to secure their comfort and safety.

Maggie Mitchell appeared on the open-

ing night in her favorite role Fanchon.

This week she is playing Lead of Savoy,

while Little Barefoot, and Jane Eyre are

in preparation for the latter part of the week.

She always receives a warm welcome here and many think she plays better than Miss Fanning. Familiarity with her makes her seem less good to less experienced in playing as is too often the case.

At Ford's opera-house Rep. Van Winkle

(his daughter) has been attracting large audiences. Songs have not

been given as yet, but he yet has

the power to strike large chords, bear him,

and, perhaps this will not tend to urge him to greater effort. The Philharmonic society advertises a concert for this evening to be given in the auditorium of the hotel.

The best part of the programme consists of Mendelssohn's Hymn of Praise By the Society. The second part will be an exhibition of Wagnerian music by Dr. Giesecke, organist of the church, and Mr. Walter of the Philharmonic Soc-

ety.

This organ has been recently built by

Messrs. Wood of New York, at a cost of

ten thousand dollars. It is the largest

instrument in the city, and is played by a

gentleman, who stands first among our

Washington organists, STEPHEN MCNAUL.

The course of lectures under the auspices of the Young Men's Christian Association was inaugurated last evening by Mr. Ward Howe, who is well known in New York as a lady of brilliant

talent and a high degree of culture. On

the platform as elsewhere Mrs. Howe manifested the characteristics of a refined

lady, and was received with great interest.

Her lecture on Men Women and

Women's Work was a brilliant and

beautiful production. She claimed that

the most brilliant and fascinating women were in the first class, but the best and

most useful were in the second.
