The Yellow Fever at Shreveport.

The ages of \$85 persons who died in Sureveport, La., of yellow fever, during the recent epidemic, have been ascertained. The Shreveport Telegram makes the following re ference to them: Of these 100 died under ten yeurs of age, 14 were be tween ten and twenty, 156 were be tween twenty and thirty, 134 were between thirty and forty, 59 were between forty and fifty, 29 were between fifty and sixty, 13 were above sixty. It wilk be observed that the greatest mortality occurs bewteen the ages of twenty and thirty years, and the next greatest from thirty to forty, the period of life when the buman system ordinarily has most capacity to resist disease. We must presume that there are more chil dren in the city under ten years of age than adults between twenty and thirty, and certainly more than between thirty and forty, and yet Claret Wines, in casks or bottles, we see that the victims are more than half as many again between twenty and thirty years of age as there are no derien, or from ten to twenty, and nearly the same ratio holds as to these whe died between thirty and forty as to those who died under ten years, and from ten to twenty.
