THE German Federal Council has approved a bill enacting that, in place of the paper currency to be withdrawn from circulation in the federal States up to the 31st of December, 1875, imperial treasury notes of five, twenty-five and fifty marks shall be issued. The total amount of these notes is fixed at 120,000,000 marks, (40,000,000 thalers), and were to be allotted to the federal States in proportion to the number of their inhabitants. The German paper currency will by this means be reduced by 27,000,000 thalers.
