CITY COUNCIL.

Discussion Yesterday. Yesterday at 5 o'clock in the afternoon the new styled City Council of San Antonio met pursuant to adjournment of the day before.

Mr. Muench offered a resolution that, in view of the financial condition of the city, no officers be appointed except those provided for in the Charter; which was passed unanimously.

Sec. 24 of the Charter, as recently amended, was then read by the Secretary at the request of the Mayor, pointing out the floors to be appointed, and the manner of their appointment.

When the reading of the section was concluded, the Mayor put in nomination the name of Theodore Baldes, for City Clerk.

Mr. Degener then replied in substance as follows: The City Charter is explicit on the subject of filling vacancies. Upon vacancies by the Mayor, the Council proceeds to "elect."

Whenever the people are called upon to manifest their will at the polls, be it for the adoption or rejection of a constitutional amendment, a railroad subsidy or otherwise, they are summoned by an Election proclamation.

Moreover, the city charter is in perfect harmony with the State laws, as of the United States law. The same thing is true in the matter of appointments to all the offices of the State Government.

Mr. McAllister then offered the following resolution, or ordinance. "Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of San Antonio, that nominations be made by the Mayor, under Section 24 of the amended charter shall be as follows: The Mayor shall get in nomination for each and every office to be elected under said act, the names of all persons applying for such offices, and the names of such other persons as the Mayor may deem proper, and from persons or persons, so put in nomination, the Council shall proceed to elect by ballot an officer for each of said offices, and a majority of the votes cast shall elect, and in case of a tie, the Mayor shall give a casting vote."

The Mayor decided that the resolution was out of order, as it empowered a provision of the City Charter. Mr. Teel appeared from the decision of the chair, and the system was maintained, five Aldermen voting to sustain the decision of the Mayor, and seven against it.
