General Orders, No. 1.

Instead of the copies of returns therein called for, officers will render state of the substance and ordnance stores for which they may be responsible direct to the Chief Ordnance Officer of the Department, upon blanks furnished by that officer.

Special Orders, No. 5.
In conformity with the requisition of General Order No. 45, series of 1874, War Department Adjutant General's Office, the following named officers will make inspection of the money accounts of the disbursing officers at the following posts:

Col. J. H. Potter, 24th Infantry, at Brown, Texas.
Colonel L. L. Anderson, 24th Infantry, at Fort Hancock, Texas.
Capt. C. H. Hood, 24th Infantry, at Fort McIntosh, Texas.
Capt. G. Boutwell, 25th Infantry, at Fort Quitman, Texas.
Col. E. Hatch, 9th Cavalry, at Ringgold Barracks, Texas.
Col. R. S. Macemonie, 4th Cavalry, now in the city, will proceed to Fort Clark on public business, on the completion of which he will return to these headquarters.
Major A. E. Lehmer, Fourth Cavalry, now at Fort Clark, Texas, will proceed with his little party as practicable to Fort Richardson, Texas, and report to the commanding officer of that post. The commanding officer of that post, Second Lieut. J. A. McKinnon, Fourth Cavalry, now at Fort McKavett, Texas, will proceed with as little delay as practicable to Fort Hancock, Texas, to superintend the transfer of company property.
Capt. S. Gunther, 4th Cavalry, now at Fort Richardson, Texas, will proceed with as little delay as practicable to Fort McKavett, Texas, to superintend the transfer of company property.
Captain J. B. Shaver, 25th Infantry, now at Fort Richardson, Texas, will proceed with as little delay as practicable to Fort Clark, Texas, to superintend the transfer of company property.
Special Order, No. 7.
The headquarters of the companies B, E, F, K, L, and M, Fourth Cavalry, are transferred to Fort Hill, Texas, and companies C, D, G, H, and I, are transferred to Fort Richardson, Texas. The authorized baggage pertaining to the headquarters and companies will be carefully packed and marked, and held in readiness to be transported to their respective posts on the arrival of the train west for that purpose. This belonging of the companies lately at Fort Detroit, will be sent from that post at once to Fort Clark. The train is expected to be at Fort Clark about the 24th inst. and will proceed via Ft. Hancock, Texas, to Fort Hill, Texas, and the baggage of the 4th Cavalry at those posts will leave it at Richardson and at Hill.
Company G, Fourth Cavalry, will move with this train, taking care to report to the commanding officer of the company. The commanding officer of the company will make his military reports to the chief of the train, but will not interfere with the baggage except when necessary for its defense.
The personnel of the headquarters and companies remaining at Fort Clark will not move until the arrival there of the company of the 4th Cavalry from Fort Concho. When it will be put en route for Fort Clark. This train of the personnel of the 4th Cavalry will proceed via Fort McKavett, Comstock, Griffin, and Richardson, gathering up the personnel pertaining to the regiment at those posts and leaving it at its former post.
Companies B, E, C, and M will be detached from their respective posts and ordered to report at Fort Concho by the 1st of March, prepared in everything as if they were in the field service. The personnel of the property and the personnel not fitted for field service will be sent to the depot by the proper train calling for them.
Major J. H. Miller, Fourth Cavalry, will be relieved from duty at Fort McKavett in time to proceed with the train of the personnel of his regiment to Fort Richardson, where he will report to the commanding officer for duty at that post.
On the arrival of the companies of the Ninth Cavalry at Fort Clark, Acting Assistant Surgeon J. J. Culver, U. S. A., will report to the commanding officer of the Cavalry for duty with the 4th Cavalry at Fort Hill.
