WOOL.—Messrs. Gross & Co. purchased Mr. Wishe's clip of 10,000 pounds at 27c. The wool market is somewhat depressed to-day in consequence of the shyness of buyers, and every day the quantity of wool increases. The following reliable statement may be of interest to buyers and growers:

Boston, May 15.—Wool very dull, with no prospect as yet of any improvement. Sales of fleece wool the past week have been quite limited, comprising some small lots Ohio and Pennsylvania fleeces at 50¢/52¢; Michigan fleeces at 48¢/50¢; scarcely any inquiry for fine fleeces or fine Australian, although prices may now be considered quite low, holders are anxious to close up stock but even if possession were submitted to, transactions would not be materially increased; 53¢/54¢ fleeces considered extreme prices for good xx and xxx fleeces, while No. 1 would sell readily at 57¢/58¢. Pooled wool still meets with fair demand, particularly fine squares available to take the place of No. 1 fleeces. Holders are sold up close, and have not allowed stock of pooled to accumulate, as prices are as high now as they are likely to be for some time to come. Sales of Western and other fleeces at 52¢/53¢, combing and delaine fleeces 57¢/58¢, on washed combing and delaine at 45¢/56¢, secured at 54¢/55¢ upper and 44¢/45¢ pulled at 42¢/43¢.

REV. SHERIDAN'S FATE.

How and Why it Happened - The Great Catalyst Leader, accompanied by a Blend - What is going to happen. When the June comes unfold - A Few Words About Her.

(Chicago Correspondence N. V. Herald.)

When that plucky little Lieutenant General Philip H. Sheridan, U. S. Army, was telegraphing from the capital of Louisiana to the Honorable, the Secretary of War, that the whole atmosphere was charged with assassination, that an armed banditti waited but a favorable moment to break forth as revolutionists, and that he was not afraid, how few of the people of the United States, who, with varying comment, were watching his course, knew that in that very hour he had met his fate; that for the first time he was vanquished, and that, too, by the all powerful god of love. Whatever recollection Louisiana may have of Sheridan, Sheridan's remembrance of Louisiana is so fraught with memories of a personal character that all thoughts of a political character must receive a gentle, kindly tinge from the association. For it was at the height of that memorable January affair in the Crescent City that the lieutenant general became so accepted lover of the fair young lady who is so named his wife in June next.

The President's instructions to General Sheridan regard the Louisiana matter were, among other things, to give his trip the appearance of a pleasure party, but to keep his eyes about him, and, if need be, assume the difficult role of command. With this view, he invited his brother, Colonel Michael Sheridan, to accompany him and to bring his young wife, a niece of Colonel MacVoy, who has just received his merited promotion to the chief clerk of the Commissary Department. To still further increase the numerical strength of his party, he suggested that Miss Greene, the young daughter of his old army friend and valued staff officer, General Roeker, of the Quartermaster General's Department, be the guest of his sister-in-law. He knew the young lady as a bright, intelligent girl who had made many conquests among the susceptible young officers, but had no thought of personal danger. It had not occurred to him to be afraid. The arrangement was agreeable to every one, and the party started. The political nature of the trip was known to the nation over. The personal routine to Philip H. Sheridan will be known in June next, when the estimable young guest of the journey will, by the license of the State, the word of the priest, and the consent of the parties most interested, be united to write, instead of Miss Roeker, Mrs. Philip H. Sheridan. A jet.

THE REGIMENTARY is only whispered in the army circles here, which, so this is the headquarters of a military division, is large, elegant and select. While the General's change in camp pleased the worldly minded wonder that no gallant and distinguished officer as the Lieutenant General, who had the center of the most fashionable society in the land, and whose prestige as a soldier would confer distinction upon any family which he might honor with a marriage connection, had not long since made an alliance with some wealthy lady of a family known by the elegance, hospitality, culture and fortune to the whole nation. But it is a man and his heart that leads under Phil Sheridan's name. With him necessary or merely social considerations could have no weight. He, said Taylor has said -

The heavens are the tempter. The luring are the darning. So it was with Phil Sheridan. Such a man need marry with his heart. Some, at his pocket. For that matter he is rich enough, and, so to speak, his rank will always ensure him such as he may wish. "HIS EAR" seems to be depending the young lady who is to be the Lieutenant General's. But it is not. All she lacks in the eyes of those who would find a wife for Phil is wealth. She is young, beautiful, bright and accomplished. She is a blonde, with the virginal purity characteristic of that type. Her father is an old and respected officer, not rich, but rich in soldierly fame to the man who devotes his life to the army. Like all the very people here, his social standing is of the best character, his wife and three daughters rendering his home peculiarly attractive to friends and callers. When the June comes are unfolding, Miss Roeker orange blossoms will be in their most fragrant bloom. Sheridan's campaign is short and decisive. So with his courtship. The wedding will be one of the quietest character possible. This is consistent with the excellent taste of the Roeker family, and meets the wish of the General, who, when his wedding day, extends only from the Roeker house, which is on Michigan avenue, near 14th street, to the General's plain but ample brick, which is on Michigan avenue, a mile north on the same beautiful thoroughfare.

Although Gen. Roeker is not, his family are Catholics, and this circumstance, it is said, highly gratifying to the gallant groom, who, though by no means a church partisan, hardly a member, yet has a warm regard for the old faith of his fathers, to full communion with which, on the principle of once a Catholic always a Catholic, he will, sooner or later, return. It is probable that the Catholic Bishop will perform the ceremony, though, if it should involve the least display, it will be abandoned as a part of the programme, since the words "thy wife" by a humble

priest are just as sacred, and often far more grateful. Society's great regret will be that there will be no wedding; the General's joy is that he and his wife are spared the glittering sham.

A word as to the General: It is supposed that he has turned the leaf of life into the mysterious valley beyond. In 1849, he entered the Military Academy in 1849, at the age of 18; consequently he is just 45. And a hale, hearty, gallant, warmer hearted and more sensible man - barring the wording of an occasional dispatch - doesn't bid fair to grow old. The nation will gladly throw the legendary slipper after him and his fair bride.

Pope Pius IX. has reached his eighty-fourth year, and the event has been duly celebrated at Rome. Twelve of the Pontiff's who have preceded the present incumbent of the papal chair reached eighty four years of age, and although his Holiness has frequently of late been reported as declining health, there is every reason to believe he will continue at the head of the Catholic Church for some time yet. He has "passed the days of Peter" at any rate, and this alone has brought joy to the fold. The old proverb that no Pope would exceed the time of Peter has proven false; but if long life is a sign of heaven's favor the reigning Pope has received it.
